POSTSEASON FOR LOBOS - The University of New Mexico women's golf team participates in the NCAA West Regional this week in Erie, Colo. Competition is Thursday through Saturday at the Colorado National Golf Course (par 72, 6,575 yards), which is northwest of Denver. The University of Colorado is the host. Live scoring will be available at www.GolfStat.com.

This marks the 20th consecutive year New Mexico has qualified for NCAA postseason competition, or every year since regional play began in 1993. The Lobos gained an at-large berth last month.

As the 17th seed, UNM will be paired with UNLV and Oregon State during the first two days of competition. The Lobos tee off Thursday at noon from No. 10, and Friday at 7:30 a.m. from No. 1.

The weather forecast for Denver: mostly sunny with a high of 80 on Thursday; 30% chance of showers and a high of 58 on Friday; and 40% chance of showers and a high of 59 on Saturday.

TRYING TO GET TO TENNESSEE - The 2012 NCAA Women's Golf Championships is divided into three regional sites: East at State College, Pa., Central at Columbus, Ohio, and the West in Erie, Colo.

Each regional has 24 teams, with the low eight teams and the low two individuals, not on those teams, advancing to the finals May 22-25 at the Vanderbilt Legends Golf Club, in Franklin, Tenn.

The Lobos are seeking their 16th trip to the NCAA Championships, and first since 2010. UNM tied for 16th at the 2010 championships in Wilmington, N.C.

THE COMPETITORS - Joining the Lobos at the West Regional are eight teams ranked in the top 23 of the latest GolfStat.com poll: No. 1 UCLA, No. 6 North Carolina, No. 7 LSU, No. 11 Colorado, No. 13 California, No. 17 Baylor, No. 19 Pepperdine and No. 23 UC Davis. The other 16 teams in order of selection are Oklahoma, Texas Tech, Tulsa, TCU, Iowa State, Stanford, Denver, UNLV, New Mexico, Oregon State, Illinois, Kennesaw State, San Jose State, Missouri State, Northern Colorado and Jackson State. The Lobos are ranked 51st.

UNM LINEUP - Head coach Jill Trujillo is taking senior Rebecca Hellbom, junior Bethany Buchner and sophomores Manon De Roey, Sofia Hoglund and Sammi Stevens. De Roey leads the Lobos with a stroke average of 76.28, although Stevens (76.37) and Hellbom (76.90) are close behind.

HEAD COACH JILL TRUJILLO - A 1990 UNM graduate and golf letterwinner from 1987-90, Jill Trujillo is in her fifth season in charge of the women's golf program. Trujillo has led New Mexico to five team titles, including three consecutive Mountain West Conference championships from 2008-10, and NCAA postseason every year. She was named 2007-08 MWC Coach of the Year.

Trujillo was head coach when UNM advanced to the 2007 NCAA Championships at Daytona Beach, Fla. The Lobos finished 22nd at the Championships in 2007, 19th in 2009 and tied for 16th in 2010.

2011 NCAA REGIONAL REVIEW - UNM finished 19th at the 2011 NCAA West Regional in Auburn, Wash. Competing in NCAA postseason for the 19th consecutive season, the Lobos completed the 54-hole event at 941 (310-318-313, +77) at the Washington National Golf Club (par 72, 6,321 yards).

Southern California proved worthy of its No. 1 national ranking, taking a 10-shot victory with a final score of 866 (-4). No. 13 Tennessee was second at 876 followed by Virginia and UC Davis at 887.

Sophomore Beth Buchner shot a team-best 75 in the final round and finished as the top Lobo at 233 (80-78-75, +17), tying for 58th. Freshman Sammi Stevens tied for 70th at 235 (75-81-79, +19). She shot 38 on the back nine, including a birdie on 18.

Juniors Rebecca Hellbom and Sarah Salvo tied for 70th at 237. Hellbom (79-79-79, +21) started strong by making the turn at 1-over, but had a 42 on the back. Freshman Manon de Roey came in at 244 (79-83-82), tying for 109th.

Tennessee's Erica Popson won the individual title by five shots at 8-under 208 (68-69-71).

2012 MW CHAMPIONSHIPS REVIEW - The University of New Mexico enjoyed its best round of the Mountain West Championships, but it wasn't enough to climb the leaderboard on the final day of competition at the Wigwam Resort Gold Course (par 72, 6,208 yards) in Litchfield Park, Ariz.

UNM shot a 301, finishing in fourth place for the second consecutive year with a 54-hole total of 918 (310-307-301). The Lobos started the final round tied for fourth with UNLV.

