The 10th annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship takes place at Houston's Reliant Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 3, at 12 p.m. (CT) under the television cameras of ABC Sports.

General public tickets are available at all Ticketmaster outlets, by phone at (713) 629-3700, online at ticketmaster.com or at the Reliant Stadium South ticket windows. For ticket package opportunities which include prime game tickets, parking and hospitality, call Jack Berger at (832) 667-1439. For suite information, call Ellie Windsor at (832) 667-1805.

Tickets are priced at \$98 (Club), \$78 (Field Level, Mezzanine), \$68 (Loge, Upper Level) and \$48 (Upper Level Ends, 700 Level).

In the nine-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

Player of the Week Watch

Colorado place kicker, Mason Crosby, claimed his fourth Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week honor this season, and seventh of his career. His seven career honors ties him with former Texas running back, Ricky Williams, for the all-time high in the Big 12, while his four season awards ties him for second-place with former Texas Tech quarterback, Kliff Kingsbury (2002), and one behind Williams during his Heisman Trophy winning season (1998).

Rushing to the Top

For the first time in Big 12 history, a quarterback can finish the season as the Conference's leading rusher. Currently, Missouri's Brad Smith sits atop the league rushing chart (919 yds), followed by Texas' Vince Young (778 yds).

Tough Sledding

Rushing yards continue to be at a premium in the Big 12 Conference with three teams ranked in the Top 5 nationally in rushing defense: 1-Kansas (64.1 ypg), 2-Oklahoma (69.2 ypg), and 5-Colorado (81.6 ypg).

Divisional Races

Both, Texas (South) and Colorado (North) can clinch divisional titles and a berth in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game with victories this Saturday.

Big 12 Preseason Media Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in two of the last three seasons (OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Last year the media accurately predicted OU to win the South, but incorrectly picked KSU in the North. Overall the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 10-of-18 times. Following are this season's projections.

BAYLOR (4-5, 1-5)

This Week: at Missouri
Next Week: Oklahoma State

Safety Maurice Lane posted his 19th career double-digit tackle game (13) last Saturday against Texas. Lane leads the team and ranks fifth in the Big 12 with 78 tackles on the season.

Dominique Zeigler ranks fifth on Baylor's all-time receptions list with 101 career receptions.

The Bears need wins in their last two games to be bowl eligible.

Saturday's game against Texas marked the first time this season Baylor's defense did not force a turnover, as well as the first time the Bears were under 100 yard passing since the 88 yards against Missouri in 2004.



COLORADO (7-2, 5-1)

This Week: at Iowa State
Next Week: Idle

Against Missouri, Joel Klatt opened the game with 12 straight pass completions, tying for the third longest streak in school history. Klatt's 31 passes without an interception extended his streak to 122, his 33rd school record.

Missouri was the seventh opponent Colorado held under 100 yards rushing this season, a school best. CU has allowed 734 rushing yards this season, or 81.6 per game.

Colorado clinches its second consecutive Big 12 North Division title with a win Saturday at Iowa State. The Buffs have played in the Conference championship game three of the last four seasons.

Colorado is 5-0 at home for the first time since going 6-0 in 1994.



IOWA STATE (6-3, 3-3)

This Week: Colorado
Next Week: Idle

With the win over Kansas State, Iowa State becomes bowl eligible for the fifth time in six seasons. This was the first time the Cyclones have won back-to-back games against the Wildcats since Iowa State beat Kansas State five straight years from 1985-89.

Iowa State allowed Kansas State just 12 yards rushing on 39 Wildcat carries. That marked the Cyclones second-best effort in rushing defense ever in conference play. The school-best is minus 16 yards allowed at Colorado in 1984. The mark is eighth on the all-time overall chart.

Todd Blythe tied Ed Williams (1994-97) and Keith Krepfle (1971-73) for the school record for touchdown receptions in his career with 15.



KANSAS (5-4, 2-4)

This Week: at Texas
Next Week: Idle

Kansas defeated Nebraska for the first time since 1968, snapping a streak of 36 straight wins by the Cornhuskers.

The Jayhawks' 40 points marked the most ever against Nebraska, as well as marked the most by KU in a Big 12 game since 1999 when Kansas defeated Baylor 45-10.

Mark Simmons' 40-yard touchdown reception last Saturday against Nebraska was the 14th of his career and fifth of 40 yards or more. The senior wide receiver has caught a pass in 33 consecutive games.

KU leads the nation in rush defense, allowing 64.1 yards per game. The Jayhawks have held five of nine opponents to less than 50 yards rushing, and have allowed over 100 rushing yards twice.



