CYCLONE QUICK HITTERS

- Iowa State will make its third-straight trip to the NCAA Regional, earning a spot in the NCAA West Regional, May 10-12 at the Colorado National Golf Course in Erie, Colo.
- ISU has placed 10th in the last two seasons at the NCAA Regional, missing out on a spot at the NCAA Championships by five shots both times.
- It marks the seventh NCAA Regional appearance in school history for the Cyclones (1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 2010, 2011, 2012).
- Iowa State is ranked 37th nationally by Golfstat and 37th nationally by Golfweek.
- The Cyclones tied for fourth at the Big 12 Championships on April 27-29, equaling the best finish

at the Big 12 Meet.

- Iowa State's top-five are all averaging 76.81 strokes or better and all five players have at least one top-10 performance this year.

- Sophomore Prima Thammaraks leads the team with a 75.67 stroke average and is tied for the team lead with three top-10 finishes.

- Junior Punpaka Phuntumabamrung was Iowa State's top finisher at the Big 12 Championships, tying for eighth to earn all-tournament honors.

- Phuntumabamrung has finished in the top-10 in her last three tournaments.

- Iowa State has placed fourth or tied for fourth in the last three Big 12 Championships.

FALL TOURNAMENT RECAPS AND SCORES

Dale McNamara Invitational

The Cyclones placed fourth at the 15-team Dale McNamara Invitational. The Cyclones fired a 290 in the third round for a three-day 888 total, the 11th-best 54-hole total in school history.

Freshman Chonlada Chayanun made an auspicious debut for the Cyclones, leading the team with a three-round 221 tally. Chayanun fired rounds of 75-73-73 to tie for ninth.

Dick McGuire Invitational

The Iowa State women's golf team finished seventh in the 18-team McGuire Invitational field. The Cyclones carded a 302 in the final round for an 899 total, 12 shots behind first-place Baylor at 887.

For the second time in as many tries, true freshman Chonlada Chayanun led the Cyclones by tying for 14th with a 223 (76-70-77) total. Chayanun has finished 14th or better in her first two meets to begin her career.

Windy City Collegiate Classic

The Iowa State women's golf team finished in 14th place at the Windy City Collegiate Classic. The Cyclones fired a 299 in the third round to card out their tournament total at 908. Oklahoma State won the tournament with an 882.

Sophomore Prima Thammaraks fired a 219 to tie for seventh place, her first top-10 finish of the season. Senior Kristin Paulson and Junior Pimpaka Phuntumabamrung each fired a 230 to tie for 46th place.

Lady Northern Intercollegiate

The Iowa State women's golf team placed fourth at the Lady Northern Intercollegiate. The Cyclones fired a 301 on the final day of the invite to round out their tournament total at 896. UCF won the tournament by carding a 887.

Senior Kristin Paulson fired a 220 in a career-best fourth place finish. It is Paulson's second career top-10 finish and first of the season. Earning her second top-10 finish of the season was sophomore Prima Thammaraks, who tied for sixth place with a 222. Freshman Chonlada Chayanun tied for 18th with a 227 and sophomore Sasikarn On-iam tied for 23rd with a 232.

The Landfall Tradition

The Iowa State women's golf team ended its fall season with a solid showing, tying for fifth at the ultra-competitive Landfall Tradition field. The Cyclones carded their tournament-best 302 this afternoon for a 54-hole 923 tally.

Sophomore Sasikarn On-iam posted her best finish of the season, garnering the third top-10 performance of her career by tying for ninth with a 226 (77-73-76). Kristin Paulson and Prima Thammaraks both tied for 24th at 232.

SPRING TOURNAMENT RECAPS AND SCORES

Lady Puerto Rico Classic

Iowa State finished ninth at the competitive Lady Puerto Rico Classic. The Cyclones tallied their best round of the tournament with a 300 for a three-day 914 total. No. 6 LSU won the tournament, carding an 884.

Freshman Chonlada Chayanun paced the Cyclones throughout the entire tournament. She fired a 223 with rounds of 73-74-76 to tie for 12th place. Sophomore Sasikarn On-iam tied for 21st, scoring a 226. On-iam tied her career low with a 69 in the final round on the final day.

