# BIG 12 CONFERENCE CHAMPIONS

In 2003, when Jen Thais said in a preseason press conference that her season goal was, "to make the NCAA Tournament and to be nationally recognized. What I'm hoping... what I'm expecting, is to surprise people," little did she know what kind of impact that prediction would have on the eighth team in Colorado soccer history... and the nation for that matter.

A record breaking season was approached in four phases. Phase I were the preseason exhibition games where the Buffs shutout Northern Colorado 4-0 and Air Force 3-0.

Phase II consisted of CU's non-conference schedule where the Buffs came out virtually unscathed at 7-1. In the season opener, they held defending national champion and then-No. 2 Portland scoreless for 87 minutes before suffering a 1-0 defeat. The Buffs would regroup and close out the remainder of the non-conference season 7-0, beating teams by a 17-2 scoring margin. It was during Phase II that CU picked up its first-ever win against a top-10 ranked opponent when it handed then-No. 9 Denver a 3-0 blanking, just days after the Pioneers had upended Portland.

Enter Phase III... the Big 12 Conference season. The Buffs came away from the '03 season 8-1-1, the crescendo of the season being a 3-1 win over nemesis Nebraska in the season finale for both teams in below freezing temperatures on a pitch covered in ice. Colorado's 25 season points was the fourth highest in league standings history. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Buffs came away with the coach, player and rookie of the year, a first-team All-Big 12 pick, three second-teamers and five of their nine newcomers named to the All-Newcomer team.

With 25 school single-season, class and career records shattered, Colorado entered the final phase of the season, Phase IV... the postseason. They went into the eighth Big 12 Conference Tournament as the No. 1 seed for the first time in program history, and a week later the Buffs entered their first NCAA Tournament as just one of 16 seeded teams.
