To reach Prentup Field **from campus**, take Colorado Blvd. east through the inter-sections of 28th and 30th Streets. Take your first left (unmarked) on to 33rd Street. After several speed bumps and the University's Day Care Center, take a right into a dirt parking lot. Prentup Field is on the left. **From Foothills Parkway**, travel west on Colorado, take a right on Innovation Drive and follow that into a dirt parking lot. The field is on the right just past the track complex and ski building.

PRENTUP FIELD INFORMATION

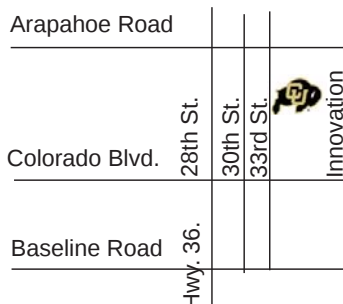
- There is bleacher seating available for approximately 750 people.

- Lawnchairs and outside food and drinks are welcome.

- Alcohol is prohibited within the confines of Prentup Field and nearby Potts Field (track).

- Animals, other than service dogs, are prohibited.

- Admission and parking for regular season games is free of charge.
