

2010 IN REVIEW



The Buffs kicked off their 2010 season shutting out the first two opponents 2-0. On Aug. 22, CU welcomed the Wyoming Cowgirls to Prentup Field for its home opener. Freshman Annie Brunner found her spot as CU's starting goalkeeper, a position she held for the entire season. Senior Kym Lowry led the team scoring the first goal of the game off an assist from Caroline Danneberg. Lowry later assisted the Buffs' second goal that was scored by Shaye Marshall. Just two days later, the Buffs strung together an almost identical performance beating the University of Northern Colorado 2-0.

Lowry scored the first goal of the game off an assist by Danneberg, and senior Amanda Foulk stepped up to score the second goal as Lowry was credited with the assist.

The Buffs traveled to Denver to take on their in-state rival in the Denver University Invitational. The Pioneers scored early before Hayley Hughes evened the score on an unassisted goal in the 38th minute. DU scored its game-

winner in the 90th minute off a penalty kick giving the Pioneers a 2-1 advantage and the Buffs their first loss of the season. CU dropped its second game of the DU Invitational, falling to UNLV 4-2. Colorado took the lead early at just 6:17 into the first half as Lowry and Kassidy Fitzpatrick worked together to assist Alex Dohm's first goal of the season. UNLV scored its four goals before Taryn Vitacca secured her first career goal on a penalty kick with just two minutes remaining.

Colorado traveled to Spokane, Wash. to compete in the Gonzaga University Tournament Sept 10 & 12. The Buffs suffered its first shutout (2-0) to host Gonzaga. CU regained its confidence and beat Washington State 2-1 in overtime in its second match of the tournament. Hughes scored for CU off an assist from Russell, but the Cougars evened the score just under a minute after the Buffs first goal. The score remained tied 1-1 after 90 minutes of regulation sending the game into overtime. Russell tallied her second assist of the night after setting up Fitzpatrick who scored the game-winner in the 91st minute of play.

CU returned to Boulder with a 3-3 record to host its home tournament, the Omni Hotels Colorado Soccer Classic. The Buffs fell to Purdue 3-1 in their first contest. Foulk scored the first goal of the game early, but the Boilermakers managed three more. The Buffs continued to struggle to score in the next match against No. 10 UCLA, but they came out ahead 1-0 after 108 minutes of action. Freshman Lizzy Herzl stepped into a new position at forward and scored the lone-goal of the game to lift the Buffs over the Bruins. Russell and Lowry assisted on the goal.

CU traveled to College Station, Texas to take on No. 6 Texas A&M in its first Big 12 Conference matchup of 2010. Just over three minutes into the game, Russell scored for CU off an assist

by Hughes. The Aggies evened the score at 1-1 where it remained for the rest of regulation. Identical to the previous win for CU, Herzl took control and blasted the ball into the goal at 98:28 to give the Buffs their first ever win in College Station, Texas and their second win of the season over a top 10 competitor. Fitzpatrick was credited with the assist on Herzl's goal.

Despite the two consecutive upsets the Buffs recorded, CU fell into a scoreless drought for the next four matches. Colorado played Texas to a scoreless tie at home on Sept. 26 after 110 minutes of play. The Buffs then traveled to Texas Tech



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and Baylor but fell 1-0 on both occasions. Missouri visited Prentup Field on Oct. 8, and the Buffaloes continued to struggle on the offensive end of the field as they fell 1-0 to the Tigers.

After 425 minutes of being held scoreless, Marshall found the goal off an assist by Russell to tie the game 1-1 against Iowa State, but Colorado's offense wasn't finished. Russell scored the game-winner and Lowry tapped in another goal to cushion a 3-1 win with assists from Fitzpatrick and Dohm.

On Oct. 14, CU traveled to Oklahoma State to play on a national stage with Fox Soccer Channel televising the contest. OSU scored two goals before the Buffs found the back of the net just after halftime on a Fitzpatrick goal assisted by Russell. CU tied the game as Danneberg assisted a Marshall goal in the 58th minute. The Cowgirls struck again just over a minute later to secure a 3-2 win. The Buffs finished their trip to Oklahoma in Norman, where they fell 2-1 to the Sooners. Russell scored the first goal of the game just 2:44 into the contest. OU responded with two goals of its own, and the Buffs failed to score again.

A last minute addition to the schedule gave the Buffs a chance to improve their record as Seattle visited Prentup Field on Oct. 23. Hughes kicked off the scoring and Seattle evened the score at 1-1 where

it stood through two 10 minute overtime periods giving the Buffs their second tie of the season.

As KU scored its first goal just 18 seconds into the contest on Oct. 25 at Prentup Field, the Buffs knew they had to do something to get the win they needed to make it to the postseason. Amy Barczuk tied the game for CU at 74:20 sending the game into overtime. Anne Stuller scored first in the overtime period off an assist by Foulk giving CU a 2-1 win.

Colorado beat Nebraska 2-1 in the final regular season Big 12 matchup at Prentup Field. Barczuk and Erin Bricker scored the first two goals giving the Buffs a 2-0 lead over the Cornhuskers. Vitacca assisted on the first goal. NU managed to score but the Buffs secured the win.

Only the top eight teams in the Big 12 get to move on to the postseason Big 12 Championships in San Antonio, Texas, and CU's win over Nebraska made them eligible for the tournament as the eighth seed. The Buffs were paired with Texas A&M in the first round. Both teams were held scoreless through 110 minutes of play sending both teams into a shootout with five attempts each in order to decide who moved on. The Aggies beat CU 5-4 eliminating the Buffs from the tournament. CU ended its roller coaster of a season with an 8-9-3 record overall

COLORADO SOCCER IN THE BIG 12 CONFERENCE

The 2010 season wraps up Big 12 Conference play as Colorado moves to the Pac-12 Conference starting prior to the 2011 season. Colorado was a charter member of the Big 12 Conference which began in 1996. CU soccer holds a 69-66-14 all-time record within the conference. The Buffaloes won the 2003 Big 12 regular season championship, and have made a total of six NCAA Tournament appearances. Twenty-six Buffaloes have earned All-Big 12 awards and 56 have been named to the league's all-academic team.