TCU (904) won its second straight team title, holding off UNLV (909) by five shots. The Horned Frogs earn the Mountain West's automatic bid to the NCAA Championships.

"Much better today, but a little too late," said UNM head coach Jill Trujillo. "Based on the competition we have played this season, I like our chances of continuing our season next month."

Sophomore Manon De Roey, who shared the lead after the first round, ended in fifth place for her best career finish as a Lobo. De Roey shot a 7-over 223 (72-75-76), which matches her lowest score at UNM in relation to par. She led the 35-member field with 43 pars.

De Roey has been UNM's top golfer in three of six tournaments this spring and she has a 75.31 scoring average in her last 13 rounds.

Sophomore Sammi Stevens placed 10th at 228 (78-73-77). The back nine proved troublesome for Stevens in the final round as three bogeys and a double bogey led to a 40.

Sophomore Sofia Hoglund was poised for her best round of the spring season before incurring problems down the stretch. She was 1 over through 15, but bogeyed 16 and 18 and suffered a double bogey on 17. Hoglund finished with a 77 and a three-round total of 235 (78-80-77), tying for 20th.

Senior Rebecca Hellbom scrambled for a 75 in the final round, her low round of the tournament. Hellbom's scorecard featured 11 pars, three birdies, two bogeys and a pair of double bogeys. Having never finished lower than ninth at three previous Mountain West Championships, Hellbom ended in a tie for 22nd at 236 (82-79-75).

Senior Sarah Salvo carded a 73 in the final round, the Lobos' low score of the day and equaling her best round of the season. She made the turn in 39 after bogeys at 8 and 9, but played the back in 34. Salvo tied for 26th at 238 (84-81-73).

TCU's Sanna Nuutinen won the individual title in a playoff with San Diego State's Christine Wong. They tied at 217.

STEVENS NAMED ALL-CONFERENCE - Sophomore Sammi Stevens was named to the 2012 all-Mountain West team at the conclusion of the conference championships. Stevens went into the MW Championships with the team's top stroke average (76.42). She finished 10th at the championships at 228.

LOBOS HAVE DOMINATED MWC - Since the Mountain West Conference started in 2000, New Mexico has won seven of the 13 team titles, the first four (2000-03) and three of the last five (2008-10).

SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION - The University of New Mexico men's and women's golf programs will conduct two Lobo Junior camps next month at the UNM Championship Golf Course.

The first session is June 4-7, the second June 11-14. Both sessions are from 8 a.m. to noon daily and open to boys and girls ages 7 to 18. Registration is available at <http://www.lobojuniorgolfcamp.com>. Call (505) 604-4786 or (805) 704-4776 for more information.

The camps will be hosted by UNM head coaches Glen Millican (men) and Jill Trujillo (women) and their assistants, Brian Kortan and Becky Dover.

As schedules permit, members of the Lobo golf teams and UNM golf alums currently playing professionally will assist with camp instruction.

Campers will be grouped by ages and skill levels. Each group will be guided by a skilled instructor and counseled throughout the camp.

BRANCH LAW FIRM WOMEN'S CLINIC REVIEW - Nearly 100 female golf enthusiasts took part in the Branch Law Firm Women's Golf Clinic on Saturday, March 24, on a beautiful morning at the UNM Championship Golf Course.

The free clinic was taught by UNM head coach Jill Trujillo, who is a certified LPGA/PGA Professional, assistant coach Becky Dover and the Lobo women's golf team.

EWART OFF TO GREAT START ON LPGA TOUR - Former Lobo Jodi Ewart is showing she belongs at the highest level of ladies professional golf.

A 2010 UNM graduate and three-time All-American for the Lobos, Ewart made the cut in her first four LPGA tournaments of 2012, earning \$82,065. Her best performance was at the Kia Classic in Carlsbad, Calif., when she tied for 7th at 4 under 284, claiming \$45,337.

Ewart earned her LPGA card in December by finishing in a tie for fourth place at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament in Daytona Beach, Fla. The top 20 finishers received full status for the 2012 Tour.

Ewart, a three-time All-American and four-time Mountain West Conference player of the year, ended the grueling five-day, 90-hole tournament at 3-under 357 (70-73-74-70-70).

"This is what I have been working for my whole life," said Ewart. "I'm so excited I get to live my dream and represent the Lobos on the LPGA Tour. Q school is a long and grueling week. You have to manage your emotions. I didn't look at the leader board the entire week. I just wanted it to be about me and the course."

