1989 Milestones

- ✓ **Sept. 1** — Mike McLean replaces Brad Saindon as the second coach in CU history as Saindon takes a leave to coach the US National Team. After three years as team manager, Pi'i Aiu becomes an assistant coach.
- ✓ **Sept. 2** — The Buffs win their first early season tournament title as they knock off three opponents in two days at the Grand Prix Classic in San Diego.
- ✓ **Sept. 8** — With 24 digs in a three game match, Tina Murray sets a record that still stands.
- ✓ **Sept. 16** — With 11 blocks against Indiana, Wendy Van Wyhe sets a three-game CU record that still stands.
- ✓ **Sept. 16** — The Buffs win their first Colorado Invitational by beating Pepperdine 3-1.
- ✓ **Nov. 17** — With 15 blocks at Texas, Lisa Soulliere sets a single-match CU record that still stands.
- ✓ **Dec. 2** — The Buffs play in their first-ever NCAA Tournament, a 3-1 loss at Minnesota in the first round.
- ✓ **SEASON** — CU would rank as high as No. 9 and ends the season with a 22-11 mark.
- ✓ **SEASON** — Tina Murray becomes the program's first All-American, as she is an honorable mention from Volleyball Magazine. She is also the first Buff to go over 1,000 career digs.
- ✓ **SEASON** — Lisa Soulliere leads the Big Eight with 169 total blocks and an average of 1.4 per game.
- ✓ **SEASON** — Soulliere and Murray are both first-team All-Big Eight selections.
