



2009 IN REVIEW

The University of Colorado volleyball team had some ups and some downs during the 2009 season, finishing with a 7-22 overall record. The Buffs recorded a 2-18 record in the Big 12 (10th place) and were 5-4 in the non-conference portion of their schedule; finishing above .500 for the 21st straight year.

The season started on a good note for CU, winning the first match under coach **Liz Kritza** against Valparaiso at the Campus USA Credit Union Invitational. The Buffs swept the Crusaders (31-29, 25-23, 25-21). Sophomore **Becah Fogle** led the team with 17 kills while junior **Ellen Henry** recorded a match-high 15 digs. Redshirt freshman **Megan Cyr** started her first match and handed out 37 assists and posted three blocks to lead the Buffs. CU returned the following night for a match against then-No. 8 Florida but fell in three sets (25-20, 25-22, 25-15). Senior **Kaitlyn Burkett** was named to the all-tournament team after recording 12 kills, 15 assist, five blocks, 14.5 points and hitting .440.

The following week was a busy one as CU traveled to Greeley, Colo. to face in-state rival Northern Colorado. The Bears downed CU in three sets (25-20, 25-17, 25-16). A few days later the Buffs returned to the east coast for the Yale Invitational. It started off well as CU recorded a pair of wins against Fairfield (29-27, 25-20, 25-19) and Georgetown (18-25, 25-17, 25-27, 26-24). CU fell to host Yale (25-22, 25-11, 25-9). Fogle and freshman **Kerra Schroeder** were named to the all-tournament team.

Colorado closed out the non-conference portion of its schedule with the Colorado/Denver Invitational, co-hosting with DU. The Buffs started the tournament at DU and won in straight sets (26-24, 25-18, 25-20). CU then finally came to Boulder to play its first match of the season at the Coors Events Center and fell in three to then-No. 24 San Diego (26-24, 25-21, 25-16). The following night the Buffs faced Cal Poly and won the match (25-19, 28-26, 26-24) to improve their record to 5-4. Sophomore **Rosie Steinhaus** and Fogle were selected to the all-tournament team.

The Big 12 schedule started out on a very rough note for the Buffs, facing three top-10 teams in then-No. 10 Iowa State, No. 8 Nebraska and No. 2 Texas. CU dropped all three matches in straight sets. Things didn't get any better for the Buffs as they fell to Oklahoma, Kansas, Baylor and Missouri before coming up with their first Big 12 win against Texas Tech at home. CU won in four sets and was led by Steinhaus' 16 kills to snap the seven-match losing streak.

After the win the Buffs dropped the next six matches against Texas A&M, Kansas State, Texas, Oklahoma, Iowa State and Kansas. Colorado traveled to Lubbock, Texas and beat the Texas Tech Red Raiders in three sets. It was the first road win of the Big 12 season. Fogle was the leader for CU with 14 kills and 15 digs.

The Buffs finished out the season by losing the final five matches against Baylor, Missouri, Kansas State, Texas A&M and Nebraska. In the final match against NU, Burkett reached the 3,000-career assist mark to become one of six Buffs to ever reach that milestone. She ended her career with 3,001.

Fogle finished the season with 289 kills to lead the team. Steinhaus recorded 243 and Schroeder added 236. Fogle also led the team with 225 digs. **Nikki Kinzer** was the top blocker, posting 64 total blocks.

Several Buffs were recognized for their accomplishments off the court. Steinhaus was named to the Academic All-Big 12 First Team and Burkett was named to the second team. Burkett was also named to the Big 12 Fall Chick-Fil-A Community of Champions.
