11th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The 11th annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship takes place at Kansas City's Arrowhead Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 2, at 7:00 p.m. (CST) under the television cameras of ABC Sports.

General public tickets are available at all Ticketmaster outlets, by phone at (800) 676-5488 or online at ticketmaster.com. Group tickets and premium ticket packages are available through Arrowhead Stadium at (888) 992-4433.

Tickets are priced at \$80, \$70, \$60 and \$50, plus handling fee.

In the 10-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

Big 12 BCS Success

The 2005 season marked the third straight and fifth time in the last six years that a Big 12 team played in the BCS National Championship game. Since the inception of the the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship game and leads all conferences with its five appearances. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

Two Big 12 Players Named to 2006 National Scholar-Athlete Class

Brian Daniels (Colorado) and Carl Pendleton (Oklahoma) have been selected to the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame 2006 National Scholar-Athlete Class. Both will receive an \$18,000 scholarship for post-graduate studies.

BAYLOR (4-5, 3-2)
This Week: at Texas Tech
Next Week: at Oklahoma State

Quarterback Shawn Bell tore the ACL of his right knee during the fourth-quarter of Saturday's game vs. Texas A&M and appears out for the season. During the game, Bell moved into second place on Baylor's all-time passing list with 5,666 career yards, and currently holds 12 BU records. His replacement, redshirt freshman Blake Szymanski, has attempted five passes this season.

Redshirt freshman linebacker Joe Pawelek had eight tackles in the loss to A&M, his sixth straight game with at least seven stops.

Running back Paul Mosley has five TDs in the last four games.

Wide Receiver Trent Shelton has recorded at least one reception in 42 consecutive games, extending his school record. However his streak of games with a TD catch ended at five Saturday.



COLORADO (1-8, 1-4)
This Week: Kansas State
Next Week: Iowa State

Safety Ryan Walters had a 95-yard fumble return for a touchdown at Kansas, the second longest fumble return in Colorado history. Walters was also credited with six tackles, all solo, including two third-down stops and a pass deflection.

Walters' return was CU's first non-offensive touchdown this season, giving Colorado 38 since 1999 -- tied for the sixth most nationally.

Abraham Wright has 10 sacks on the season, the first Buff to record double-figure sacks since Ronnie Woolfork had 13½ in 1992. With 19½ career sacks, he is now seventh all-time at Colorado.

Mason Crosby is 15-of-21 in field goals in 2006, and with 56 points, he has 287 for his career (already CU's all-time leader). He is 67-of-88 in career field goals.



IOWA STATE (3-6, 0-5)
This Week: Kansas
Next Week: at Colorado

In Saturday's loss at Kansas State, Milan Moses caught five passes for a team-leading 96 yards. Moses was starting in place of Todd Blythe, who missed the first game of his career, ending his streak of 32 consecutive starts.

Jason Scales rushed for 67 yards and one touchdown on 12 carries while filling in for the injured Stevie Hicks vs. K-State.

Linebacker Tyrone McKenzie led the Cyclone defense with 11 tackles and a forced fumble against KSU. McKenzie ranks second in the Big 12 with 102 tackles, and fourth nationally with an 11.3 average.

Junior Alvin Bowen leads the Big 12 with 65 solo stops and 116 tackles. Bowen leads the nation with a 12.9 tackles per game average.



KANSAS (4-5, 1-4)
This Week: at Iowa State
Next Week: Idle

KU's five-point victory over Colorado marked the eighth-straight game decided by less than 10 points, the longest streak in Kansas history.

Freshman quarterback Todd Reesing came on in relief of Adam Barmann Saturday, throwing for two touchdowns and rushing for another in the 20-15 win over Colorado.

Sophomore Aqib Talib's two interceptions Saturday give him four on the season and six for his career.

KU needs two victories in its final three games to become bowl eligible.

Jon Cornish is the ninth KU player to rush for 1,000 yards in a season and the first since June Henley in 1996. Cornish currently has 1,041 yards, good for 10th place on KU's single-season rushing list.



KANSAS STATE (5-4, 2-3)
This Week: at Colorado
Next Week: Texas

Josh Freeman connected on his first career touchdown pass last Saturday, completing 14-for-20 attempts for 161 yards and a touchdown.

Senior linebacker Zach Diles doubled his career total with two sacks in the win over Iowa State. He also recorded a career-high 12 tackles, including 10 solo stops.

Ian Campbell moved into eighth place on the K-State single-season record book with his 9.5 sack of the season. Campbell was in on one of KSU's season-high tying five sacks against Iowa State.

Defensive back Devin Anderson recorded his first career interception Saturday and the return for touchdown was the first by the Wildcats since last season.

Brandon Archer was named Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week for his effort against Iowa State.



MISSOURI (7-2, 3-2)
This Week: at Nebraska
Next Week: Idle

David Overstreet recorded a game-high 13 tackles, including eight solo stops against Oklahoma, marking his third consecutive double-figure tackle game. He also recovered a fumble to bring his career total to five.

