



2010 IN REVIEW

The University of Colorado volleyball team continued to go through some growing pains during the 2010 season, finishing 6-20 overall, 3-17 in the Big 12 Conference. The Buffs placed 10th in the league and finished the non-conference portion of the schedule with a 3-3 record, finishing above .500 for the 22nd straight year.

The Buffs started the year with a three-set win (25-22, 25-22, 25-19) against Furman at the Coors Events Center before falling in five to Duke (18-25, 28-25, 25-18, 16-25, 10-15). CU followed up that loss with a three set defeat (19-25, 22-25, 16-25) at the hands of No. 15 Colorado State.

Colorado then hit the road to compete at the Crowne Plaza Fullerton Titan Classic in Fullerton, Calif. CU went 2-1, defeating Georgia State (25-22, 23-25, 25-17, 25-22) and Montana (21-25, 29-27, 25-14, 19-25, 18-16) before falling to Cal State Fullerton in three (23-25, 22-25, 21-25). **Kerra Schroeder** and **Anicia Santos** were both named to the all-tournament team and Schroeder was named the CU Athlete of the Week for her performance. She recorded 51 kills (4.25 kills per set), hit .220 and recorded 25 digs and five blocks. **Megan Beckwith** was CU's top defensive threat. She recorded 73 digs in three matches; 30 of those came against Georgia State.

CU had the next week-end off to prepare for its final season as a member of the Big 12 Conference. The Buffs started the conference season with two three-set losses to Oklahoma and No. 4 Nebraska. Colorado seemed to bounce back from those defeats, taking the next two matches against Kansas State and Kansas, both in five sets at the Coors Events Center. **Alyssa**

Valentine was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week after helping the Buffs to back-to-back conference wins for the first time since 2008. She averaged 10.60 assists per set and led the Buffs to a .228 hitting percentage.

The Buffs fought hard to earn a third straight league match, but fell just short after losing 22-25, 17-25, 25-18, 25-23, 6-15 against Texas A&M on Sept. 29. CU would drop the next three matches in three sets to Missouri, No. 11 Texas and Baylor.

Things looked up for CU when it traveled to Lubbock, Texas to face-off against the Red Raiders, although the match did not start off on a good note. The Buffs dropped the first two sets to TTU, 24-26, 20-25, and needed to rally back. They fought hard and won the next two sets 25-15, 26-24, but it wasn't over as there was still a fifth and deciding set left to play. The two teams fought back-and-forth, but no one could get the two-point lead needed to win until the Buffs finished the contest 28-26. CU recorded 123 points in the match, the most by

any NCAA Division I team during the 25-point rally scoring format. Schroeder recorded a career-high 35 kills, the third most in school history, and was named the Big 12 and CU Athlete of the Week for the performance.

Despite earning three wins during the first nine matches of the conference schedule, the Buffs seemed to

fade. They finished out the season by losing the final 11 matches. They put up a good fight in the final two matches, falling in five sets to Texas Tech and Kansas State.

Schroeder finished the season with 372 kills to lead the team and ranked sixth in the Big 12 with 3.84 per set. She was also sixth in the league with 4.29 points per set. Schroeder also set the sophomore season attacks record after averaging 12.04 attacks per set, break AVP and former CU standout Rachel Wacholder's record of 11.60.

Beckwith led the team with 401 digs and ranked seventh in the conference with 4.18 digs per set. She set the freshman record for digs in a match (30), as well as digs in a season and digs per set. Valentine ranked ninth in the Big 12 with 8.62 assists per set. The top blocker for CU was **Nikki Lindow**. She averaged 0.74 blocks per set.

Several Buffs were recognized for their accomplishments off the court. **Rosie Steinhaus** was named to the Academic All-Big 12 First Team and Schroeder was named to the second team.
