Hogberg became the first freshman ever to make the trip to nationals as part of the CU squad back in 1980-81, and it's fitting he returns as a senior.

Nicknamed "Frank" because of his large frame, Hogberg led the Buffs in stroke average as a junior (76.3) and as a senior (74.7). He's earned four letters at CU.

Hogberg came on at the end of the '82-83 season, in which he fired his best college round ever of 66 at Bear Creek Golf World in the Houston All-American, that in 40 degree and windy weather.

He carried that success home to Sweden with him last summer, when he captured the Swedish Amateur Championship and won five other summer tournaments in Europe, and finished second in three others and third in an international meet held in Scotland.

Hogberg is the only Buff that's married (Karen).
