11th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The 11th annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship takes place at Kansas City's Arrowhead Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 2, at 7:00 p.m. (CST) under the television cameras of ABC Sports.

General public tickets are available at all Ticketmaster outlets, by phone at (800) 676-5488 or online at ticketmaster.com. Group tickets and premium ticket packages are available through Arrowhead Stadium at (888) 992-4433.

Tickets are priced at \$80, \$70, \$60 and \$50, plus handling fee.

In the 10-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

Big 12 BCS Success

The 2005 season marked the third straight and fifth time in the last six years that a Big 12 team played in the BCS National Championship game. Since the inception of the the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship game and leads all conferences with its five appearances. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

Division Races

Texas clinches a share of the South Division title with one win in its final two games. It owns the tie-break over Oklahoma and can clinch the Division outright with a win combined with an OU loss this weekend.

Nebraska clinches the North Division with a win in one of its two remaining games. In the event of a tie with Missouri and/or Kansas State, Nebraska owns the tie-breaker by virtue of its win over both teams.

Big 12 Bowl Partners

Again this season, the Big 12 has eight bowl slots guaranteed. The Conference is partnered with nine bowls, with the the Gator Bowl and Sun Bowl taking a Big 12 team twice over a four-year period. In the two years in which the Gator does not select a Big 12 team, the Sun Bowl will. Following is the selection order:

- BCS - Fiesta
- Cotton
- Holiday
- Gator (when it selects a Big 12 team)
- Alamo
- Sun (when the Gator does not take a Big 12 team)
- Insight
- Independence
- Texas

Bowl Eligibility

Heading into the final weeks of the regular-season the Big 12 finds itself with seven teams currently at or better than the NCAA minimum six-win threshold for bowl eligibility. When filling a conference's contracted bowl slots, six-win teams can only be selected provided there are no other teams with winning records available within the conference to fulfill its obligation(s). Teams with winning records must be selected to fill a conference's bowl obligations before six-win teams within the conference can be chosen. Six-win teams are only able to fill at-large spots in bowls outside of existing bowl agreements if there are no other teams with winning records available within Division I-A.

BAYLOR (4-6, 3-3)
This Week: at Oklahoma State
Next Week: Oklahoma

Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week Daniel Sepulveda had two 60-yard punts and set an NCAA record with his 89th punt of longer than 50 yards last Saturday. For his career, Sepulveda has 91 punts of 50-plus yards and 21 that have traveled at least 60.

Baylor has five one-play touchdown drives this season. All five have involved QB Blake Szymanski and/or WR Trent Shelton (three Shelton receptions, two Szymanski passes and one Szymanski run).

Szymanski's two rushing TDs were the first of his career. He is the first BU quarterback with two rushing TDs in a game since 1992 when J.J. Joe accomplished the feat.

Shelton's first-quarter TD reception was the 14th of his career, moving into sole possession of fifth place all-time at Baylor.



COLORADO (1-9, 1-5)
This Week: Iowa State
Next Week: Idle

CU extended its consecutive game scoring streak to 220, though last Saturday marked just the 20th time the Buffs had to wait until the second half to extend it. It now stands alone as the 11th longest in NCAA history (the sixth longest active streak).

Jordan Dizon has 16 stops on opponents' third downs this season, only two behind the school record of 18.

Bernard Jackson is coming off his first 100-yard rushing game. His 62-yard touchdown run against Kansas State was the longest run by a CU quarterback since Darian Hagan's 71-yard run for a touchdown against Colorado State in 1989.

Jackson & Hugh Charles teamed for 171 yards vs. K-State. The duo owns six of the top 33 efforts in school history for combined rushing yards by a quarterback and tailback. The 171 yards is 28th on the list, as all six by the pair are from this season.



IOWA STATE (3-7, 0-6)
This Week: at Colorado
Next Week: Missouri

Milan Moses set career highs in receptions (nine) and receiving yardage (109) vs. Kansas. Moses now has 16 catches for 224 yards in the last three games.

Ryan Kock's one-yard touchdown run Saturday was his 17th career rushing touchdown, and third of the season. He is one touchdown shy of tying Joe Henderson (18, 1985-88) for 10th place on ISU's career chart.

Alvin Bowen tallied 18 tackles last week, giving him 134 for the season. Bowen, the nation's leading tackler, came into the game with a 12.89 average and improved it to 13.40. Bowen has five games this season with 15 or more tackles.



KANSAS (5-5, 2-4)
This Week: Idle
Next Week: Kansas State

Freshman quarterback Kerry Meier's 50-yard touchdown pass to wide receiver Brian Murph Saturday was KU's longest touchdown through the air this season. Meier's 12 touchdown passes this season are a KU freshman record.

KU's defense has allowed just one touchdown in the last two games.

Senior running back Jon Cornish moved into 11th place on Kansas' career rushing list with 1,908 for his career. He also moved into ninth place on KU's single-season chart with 1,120 yards.

Kansas has scored 58 points off 13 opponent miscues over the last four outings. The Jayhawks have scored 74 points off 22 takeaways for the season.



KANSAS STATE (6-4, 3-3)
This Week: Texas
Next Week: at Kansas

Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week Josh Freeman completed 22-of-26 attempts (84.6 percent) for 251 yards, two touchdowns and no turnovers against Colorado. His 84.6 completion percentage is the highest in a Big 12 game this year and the second best in K-State history.