Central District Invitational

The Cyclones finished seventh at the Central District Invitational. The Cyclones fired a 298 in the third round for a tournament total of 894. TCU won the tournament title at 882.

Sophomore Sasikarn On-iam posted the best tournament of her career, finishing third at 216 after carding a final-round 69. On-iam, broke her previous career-low 54-hole total, tying for the ninth-best 54-hole score in school history. It was the second-straight tournament where On-iam carded a 69, which ties her career low round.

Notre Dame Clover Cup

Iowa State tied for eighth at the Clover Cup. The Cyclones fired a 316 in the final round to bring their team total to 915. Colorado posted an 855 to win the tournament.

Sophomore Prima Thammaraks tied for 17th with a three-round 225 total. Thammaraks shot rounds of 70-76-79. Freshman Chonlada Chayanun fired a 74 in the final round to help her finish 32nd (78-79-74=231).

Mountain View Collegiate

The Cyclones finished second at the 15-team Mountain View Collegiate. Iowa State shot a three-round 865 total, the second-best 54-hole score in school history. ISU's final-round 284 ties for the third-lowest 18-hole score in the school record book.

The Iowa State contingent all shot 74 or lower in the final round, led by Kristin Paulson's 69, her second sub-70 round of her career. Prima Thammaraks and Pimpaka Phuntumabamrung led the Cyclones, tying for ninth at 216. It was the sixth career top-10 performance for both players, as Phuntumabamrung notched her best 54-hole score of her career.

Lady Buckeye Invitational

The Iowa State women's golf team finished third at the Lady Buckeye Spring Invitational in Columbus, Ohio. Competing against a field which included five top-50 teams, the 37th-ranked Cyclones fired a 304 in the final round to post a three-round score of 921. Ohio State won the tournament at 894.

Iowa State's Pimpaka Phuntumabamrung continued her excellent play in the final round, carding a 71 this afternoon to help her finish runner-up in the medalist race at 220. The junior now has two top-10 finishes on the year. Sophomore Prima Thammaraks fired a 233 to tie for 17th place and sophomore Sasikarn On-iam posted a 235 to tie for 25th.

Big 12 Championships

The Iowa State women's golf team tied for fourth at the Big 12 Championships after carding a 300 in the final round this at the Lawrence Country Club. The Cyclones shot a 913 total, just two shots out of second place. Oklahoma won the team title at 904.

Iowa State has placed fourth in the last three Big 12 Championships, equaling its best finish in the tournament since the Big 12 was formed in 1997.

Junior Punpaka Phuntumabamrung led the Cyclones by tying for eighth behind a final-round 73 to earn all-tournament team honors. Phuntumabamrung, who shot a 226 total (78-75-73), has bounced back from a slow start in the spring by placing in the top-10 in her last three tournaments. She now has eight top-10 performances in her career.

Sophomores Sasikarn On-iam and Prima Thammaraks finished in the top-20, placing 12th and tying for 16th, respectively. On-iam was at 227 (75-74-78) and Thammaraks carded a 74 in the final round for a 231 tally (78-79-74).

THE COACHING STAFF



Christie Martens,
head coach

- Eighth season at Iowa State
- Big 12 Coach of the Year (2011)

Through relentless hard work, determination and tireless recruiting, Christie Martens has firmly established the Iowa State women's golf program as one of the nation's best.

The Iowa State administration affirmed Martens' outstanding coaching abilities by signing her to a contract extension through 2015 in May of 2010.

Martens, who is in her eighth season as the head coach with the Cyclones, saw the first signs of her rebuilding project come to fruition in 2009-10, as Iowa State recorded one of its finest seasons in school history. The Cyclones finished fourth at the Big 12 Championships, their best finish ever, and qualified for the NCAA West Regional, the school's first postseason appearances since 1996.

Martens and her Cyclones trumped the 2009-10 campaign with a record-shattering 2010-11 season, as Iowa State achieved its highest ranking in school history (No. 15), won three tournament titles and recorded 11 of the top-12 18-hole team scores in the program's history. The Cyclones as a team averaged 297.6 strokes per round in 2011, an average of over five shots lower than the old school mark set the previous season.

