## 1997 Milestones

- Soccer Buzz online magazine rated Colorado's schedule the third toughest slate in the nation. The schedule consisted of five of the top 17 preseason ranked teams (No. 6 Nebraska, No. 8 Texas A&M, No. 12 Harvard, No. 15 Massachusetts and No. 17 Florida).
- CU's first win of the season came with a 2-1 OT victory over Big 12 rival Iowa State
- In the 3-0 win at Kansas on Sept. 28, CU's three goals mark the most scored for Colorado on the season, the second most goals scored in the program's two-year history.
- CU posted its first win over a ranked team in defeating then-No. 25 Baylor 3-2
- With a 2-1 double overtime win over Texas Tech on Oct. 19, CU clinched a birth in the Big 12 Tournament.
- CU took a 3-2 win over the in-state rival University of Denver on Nov. 2, earning the victory in the first-ever meeting between the two schools.
- Qualified for the Big 12 Conference tournament for the first time with a 5-5 record, securing the fifth place in the conference.
- Colorado placed nine players on the academic all-Big 12 team, the second consecutive year the Buffs have earned more spots than any other school in the conference; First Team: Nina Bjornstad, Heidi Burgett, Amanda Bush, Teri Fildey, Elizabeth Swain, Brita Zoellner; Honorable Mention: Christina Cambra, Maris Dillman, Shawn Kenyon.
- Donna Holyman led the Buffs with six goals, four assists and a total of 16 points on the season.
- Keeper Sloane Cox recorded 133 saves, one shutout and six wins during her first season for Colorado in the net.

## 1998 Milestones

- Colorado opened the season with a 2-0 loss to 1997 national champion North Carolina in front of a school record 3,000 fans.
- With 36 saves in one weekend, including a school record 19 against BYU on Sept. 11, Sloane Cox became Colorado's career saves leader with 189 (passing Nina Bjornstad who had 158).
- Shawn Kenyon became the first Buff to record 100 shots with No. 100 coming against Utah on Sept. 13.
- CU earned their first ever win in a Big 12 Conference opener with a 3-0 win over Oklahoma on Oct. 2.
- Cox notched the first ever point for a CU goalkeeper with her assist of Jessica Wollow's second goal on Oct. 2 vs. Oklahoma.
- CU ran into its program-worst losing streak with the fifth consecutive loss to Denver 1-0 on Oct. 18.
- With a 6-0 loss to Missouri, the final game of the season, Cox finished her career as the holder of every Colorado goalkeeping record. In addition to her 200th save of the season, Cox also recorded the 333rd save of her career, and had six shutouts.
- Sloane Cox was named to the All-Big 12 second team, the first player in CU soccer history to be named All-Conference.
- Cox was also named Big 12 Athlete of the Week for September 2 (first player in program history to earn the honor) and CU Athlete of the Week for November 1.
- Teri Fildey was named TCI Student Athlete of the Week for September 5.
- Five players were named to the Academic All-Big 12 first team: Fildey, Cartmell, Matassa, Kenyon, Pascoe.
- Melissa Cartmell led the Buffs offense with 50 shots, six goals, two assists and 14 points.
- Assistant coach Kim LeMere was inducted into the University of Hartford's Alumni Hall of Fame on April 17.

- With 12 true freshmen signing letters or walking on, the freshman class was the largest in the program's seven-year history.
- Freshman Fran Munnelly was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Week Sept. 23.
- As of Oct. 18, Munnelly took the lead as CU's all-time frosh leader in points (13), second in goals (5), assists (3) and shots (47) with at least five games left to play.
- Senior goalkeeper Sara Erskine was named Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week Oct. 29.

## 2004 Milestones

- CU was picked to finish third in the Preseason Big 12 Poll and Fran and Laura Munnely were named to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team.
- For the first time in program history, Colorado was ranked in a pair of preseason polls at No. 17 in the nation in the *Soccer America* poll and No. 23 in the *NSCAA/adidas* list.
- CU claimed the Wake Forest/adidas Classic Title. Ashlie Mihalcin was named the tournament's most valuable player and Laura Munnely, Jessica Keller and Katie Griffin were named all-tournament.
- The Buffs won their first two games at Prentup Field.

## 2007 Milestones

- Fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament bid and second straight year playing host to the first and second rounds in Boulder.
- Colorado recorded 10 wins on the season for the sixth straight year.
- Five Buffaloes were named to All-Big 12 Teams.
- Colorado played No. 1 ranked Stanford on Friday, Sept. 21 and the Buffs welcomed a school record 3,128 fans. Head football coach Dan Hawkins and the football team were also in attendance. The record-breaking crowd topped the previous record at Prentup Field by 1,239 people, set last year in the first round of the NCAA Tournament against Colorado College. The all-time record, before the Buffs played No. 1 North Carolina in front of an even 3,000 fans at Pleasant View Soccer Complex.
- CU shut out its opponents on 10 different occasions, marking the fourth time in the history of the program that they have recorded nine or more shutouts in a single season.
- Nikki Marshall's goal against Oklahoma, just 27 seconds into overtime, was the quickest overtime goal in program history, besting the previous mark of 91:06, set by former Buff Melissa Cartmell in 1998, by 39 seconds. Michaela DeJesus' goal in the Utah game came just 52 seconds into the match, going down as the quickest goal in the 11 year history of the program, shattering the previous record of 1:33 set by Jen Almquist vs. Hawai'i in 1996 by 41 seconds.

## 2008 Milestones

- CU earned its sixth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance as a No. 4 seed.
- Colorado recorded 14 wins on the season for just the third time in program history.
- A record high eight Buffaloes were named to All-Big 12 Teams.
- Off the field, six Buffs were named to the All-Big 12 Academic teams.
- On Aug. 29, CU beat Texas Tech 3-2 which started the second longest winning streak in program history with eight consecutive games.
- The Buffs recorded the most on-the-road-wins with six for only the second time in school history since the 2003 season.
- CU shut out its opponents on 15 different occasions, marking the most shutouts in a single season in the history of the program.
- CU attempted a record high 472 shots on the season.
- Colorado tied its previous record most shots in a single game with 37 when they played Iowa State on Oct. 19.
- The Buffs' tallied a record high 191 shots on goal while scoring 43 goals which is the second most goals scored in a season.
- Colorado's impressive 3-2 overtime come-from-behind win at Mississippi on Sept. 12 marks the biggest deficit that CU has recovered from. They were down 2-0 for the first 75 minutes of the game.
