1995 Milestones

- ✓ **Oct. 21** – CU falls at Nebraska in three games before a then-NCAA record crowd of 11,529.
- ✓ **Nov. 24** – Playing against Iowa State in the last Big Eight Conference Tournament, Rachel Wacholder shatters the NCAA record for attacks in a four-game match with a mind-blowing 106.
- ✓ **Nov. 29** – The Buffs make their fifth straight NCAA Tournament, sixth overall and seventh straight post-season appearance as they travel to Northern Iowa, who earned revenge against the Buffs who beat them in the 1994 NCAA Tournament and swept CU to end its season.
- ✓ **AWARDS** – Leah Williams is named first-team all-district and first-team all-Big Eight. Sarah Lodge earns the Big Eight Newcomer of the Year award, the first CU player to earn that honor.
- ✓ **STAT SHOTS** – Leah Williams led the Big Eight conference with a 1.64 blocks per game average, a mark that was good for sixth in the NCAA. That average and her 177 total blocks are still CU records.
- ✓ **STAT SHOTS** – Rachel Wacholder becomes the sixth player in program history to reach 1,000 kills and the sixth to reach 1,000 digs, in doing so she became the fourth to reach 1,000 in both. Her 34 digs against Georgia Tech in five games is still the CU record for five games and her 40 against Iowa State at the Big Eight Tournament is just the second time a player's had 40 or more digs.