Iowa State was the No. 1 seed at the 2011 Big 12 Championships, qualified for its second consecutive NCAA Regional berth and finished the season ranked in the nation's top-20 to cap off its record-setting season. Martens was rewarded for her efforts, earning 2011 Big 12 Coach of the Year honors and NGCA Central Region Coach of the Year accolades.

A key ingredient to Martens' success at Iowa State has been her ability to surround herself with outstanding players. A total of eight Cyclones have earned All-Big 12 recognition nine times in her Iowa State tenure: (Louise Kenney-2005; Jessica Shin-2006; Pennapa Pulsawath-2010; Laurence

Herman-2010, 2011; Punpaka Phuntum-abamrung-2010; Prima Thammaraks-2011; Victoria Stefansen-2011 and Sasikarn On-iam-2011).

The Cyclones have broken virtually every team scoring record under Martens' watch, including shattering the school mark for best 54-hole score of 857 at the 2011 Mountain View Collegiate. The top-11 54-hole team scores in Iowa State history have occurred under Marten's tutelage, as well as the top-15 18-hole team scores in the Cyclone record books.

Martens has established herself as an outstanding recruiter on a national and international scale. Martens has been instrumental in getting highly touted international players like Pulsawath (Thailand), Phuntumabamrung (Thailand), Thammaraks (Thailand), On-iam (Thailand), Stefansen (Denmark) and Herman (Belgium) to enroll at Iowa State.

Iowa State golfers have also succeeded in the classroom under Martens, as 10 Cyclones have gone on to earn academic All-Big 12 honors 20 times.

As an assistant at Purdue from 2001-05, Martens helped lead the Boilermakers women's team to a 22nd-place finish at the 2004 NCAA Championship. Purdue finished in 12th place in 2003 and 16th in 2002. In Martens' first season in West Lafayette, Ind., the Purdue women's golf team placed fourth at the 2002 NCAA Central Regional and second at the Big Ten Championship. The Boilermakers were fourth at the Central Regional and Big Ten Championships in 2003. In 2004, Purdue finished fourth in the Big Ten and sixth at the NCAA Central Regional.

Martens earned a bachelor's degree in learning and organizational change from Northwestern University in 2001. A three-time academic all-Big Ten honoree, she captained the 2000 Wildcat team, which was the first NU women's squad to advance to the NCAA Championships. The former Northwestern record-holder for 54-holes, Martens placed among the top-10 finishers at the 1999 Big Ten Championship. She received the Walter K. Smart scholarship at Northwestern, recognizing a student-athlete who achieves in both academics and athletics.

Martens, a native of Dixon, Ill., played in the 2000 U.S. Women's Amateur in Asheville, N.C. The former Christie Hermes, Martens and her husband Bobby, were married in Oct. 2005. They have one daughter, Norah (3) and an infant son, Lucas.

- Fifth season at Iowa State

Pina Gentile is in her fifth season with the Iowa State women's golf program, helping the Cyclones achieve national recognition in her time in Ames.

Iowa State qualified for back-to-back NCAA Regional appearances (2010, 2011), recorded its best finishes at the Big 12 Championships (4th-2010, 4th-2011) and has set numerous team records in her four years as a member of the Iowa State staff.

The Cyclones posted their highest ranking in school history (No. 15) and won three tournament titles in the 2010-11 campaign, as Iowa State earned the No. 1 seed at the 2011 Big 12 Championships.

Gentile has also helped tutor six Cyclones who have earned All-Big 12 recognition, including 2010 All-Big 12 First-Team recipient Pennapa Pulsawath. Pulsawath ended her career in 2010 as Iowa State's leader in career (76.30) stroke average.

Gentile spent six seasons on the Illinois State staff before arriving in Ames.

Gentile was hired fulltime at Illinois State in 2005 after previously serving as a volunteer assistant.

She helped lead the Redbirds to Missouri Valley Conference Tournament titles in both men's and women's golf in 2005.

Gentile earned her Ladies Professional Golf Association (LPGA) Teaching and Club Professional Division card in 2000.

She has worked as an assistant golf professional at Crestwicke Country Club in Bloomington, Ill., and Edgewood Valley Country Club in LaGrange, Ill.

A four-year letterwinner at Illinois State, Gentile helped lead the Redbirds to the 1997 Missouri Valley Championship.