On Jan. 19, Ewart qualified for the 2012 Ladies European Tour by finishing first at the European Tour's Final Qualifying

School.

Playing in Murcia, Spain, Ewart covered five rounds on the La Manga North and South courses in 11-under-par 350 (70-67-67-73-73), edging Swiss amateur Anaïs Maggetti by two shots. Ewart held the top spot for the final four rounds.

"It feels good," said Ewart. "I mean, fourth on the LPGA and now winning the LET; it's a pretty good off-season if you ask me. It feels good and I'm really looking forward to this year."

LOBOS SIGN KNOPF SISTERS - Head coach Jill Trujillo announced that Ira (EAR-uh) and Xenia Knopf (ZEEN-ya ka-nawpf) have signed national letters of intent to attend UNM in the fall of 2012.

Born 14 months apart, the natives of Schwalbach, Germany, are excellent students. Xenia, the oldest, has a 3.7 high school grade-point-average, while younger sister Ira has a 3.8 GPA. Both are interested in majoring in Pharmacy or Marketing at UNM.

The Knopfs will graduate from Heinrich von Kleist Schule in Eschborn, Germany, in the spring of 2012.

HOGLUND WINS 2011 McGUIRE - A clutch putt on the penultimate hole made University of New Mexico sophomore Sofia Hoglund the improbable winner of the 32nd Branch Law Firm Dick McGuire Invitational played at the University of New Mexico Championship Course (par 73, 6,187 yards) last September.

Playing as an individual, Hoglund drained a breaking downhill 35-footer for birdie on the par-3 7th to seal her first collegiate victory. It was Hoglund's lone birdie in a round of 77 (4-over), but enough to edge Baylor's Hayley Davis by one shot. Davis started the final round six shots behind Hoglund.

"It was a tough day," said Hoglund, who took a two-shot lead into the final round. "That putt would have gone past by six or seven feet if it didn't hit the hole. Obviously, I'm very happy."

Hoglund finished at 3-under 216 (71-68-77). Her best finish in five previous tournaments as a Lobo was a tie for 59th. Hoglund's stroke average in 2010-11 was 81.71 for 14 rounds.

A native of Kokkola, Finland, Hoglund is the sixth Lobo to take home the title, joining Pat Park (1962-63), Kristi Albers (1984), Tracy May (1994), Kailin Downs (2003) and Jodi Ewart (2008).

As it turned out, Hoglund was nearly contested by one of her Lobo teammates. Fellow sophomore Sammi Stevens shot a par 73 (two birdies, two bogeys) to finish in third at 218 (1-under).

For Stevens, she set UNM personal bests for highest finish and lowest 54-hole total. It is also the first time the sophomore has finished under par in 12 collegiate tournaments.

"Sofia and Sammi were just tremendous," said UNM head coach Jill Trujillo. "Hopefully, these types of performances will continue."

As a team, UNM finished eighth in the 18-team field at 29-over 905 (305-298-302). Baylor held off TCU, Denver and Northwestern to claim the championship at 887 (1-over).

Lobo junior Beth Buchner tied for 33rd at 227 (77-72-78) followed by seniors Rebecca Hellbom (232, 60th) and Sarah Salvo (233, T61st), and sophomore Manon De Roey (234, T66th).

LOBOS LAUDED FOR ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT -- For the third time in the past four seasons, the University of New Mexico women's golf team has been recognized by the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA) for its academic performance.

The Lobos combined to post a 3.678 grade-point-average for the 2010-11 academic year, the highest GPA among Mountain West institutions and No. 13 nationally. Lee University (Cleveland, Tenn.) had the top GPA at 3.864.

"I know all of our ladies would like to play professional golf, however, they also know that goal is extremely ambitious," said head coach Jill Trujillo. "They recognize the tremendous value of receiving an education and a degree from The University of New Mexico."

FIVE LOBOS RECEIVE MWC SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARD

- Five members of the UNM women's golf team received the 2010-11 Mountain West Conference Scholar-Athlete Award.

Receiving the award for the third time in their careers are Rebecca Hellbom and Sarah Salvo. Hellbom holds a 3.84 cumulative grade-point-average, majoring in Musical Performance. Salvo is majoring in Business Administration and has a 3.58 GPA. Both Hellbom and Salvo completed their junior year at UNM in May.

Beth Buchner was recognized for the second straight year, posting a 3.64 GPA with a major in Business Administration.

