



2008 IN REVIEW

REVIEW

Colorado had a rebuilding year in 2008. The Buffs recorded a non-conference record of 6-3 and was 7-13 in the Big 12. They were tied for eighth in the league with Kansas and Missouri. Overall, CU finished 13-16 overall and below the .500 mark for the second straight year.

For the first time in the history of the program, the Buffs started off the year with six straight wins, all coming on the road. CU rattled off three wins at the Mississippi State Classic against Troy, Arkansas-Pine Bluff and Mississippi State; all three victories came in three sets. **Alex Buth** and **Kaitlyn Burkett** were named to the all-tournament team and **Lauren Schaefer** was named the tournament's MVP. Schaefer led the Buffs with 2.62 kills and 0.88 blocks per set while attacking at a .613 clip.

The following week, Colorado continued its winning ways with three more wins against Arkansas-Little Rock, Texas Southern and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi at the Islander Holiday Inn-Emerald Beach Invitational. UALR took the Buffs to four sets, but CU blanked the other two matches to capture their second straight tournament of the season. This time around Schaefer and **Amber Sutherland** were named to the all-tournament team while Buth was named the MVP. She recorded 3.80 kills and 3.30 digs per set and hit .369.

The Buffs hit a rough patch when they returned home to host three top teams at the Colorado Invitational in the Coors Events Center. No. 21 Colorado State, No. 8 Florida and North Carolina all won in four sets. The Buffs became the first team to take a set from Florida on the year. All three of those teams advanced to the NCAA Tournament at the end of the year. It was the first time ever that the Buffs did not win a match at their home tournament.

Despite dropping the final three matches of the non-conference schedule, the Buffs finished the 20th straight season above .500 in non-conference matches (6-3).

The Big 12 Conference part of the schedule got off to a better start for the Buffs in 2008. CU went to five-sets against Kansas at Coors but was able to finish it off and record its first conference win. A big part of the win was freshman middle blocker **Alex Penewell** who started in place of an injured Schaefer. She led the Buffs with 14 kills and eight block assists while attacking at a .600 clip.

CU fell to No. 18 K-State later that week in Manhattan, Kan. but bounced back to defeat Texas A&M at home; another win that came in five sets. This time it was Buth who stepped up to lead the Buffs. She hammered 26 kills, 17 digs and hit .429. For her performance, Buth was named a CVU.com Top Performer for the week.

The Buffs dropped the next two matches against Baylor and No. 2 Nebraska; both in three sets. But Colorado followed it up by sweeping Texas Tech at home. **Emilee Sisco** led CU with 12 kills and hit .478. Once again CU dropped the next two matches. The Buffs did pick up a set against No. 3 Texas (19-25, 23-25, 25-21, 20-25) but was swept by Oklahoma a few days later.



Colorado came back home and picked up a five-set victory against Iowa State, pushing the Cyclones to extra points in game two and four to secure the win. Buth and Sutherland each recorded 17 kills and Webster recorded a season-high 25 digs. Buth also put up eight block assists. The Buffs were led by Edelman with nine total block and Penewell also recorded eight block. The Buffs put up 17.5 on the night.

CU had a tough time winning on the road during conference play in 2008 and its woes continued at Missouri, losing in three. But the following match CU did pick up its first road victory on against Texas Tech on Oct. 25. The win didn't come easy though as the Buffs had to fight back after dropping the first two sets to the Red Raiders and took the fifth frame 19-17. Sutherland had her best match of the year as she hammered 21 kills to lead the Buffs.

Colorado returned home to take on No. 2 Nebraska in front of 2,817 at the CEC. The home fans were in for a treat as the Buffs shocked the Huskers and won in four sets (25-19, 27-25, 18-25, 25-16); handing NU its first loss of the season. It was the second time in three years that the Buffs defeated the Huskers, becoming just the second team to beat NU twice in a five-year span. Sisco recorded 17 kills in the victory and the Buffs put up 14.5 team blocks compared to 8.0 by the Huskers. Webster collected 16 digs and went on to be named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week.

After their thrilling victory against Nebraska, the Buffs dropped the seven if its last eight matches, including the next six straight. They came close to pushing No. 14 Kansas State to a fifth set at home (25-23, 20-25, 18-25, 25-27) but a close call went in the favor of the Wildcats to end the match.

CU's last win of the season came against Oklahoma on senior night. The Buffs sent the five seniors out in style by sweeping OU 26-24, 25-22, 25-23. Sutherland led the seniors with 13 kills and Webster picked up 19 digs.

The senior class left its mark on the CU record book and was led by Sutherland. Sutherland left CU in the top 10 in career kills (10th; 1,142) and attacks (ninth; 2,954). She was also 21st in assists (123) and 15th in digs (863). Schaefer was fourth in career attack percentage (.306) and seventh in blocks (311). She was tied for 23rd in kills (786) and 24th in attacks (1,831). Buth, who started her career as a serving specialist for the Buffs, was 15th in service aces (86), 16th in kills (865), 16th in attacks (2,235), 14th in assists (209), 18th in digs (802) and 22nd in attack percentage (.223). Callie Webster recorded 1,042 digs as a Buffalo, which ranks 12th overall.

Several Buffs were recognized for their accomplishments off the court. Buth was named to the Academic All-Big 12 First Team for the fourth straight year, while Burkett, Schaefer, Sutherland and **Ashley VenHorst** were named to the second team. Buth was also named to the Big 12 Fall Chick-Fil-A Community of Champions.
