1994 Milestones

- ✓ **Oct. 25**—The Buffs finish the best run in school history. Not only did the Buffs win 10 straight matches, which still ties the program record, but they swept all 10 teams to win 30 straight games.
- ✓ **Nov. 16**—The Buffs match against Nebraska draws 3,685 to the Events Center, still the school record.
- ✓ **Dec. 4**—The Buffs earn their fourth straight trip to the NCAA Tournament, fifth overall and sixth straight trip to the post season as they earn a first-round bye and defeat Northern Iowa in the second round for their second straight Sweet 16 appearance.
- ✓ **AWARDS**—Karrie Downey is named fist-team all-district, while Leah Williams makes the second team. They both are named first-team all-Big Eight.
- ✓ **STAT SHOTS**—Downey surpasses Tina Murray in both career kills, digs and attacks and goes out as the all-time Big Eight leader in all three categories. She has a CU record 41 digs against Iowa State on Nov. 5 and her 4.39 digs per game average is the only instance in CU history when a player has averaged over 4.0 per game.
- ✓ **STAT SHOTS**—Staci Wolfe records 31 kills against Texas A&M on Sept. 18, setting a record for four games that still stands and surpassing the 1,000 kill plateau in what would be her last match. She was the fourth player to reach 1,000 kills and just a match earlier was the fifth to reach 1,000 digs for a career.
- ✓ **STAT SHOTS**—Janine Zumerchik became the fifth Buff to record 1,000 career kills, and is still the only middle blocker in CU history over 1,000 kills.
- ✓ **STAT SHOTS**—Rachel Wacholder led the Big Eight in conference matches with 22 aces in 37 games, averaging .60 per game.