Manon de Roey and Sofia Hoglund - freshmen in 2010-11 - received the award for the first time. De Roey had a 3.51 GPA in her first year at UNM while Hoglund had a team-high 4.01.

The Mountain West Scholar-Athlete Award is one of the highest academic honors bestowed by the Conference. To be eligible for selection, student-athletes must have completed at least two academic terms at the institution, while maintaining a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or better, and have participated in varsity competition in an NCAA-sponsored sport.

AND FOUR NAMED NGCA ALL-AMERICAN SCHOLARS

- The National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA) recognized four Lobos as All-American Scholars for 2010-11. Beth Buchner, Manon de Roey, Rebecca Hellbom and Sarah Salvo all met the criteria requiring a minimum cumulative grade-point-average of 3.50. UNM women's golf has had at least two NGCA All-American scholars every year since 2005.

Hellbom received the accolade for the third straight year. Buchner was recognized for the second straight year while Salvo and de Roey are first-time honorees.

Jill Trujillo is in her fifth season as head coach of the nationally-recognized University of New Mexico women's golf program. The UNM graduate became the ninth coach in Lobo history on June 14, 2007.

Trujillo was promoted to her current position after serving as the interim head coach for the latter part of the 2007 spring season. She guided UNM to its 16th consecutive NCAA regional appearance as well as reaching the NCAA Championships for the 13th time. The Lobos placed 22nd at the 2007 championships.

"Jill is an outstanding golf coach and mentor to our student-athletes," said UNM vice president for athletics Paul Krebs. "She's a Lobo alum who knows what it takes to compete at the national level. I'm delighted that she is on board and that we are continuing the strong tradition of our women's golf program."

New Mexico advanced to its 19th consecutive NCAA post-season competition in 2010-11, playing in the West Regional.

In 2009-10, the Lobos tied for 16th at the NCAA Champion-

ships with a school-record, 72-hole total of 1,189 and won their third consecutive Mountain West Conference title. Senior Jodi Ewart became the first student-athlete in any MWC sport to be named Player of the Year four times. Ewart won her third MWC individual championship, and, in the process, set a school record with five career titles. She was also named the MWC Female Athlete of the Year, which included all sports.

In 2008-09, the Lobos won two tournaments, including their second straight Mountain West Conference team title. UNM finished 19th at the NCAA Championships.

Ewart was named first team All-America and MWC Player of the Year for the third consecutive season.

The Ladies Professional Golf Association (LPGA) Teaching and Club Professional (T&CP) membership recognized Trujillo as the 2009 Central Region Coach of the Year. She also won the award in 2007.

Trujillo's first full season (2007-08) provided a number of highlights. First and foremost was New Mexico capturing the 2008 Mountain West Conference championship on its home course by a staggering 19 shots. Sophomore Jodi Ewart won the individual title to complete the Lobo sweep.

UNM also won the 2008 Betsy Rawls Longhorn Invitational title in Austin, Texas, beating No. 5 Florida and No. 6 Arkansas in the process.

For all of the accomplishments throughout her rookie season, Trujillo was honored as the 2008 MWC Coach of the Year.

Prior to becoming the Lobos head coach, Trujillo served as an assistant with UNM women's golf for three seasons starting in the fall of 2004.

She helped lead New Mexico to a pair of regular-season tournament titles and three consecutive NCAA Championships appearances, while remaining nationally-ranked and among the nation's elite programs.

Before joining the UNM staff, Trujillo was the head golf professional at the Isleta Eagle Golf Course south of Albuquerque. She was responsible for the overall operations at the course from 1996 to 2003, and was the tournament director for numerous events, including the Futures Golf Tour, the PGA Junior Series and the AJGA Southwestern.

While working at Isleta, Trujillo earned numerous accolades, including the 1997 Sun Country Section PGA Merchandiser of the Year, the 2001 Junior Golf Leader award and the LPGA Central Section Professional of the Year in 2000 and 2002.

Additionally, she was named one of Golf For Women magazine's Top 50 teachers in the United States in 2002 and 2003.

Trujillo served as the assistant golf professional at the University of New Mexico Championship Course from 1990 until August of 1996. During her tenure, Trujillo assisted with the day-to-day operations at the course.

Trujillo was a member of the Lobo women's golf team from 1986-90, and earned all-conference and academic all-conference honors her senior season. She also won the 1988 New Mexico Women's Amateur Open.

Trujillo has 20 years of experience as a golf professional and is a Class A member of the PGA of America and the LPGA T&CP.

The Silver City, N.M., native graduated from UNM in 1990 with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration.