Freeman's 74-yard TD pass to Jordy Nelson is the Wildcats' longest play from scrimmage this season. He ended the day with 1,138 passing yards for the year which is a record for a true freshman at K-State.

KSU is bowl eligible for the first time since its 2003 Big 12 Championship team.

Leon Patton has scored in four of his last five games.

K-State's offense totaled 439 yards, its highest output of the season and breaking the 400-yard barrier for the first time since its 658 yards last season against North Texas.



MISSOURI (7-3, 3-3)
This Week: Idle
Next Week: at Iowa State

Chase Daniel was 20-for-38 and 244 yards at Nebraska. He raised his total to 2,531 yards in 10 games to break the single-season yardage record set by Jeff Handy in 1992.

Tony Temple rushed for 99 yards on 18 carries last week to improve his season total to 761. He averages 5.2 yards per carry.

Freshman receiver Danario Alexander had a career day against Nebraska with four catches for 89 yards. Going into the game he had four catches for 40 yards on the season and hadn't caught a pass since MU's third game.

Jeff Wolfert's 54-yard field goal tied for the second-longest in MU history. It surpassed his previous long of 44 yards, and it was the 16th FG in MU history of 50 yards or more, and the longest in MU annals away from Columbia.



NEBRASKA (7-3, 4-2)

This Week: at Texas A&M
Next Week: Idle

Zac Taylor tied the Nebraska season record of 20 touchdown passes. He has a streak of 80 straight passes without an interception. His 61.9 percent completion rate is just off of the Nebraska season record of 63.1 percent.

Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week Bo Ruud was responsible for two of Nebraska's takeaways against Missouri. He intercepted a second-quarter pass and returned it 40 yards for the longest return by a Husker this season. He also had a fumble recovery in the last two minutes of the game.

The Cornhusker offense has posted 871 yards over the last two games.



OKLAHOMA (7-2, 4-1)

This Week: Texas Tech
Next Week: at Baylor

Allen Patrick rushed for 173 yards in the win at Texas A&M. Patrick has eclipsed the 100-yard mark in each of the last three games since taking over the starting duties in place of the injured Adrian Peterson.

Oklahoma has had an individual rush for 100 yards in every game this season. OU has rushed for at least 100 yards as a team for 15 consecutive games.

Michael Cohen's 75-yard punt was the longest punt by a Sooner since Brian Lewis' 81-yarder against Oklahoma State in 1996. That punt ranks 17th on the all-time list.

The Sooner defense has forced at least one turnover in 89 of Bob Stoops' 100 games and has one interception in 66 of the last 87.



OKLAHOMA STATE (5-4, 2-3)

This Week: Baylor
Next Week: at Texas Tech

With his sack against Texas, senior defensive end Victor DeGrate has 8.5 on the season and raised his career total to 16, which moved him into seventh on the Oklahoma State all-time list.

Bobby Reid has 1,739 passing yards on the season, which ranks ninth on OSU's single-season list. Reid's 2,068 yards of offense are the sixth best single-season total.

Junior Adarius Bowman has 44 receptions for 943 yards on the season. The 943 receiving yards rank sixth on the Cowboys' single-season list. The 66 catches are good for 13th best in a single season.

Senior Grant Jones' kickoff return for a touchdown was the first of his career. The 89-yard return tied for the longest of Jones' career (at Kansas State earlier this season) and tied for the 12th-longest kickoff return in Cowboys history.



TEXAS (9-1, 6-0)

This Week: at Kansas State
Next Week: Idle

The Longhorns posted their 21st consecutive regular-season win against Big 12 competition, tying the record set by Kansas State between 1997-99.

Texas now has nine wins in each of the last nine seasons. UT and Miami (Fla.) entered the season as the only two I-A programs riding streaks of eight consecutive nine-win seasons.

Texas rolled up 500 yards of total offense Saturday for the first time in 2006 and the 29th time during the Mack Brown era.

Quan Cosby recorded his first career 100-yard receiving game. In the last two games, he has 11 receptions for 180 yards and a touchdown.

Colt McCoy threw for a career-high 346 yards against Oklahoma State while setting a school record for TD passes in a season with 27.



TEXAS A&M (8-2, 4-2)

This Week: Nebraska
Next Week: Idle

Sophomore running back Jorvorskie Lane scored touchdown No. 18 last Saturday, leaving him just one behind the second-oldest record in the Texas A&M record book: Joel Hunt's 19 rushing touchdowns in 1927.

Freshman running back Mike Goodson rushed for a career-high 127 yards on 10 carries against Oklahoma.

The Aggies' defense held OU to 98 yards and six first downs in the final three quarters.

A&M came into the game as the national leader in possession time (34:08) and had a 31:24-to-28:36 edge vs. the Sooners.

Defensive end Chris Harrington had eight tackles vs. OU, including four solo stops, 2.5 for loss and a sack, and a fumble recovery.



TEXAS TECH (6-4, 3-3)

This Week: at Oklahoma
Next Week: Oklahoma State

Joel Filani turned in the second-best day of his career with 212 yards on eight receptions against Baylor. He scored on three receptions for the third time in his career and second this season (Iowa State). Filani averaged 26.5 yards per catch, the best single-game performance by a receiver under Mike Leach.

Shannon Woods ran for a career-high 125 yards on 10 carries vs. Baylor.

Tech post a season-best 682 total yards against Baylor.

Senior defensive end Keyunta Dawson sits in fourth place on the career sacks list at Texas Tech with 19.

Texas Tech is bowl-eligible for the seventh straight season.
