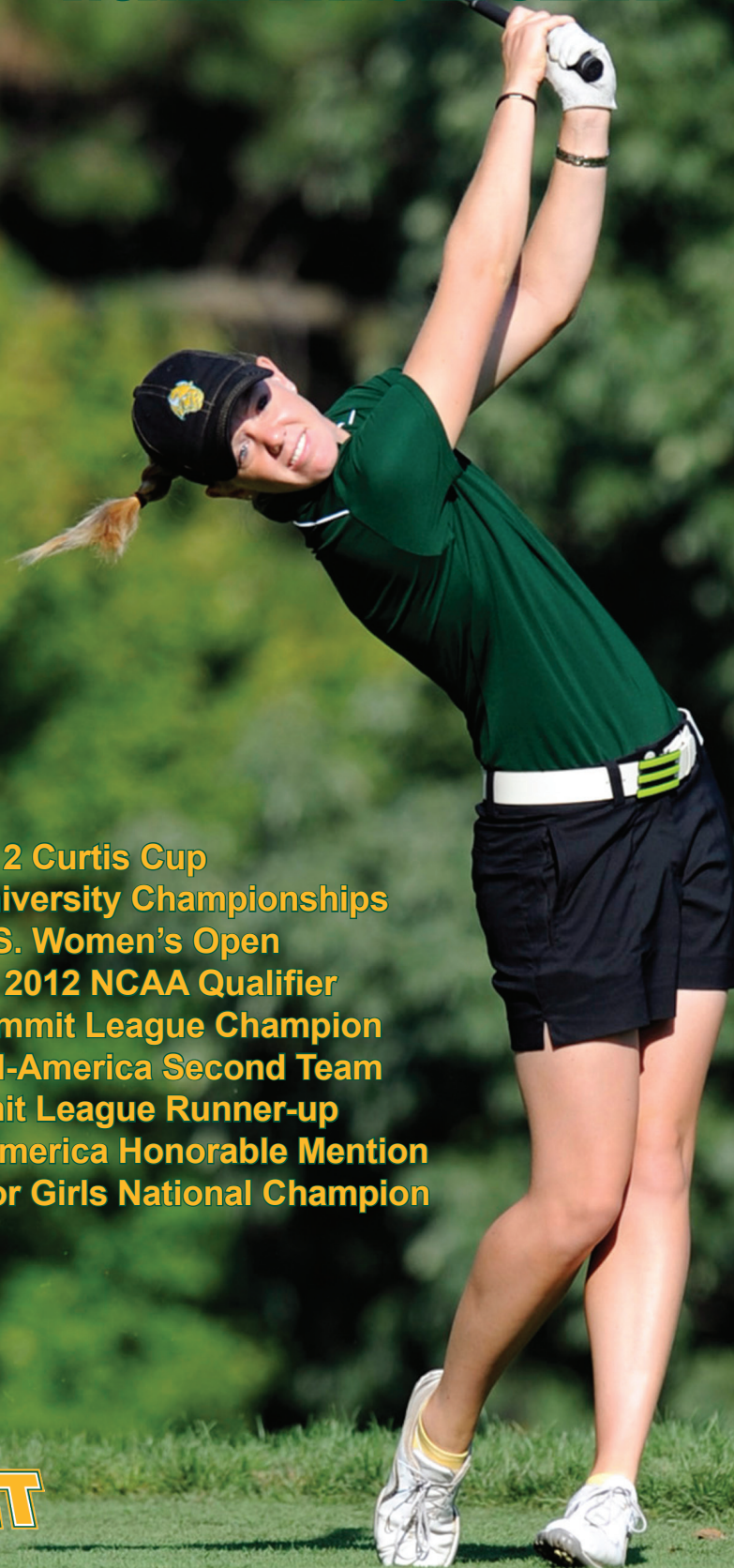

2011-12 (Junior): All-Summit League first team for the third straight season...Summit League championship MVP and individual champion for the second straight year after shooting 2-over 218 and defending her league title with a three-shot win over Southern Utah freshman Monica Jung...Tied her own school record with five tournament victories for the third straight year, running her career total to 15 wins...Capped the regular season with back-to-back titles including her third victory in three years at the Creighton Golf Classic...Named Summit League co-Golfer of the Week for her win at Creighton, where she shot a 5-over 149 in the 36-hole event...Summit League leader by almost three full strokes with a 73.00 average through 25 rounds entering the NCAA West Regional...Shot a school-record 67 in the final round to win at Campbell on Nov. 1 and topped that with a 66 in the final round of the South Dakota State Jackrabbit Invitational on March 13...Scheduled to play for Team USA in the Curtis Cup Match in Scotland in June and the World University Golf Championships in the Czech Republic in July.