Jeff Wolfert, after connecting on a 39-yard field goal against Oklahoma, is 11-for-13 for the season and has made his last eight attempts.

The Missouri defense has held opponents to 190 passing yards over the last two games, while forcing six turnovers.

Chase Daniel has 2,283 passing yards on the season, which places him fifth in school history (206 behind Jeff Handy's all-time mark of 2,463 set in 1992). His total offense of 2,609 yards also ranks fifth in MU history (all four places ahead of him are held by Brad Smith, including the all-time mark of 3,605 yards set in 2005).



NEBRASKA (6-3, 3-2)

This Week: Missouri
Next Week: at Texas A&M

Brandon Jackson rushed for a career-high 182 yards in the loss to Oklahoma State, pushing his career total to 1,026 yards. Jackson's 182 yards on the ground are the most by a Husker this season.

Nebraska had 211 rushing yards at OSU, marking its fifth 200-yard rushing game in 2006. By comparison, the Huskers combined for four games with more than 200 yards rushing over the last two seasons.

Adam Carriker had two sacks for minus-10 yards, three tackles for loss, six total tackles, a pass breakup and a blocked extra point against Oklahoma State.

Nebraska has eclipsed 450 yards of offense five times this season.



OKLAHOMA (6-2, 3-1)

This Week: at Texas A&M
Next Week: Texas Tech

Malcolm Kelly has reached 1,000 career receiving yards (1,035) faster than any player in Oklahoma history. Kelly crossed the threshold in his 19th game. The previous record was held by Antwone Savage, who reached 1,000 yards in his 21st game.

Over the last five games the Sooners have given up a total of 50 points (10 ppg), while registering 13 takeaways.

Paul Thompson has now gone three straight games without throwing an interception. During the same time frame he has fired five touchdown passes and completed 60% of his attempts.

Allen Patrick has had 100-yard rushing games in both of his starts since replacing an injured Adrian Peterson.



OKLAHOMA STATE (5-3, 2-2)

This Week: at Texas
Next Week: Baylor

With 117 yards vs. Nebraska, Dantrell Savage topped the 100-yard rushing mark for the second consecutive week. Savage also set a career-high with two touchdown runs.

Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week, Nate Peterson's 19-yard fumble return for a touchdown was the first score of his career. It was also the Cowboys' second defensive touchdown of the season.

Freshman linebacker Patrick Lavine recorded a career-high 11 tackles against Nebraska, topping his previous best of eight. Lavine also had his first career sack and forced fumble.

Bobby Reid threw for 229 yards and two touchdowns, and rushed for 61 yards in the win over Nebraska. Reid leads the Big 12 and ranks third nationally with a 177.4 pass efficiency rating.



TEXAS (8-1, 5-0)

This Week: Oklahoma State
Next Week: at Kansas State

Offensive Player of the Week, Colt McCoy threw four touchdown passes Saturday at Texas Tech on 21-of-31 passing for 256 yards. McCoy has 24 TD passes, two shy of the UT single-season record shared by Vince Young and Chris Simms.

Aaron Ross has had a role in nine take-aways in the last seven games -- four interceptions, three forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries.

Of Limas Sweed's 10 touchdown receptions this season, five have been longer than 40 yards. He has caught a TD pass in seven consecutive games and in eight of nine this season.

The Longhorns have held their last three opponents to a combined 64 yards rushing. UT leads the Big 12 and ranks second nationally in rush defense with a 41.2-yard average.



TEXAS A&M (8-1, 4-1)

This Week: Oklahoma
Next Week: Nebraska

A&M is off to an 8-1 start, marking the first time since the 1998 Big 12 Championship squad opened the year 10-1.

Stephen McGee has gone a career-best 134 pass attempts without an interception. For the season, McGee has attempted 225 passes with one interception -- the nation's best attempt-interception ratio.

Texas A&M has committed a Big 12-low 10 turnovers this season, with four coming in the opener against The Citadel.

The Aggies have been behind in each of their last seven games.

Texas A&M rushed for a season-best 292 yards against Baylor, including a 62-yard touchdown run by Mike Goodson, the Aggies longest run from scrimmage this season. The 507 yards of offense was also a season-high.



TEXAS TECH (5-4, 2-3)

This Week: Baylor
Next Week: at Oklahoma

Graham Harrell's career-high 519 yards passing last week against Texas ranks fifth on the Big 12's single-game chart. Harrell connected on 42-of-62 attempts with three touchdowns. Tech quarterbacks hold 12 of the conference's top 15 single-game passing records, including all of the top 10.

Jarrett Hicks grabbed his school-record 30th career touchdown pass in the loss to Texas, catching nine passes for a game-high 156 yards - his first 100-yard game of the season.

Linebacker Fletcher Sessions' 19-yard interception return for a score was Tech's first INT for a touchdown since 2003.

For the second-straight week and third time this season, the Texas Tech offense scored on its first possession of the game.
