Scouting Auburn... Auburn played just one exhibition contest in the preseason as the Tigers took on Premier Players, defeating them 100-68. Five Auburn players scored in double figures in the game including Natasha Brackett with 20, Le'Coe Willingham with 18, Nancy Derrick with 15, Marita Payne with 10 and Mandisa Stevenson, who picked up a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds. The Tigers return all five starters to the lineup from the WNIT Champion team from 2002-03. Returning leading scorer Natasha Brackett leads the team along with senior Le'Coe Willingham. Head coach Joe Ciampi enters his 25th season at the helm after leading the Tigers to a 23-11 record last season. Returning to the lineup this year are 2002-03 starters Brackett, Nicole Louden, Louise Emeagi, Tia Miller and Willingham along with Marita Payne, Mandisa Stevenson, Tiffany Presley, Nancy Derrick, Tanesheia Thompson and Nitasha Brown. The Tigers are ranked in numerous preseason polls including No. 15 in Street & Smith's, No. 22 in the Associated Press, No. 25 in the USA Today/ESPN, WBCA Coaches' Poll, and No. 24 in Full Court Press. Auburn and Notre Dame have never met on the court in the schools' history.

Scouting Notre Dame... The Fighting Irish return four starters from a team that went 21-11 last season including a trip to the Sweet Sixteen in which they fell 47-66 to Purdue. Forward Jacqueline Batteast led the team in 2002-03 with a 13.9 points per game average and 8.3 rebounds per game. Also returning to the lineup for Notre Dame are Katy Flecky, Courtney LaVere, LaTania Severe and Megan Duffy, who started five games last season. In Notre Dame's two exhibition games, Batteast scored an average of 15.5 points including a 20-point performance against Northwest Sports. Katy Flecky was the leading scorer for Notre Dame vs. Team Concept with 21 points and added seven rebounds. The Fighting Irish defeated Northwest Sports 85-65 on Nov. 3 and went on to defeat Team Concept 78-45. Head coach Muffet McGraw is in her 17th season with the Fighting Irish and holds a 363-138 record.

Looking Ahead... Following Auburn's contest vs. Notre Dame, the Tigers will meet up with either Old Dominion or No. 20 Colorado on Saturday, Nov. 15. The games will be played at 7 and 9:15 p.m. Auburn has met up with Colorado just once in a 68-61 win on March 17, 1996 in Boulder in the NCAA Tournament. Auburn is currently 2-2 all-time with Old Dominion with the last meeting coming in a 48-59 loss in Miami, Fla. on Dec. 28, 1994. Colorado finished their 2002-03 season with a 24-8 overall record and a Sweet Sixteen finish while Old Dominion ended their campaign at 21-11 and a trip to the NCAA Tournament where they fell in the first round to Boston College in a heartbreaker, 72-73.

Looking For Depth: In Auburn's 100-68 win over Premier Players, the Tigers had five players in double figures including two off the bench including Nancy Derrick with 15 and Marita Payne with 10. Auburn will be looking for that kind of depth in the regular season and will need it immediately as Auburn could face two top-25 teams in its first weekend of play.

Back In The Ranks: For the first time in school history, the Tigers were not ranked in the Associated Press poll during the season. In preseason polls, Auburn is ranked at No. 22, its first ranking since a No. 25 ranking on Jan. 28, 2002.

Among Great Company: Guard Natasha Brackett placed her name among Auburn's best in the 2002-03 season as she broke the Tigers' all-time top sophomore scoring record with 557 points on the year. Auburn legend Vickie Orr scored 550 in the 1986-87 season, holding the previous record. Currently, Brackett is 28th all-time in Auburn scoring in just her sophomore year with 834 points and an average of 13.5 points per game.

No Shot For You: Center Marita Payne accumulated 47 blocked shots in 384

minutes of play in 2002-03 as a freshman, which breaks the Auburn block record for a rookie season. The former record was held by Brenda Hill with 45 (1982-83). The 6-4 Payne surpassed current Auburn assistant coach Lauretta Freeman earlier in the season.

Chasing 1,000: Le'Coe Willingham missed becoming the Tigers' 20th 1,000-point scorer by just a few games in 2002-03 as she has concluded her first three seasons at Auburn totaling 969 points including averaging 9.6 points per game this season. Also approaching the impressive mark is sophomore Natasha Brackett, who is currently at 821 points with a 16.4 points per game average. If Brackett were to stay on that pace next season, she would need 11 games to reach the plateau.

November Reign: The month of November has been very kind to Auburn under head coach Joe Ciampi. Under Ciampi the Tigers are 65-6 (.913) in November, including a perfect 10-0 the last two seasons. Auburn has won 38 straight games in November dating back to a 70-63 loss to Wisconsin on Nov. 29, 1991 in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Pretty Impressive: Since a 77-70 loss to Virginia on Jan. 5, 1992, the Auburn Tigers have compiled a 89-2 record against non-conference opponents in Beard-Eaves-Memorial Coliseum. The two losses during that time were to Connecticut, a 64-55 loss on Dec. 8, 1993, and a 73-56 loss to Illinois Dec. 30, 2000. Before that loss to Illinois, Auburn had won 55 straight non-SEC home games. In the past two years, the Tigers are 22-0.

Auburn Head Coach Joe Ciampi:



Joe Ciampi is in his 25th year as the head coach of the Auburn Tigers. Ciampi, a graduate of Mansfield University in 1968 and native of Glen Lyon, Pa., has guided the Tigers to a 546-194 (.738) record. He has compiled a 585-204 (.741) career record which includes two seasons as the head coach at the U.S. Military Academy in West Point, N.Y., where he posted a 39-10 record. His victory total ranks him

11th on the all-time active list. Ciampi's success can also be told by his three Southeastern Conference titles, his four SEC Tournament titles, his 15 NCAA Tournament births, three Final Four appearances and a WNIT Championship.

Another Milestone: Ciampi reached a milestone on Nov. 24, 2001 with a victory over Chicago State, 74-54. The head coach became the 11th active division I women's coach to reach 550 career wins. Ciampi is also fast approaching his 600th career victory as he is just 15 wins away from the plateau.

Assisting Ciampi: Assisting Joe Ciampi this season is associate head coach Joanie O'Brien, who is in her first season, but is familiar to the Auburn program. O'Brien was a graduate assistant from 1986-88 and an assistant for the Tigers from 1988-91. Returning this season is assistant Craig Kennedy, who is in his third season at Auburn. Another familiar face to the staff is assistant Samantha Williams, who was four-year starter under Ciampi from 1992-96, and is joining the staff for her first season.