2010-11 (Sophomore): Repeated as Summit League Golfer of the Year and All-Summit League first team...Selected to the National Golf Coaches Association Division I All-America second team...Qualified for her second straight NCAA regional tournament as an individual...Tied for 11th place at the West Regional with a 5-over 221...Shot par 72 in the first two rounds and a 77 in the final round...Birdied the No. 18 and qualified for nationals by one shot as the second of two individuals...Tied for 12th at the NCAA championship with a 2-over 290, which was the best national finish in the 14-year history of Summit League women's golf...Entered the final round in fifth and moved as high as second before five bogeys on the back nine...NCAA Elite 88 award winner as student-athlete with highest cumulative GPA at the national championship site (4.0)...Earned a spot in the USGA Women's Open two days after the NCAA championship by winning a qualifier in Medina, Minn., with a 3-under 141...Beat out 34 other golfers for medalist honors including seven professionals...Named the "Non-School Athlete of the Year" by the North Dakota Associated Press Sportscasters and Sportswriters Association in June 2011 for the feat...Was tied for the U.S. Open lead with professional Cristie Kerr at 2-under-par after the weather-shortened first day and went on to a 63rd-place finish...Advanced to the match play semifinals at the Women's TRANS Amateur and lost in the second round of match play at the U.S. Women's Amateur...Was named Summit League Championship MVP in April after winning the league tournament by three shots with a 6-over 219...Won five of 11 tournaments during the year...Three of her five wins were in the spring half of the regular season when she had zero outdoor practices due to weather...Summit League leader by more than two strokes with a school-record 73.10 average over 31 rounds...Broke two of her own school records with a 68 in the final round to win the South Dakota State Jackrabbit Invitational and a 36-hole score of 144 to win the Nebraska Chip-N Club Invitational in September...The SDSU win helped set a team 54-hole tournament record by seven shots with a 927...Shot a 1-under 70 in the final round of the league championship to help NDSU to a school-record round of 302...Named Summit League Golfer of the Week twice after her win at South Dakota State and her runner-up finish at Cincinnati...Voted to the Capital One Academic All-America second team with a 4.0 GPA in accounting...Named to the NGCA All-America Scholar Team, Summit League Winter/Spring All-Academic Team, and Summit League Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence.

2009-10 (Freshman): Summit League Newcomer of the Year, Golfer of the Year, All-Summit League first team, and Division I All-America honorable mention by the National Golf Coaches Association...Summit League runner-up by one shot after suffering her worst score of the year with an 81 in the first round...One of nine individual qualifiers for the NCAA tournament...Tied for 17th place at the West Regional with a 222 and missed the national championship cut by only three shots...Led The Summit League with a 74.0 average over 27 rounds...Broke NDSU records for lowest 18-hole round, 36-hole tournament, 54-hole tournament and single-season scoring average, and her five tournament wins were NDSU single-season and career records...Won her first three collegiate events at Concordia Moorhead, Nebraska and Northern Arizona...Tied the 18-hole record of 71 at Concordia then fired two 69s at Nebraska, where her winning score of 6-under-par 210 shattered NDSU's 54-hole record by 13 strokes...Snapped the 36-hole record the next week with a 144 at Northern Arizona...Summit League Female Athlete of the Month for August/September for her performances...Had a 70.8 average and defeated 176 competitors over three events...Named Summit League Women's Golfer of the Week twice during the spring season after wins at the Drake Monterey Invitational and Creighton Golf Classic...Named to the Summit League Winter/Spring All-Academic Team as a Distinguished Scholar and to the NGCA All-America Scholar Team with a 4.0 GPA...Played in three national tournaments in the summer of 2010...Won the stroke-play qualifying round at the Women's Western Golf Association's national amateur championship...Shot rounds of 68 and 69 to beat Southern California freshman Cyna Rodriguez by two strokes...Also made the cut into the round of 64 at the TRANS National Amateur and USGA Women's Amateur.

Before NDSU: Won the 2009 U.S. Junior Girls Amateur championship at age 17 with a 6-and-5 victory over Kimberly Kim of Hilo, Hawaii, in the match play final at Trump National in Bedminster, N.J...Also won stroke-play medalist honors with a 3-under-par 141...Led the first round of stroke play at the 2009 U.S. Women's Amateur in St. Louis with a 3-under 68...Tied for eighth in stroke play before being eliminated 3-and-2 in the first round of match play...Cruised to a 16-shot victory in the 16-18 girls division at Purdue in the 2009 PGA Junior Series with a 2-under 214 over three rounds...Placed 10th in the girls' division of the PGA Junior Championship in 2009 and was 19th in 2008...Became the first female to advance to the championship flight of the Pine-to-Palm tournament in Detroit Lakes, Minn...Lost to TCU's Tom Hoge in the finals...Named the "Non-School Athlete of the Year" by the North Dakota Associated Press Sportscasters and Sportswriters Association in June 2010 for her accomplishments before starting at NDSU...Three-time Fargo-Moorhead Women's All-City champion from 2006-2008...Three-time F-M Junior All-City champion from 2004-2006...Won the Minnesota Players Cup in the 13-15 girls division in 2005 and 2006...Her brother, Nathan, was the boys champion in 2006.

Personal: Born July 10, 1992...Daughter of Mark and Twyla Anderson of Oxbow, N.D...Has an older brother Nathan, who is a junior on the NDSU men's golf team...Home-schooled...Majoring in accounting with a minor in fraud investigation.
