

2008 BIG 12 OUTDOOR T&F CHAMPIONSHIP/ 2013 PAC-12 XC CHAMPIONSHIP



The CU men's track and field team won its first Big 12 Conference Outdoor Track & Field title at Potts Field on May 18, 2008. Colorado scored a school record 138 points in a Big 12 meet and defeated top-ranked Texas A&M by 17 points (121). The Buffs had four individual champions in seniors Billy Nelson (3,000-meter steeplechase), Brent Vaughn (5k), James Begley (discus) and junior Kenyon Neuman (10k). CU also recorded 32 points in the 5,000-meter run and 33 points in the 10k.



The top-ranked CU men's cross country team captured their third straight Pac-12 Championship in front of a home crowd of over 5,000 at the Coal Creek Golf Course in Louisville, Colo. The Buffs soundly defeated runner-up No. 4 Oregon 28-54. No. 13 Stanford was third with 79 points. CU impressed by placing all five of its scorers in the top nine, going 3-4-5-7-9. Less than a month later, the Buffs went on to win their fourth NCAA Championship.