KANSAS STATE (4-5, 1-5)

This Week: at Nebraska
Next Week: Missouri

Ted Sims is tied for the Big 12 lead with three fumble recoveries this season.

The Wildcats are sixth in the Big 12 in conference games only red zone defense, surrendering points on 77.8 percent (21-of-27) of red zone penetrations.

Kansas State has scored in 113 straight games, dating back to the 1996 Colorado game. The scoring streak is currently the 12th longest in the nation.

The Wildcats need victories in each of their last two games (at Nebraska, vs. Missouri) to become bowl eligible. Last season snapped K-State's streak of 11 consecutive bowl appearances.

K-State has committed a conference-high 14 fumbles.



MISSOURI (5-4, 3-3)

This Week: Baylor
Next Week: at Kansas State

If Missouri ends in a three-way tie at 5-3 atop the North Division standings with Colorado and Iowa State, the Tigers would hold the tie-breaker if Nebraska finishes ahead of Kansas in the standings by virtue of their win over the Cornhuskers.

In Saturday's game at Colorado, Brad Smith became the NCAA's all-time leader in quarterback rushing yards (3,907), surpassing Antwan Randle El's record of 3,895 yards.

Missouri needs one win in its last two games (vs. Baylor, at Kansas State) to become bowl eligible and play in its second bowl game in three seasons.

Defensive back David Overstreet leads the Tigers with 70 tackles, including 40 solo stops.



NEBRASKA (5-4, 2-4)

This Week: Kansas State
Next Week: Idle

Corey McKeon recorded his team-leading second interception of the season against Kansas. He also registered a safety on his seventh sack of the season, the second-highest single-season total by a Nebraska linebacker. His 17 tackles for loss this season is the third-most by a NU linebacker.

With his eight-tackle performance vs. Kansas, Daniel Bullocks became the third Husker defensive back to top 200 career tackles. He heads into the last two regular season games with 206 career stops.

Terrance Nunn has a five-game touchdown receptions streak.



OKLAHOMA (5-3, 4-1)

This Week: Texas A&M
Next Week: at Texas Tech

The Sooners come off an open date needing one win in their last three games to assure themselves of their seventh consecutive bowl appearance.

The three teams that have defeated Oklahoma (Texas, UCLA, TCU) are a combined 24-1.

Adrian Peterson missed all or more than half of four straight games with an ankle injury before returning to rush for 146 yards at Nebraska.

Defensive Tackle Dusty Dvoracek has 15 tackles for loss this year, with 41 career TFL he has surpassed Sooner legends Tony Casillas, Lee Roy Selmon and Darrell Reed on the OU list.



OKLAHOMA STATE (3-5, 0-5)

This Week: Texas Tech
Next Week: at Baylor

Oklahoma State was idle last week.

Mike Hamilton ran for a career-high 194 yards on 31 carries against Texas.

Al Pena, who had thrown eight interceptions and lost two fumbles in his first two starts since replacing the injured Bobby Reid, finished with 152 yards on 12-for-27 passing with two touchdowns and no turnovers against Texas.

OSU posted a season-high 402 yards of offense against a Texas defense that entered the contest leading the Big 12 and ranked sixth nationally with an average of 272.6 yards. The Cowboys rushed for a season-best 250 yards in the contest.



TEXAS (9-0, 6-0)

This Week: Kansas
Next Week: Idle

Texas has won 16 consecutive games, the second longest winning streak in UT history to 30 wins from 1978-70. It is also the second longest active streak in the nation behind USC (30).

Texas has posted 1,247 yards of offense in its last two games, including 645 total yards, the fifth highest total in school history, last week at Baylor. UT totalled 602 yards the previous week at Oklahoma State.

The Longhorns are the only team to score 50 or more points five times in 2005 in games versus Division 1-A opponents.

Texas leads the Big 12 in scoring offense (48.3 ppg), rushing offense (278.6 ypg), scoring defense (14.3 ppg), pass defense (166.2 ypg), kickoff returns (25.8 ypr), pass efficiency (162.0), pass defense efficiency (95.4), and 3rd-down conversions (50.4 pct).



TEXAS A&M (5-4, 3-3)

This Week: at Oklahoma
Next Week: Idle

The Aggies need one win in their final two games (at Oklahoma, vs. Texas) to become bowl eligible. A&M's two remaining opponents have a combined record of 14-3. TAMU has not beaten Texas since the 1999 season, or OU since '98.

Quarterback Reggie McNeil leads the Big 12 with four 100-yard rushing games this season.

With 49 catches for 732 yards thus far this season, senior Jason Carter is on pace to break the A&M single-season receiving record of 895 yards set by Robert Ferguson in 2000.

Junior linebacker Justin Warren leads the Big 12 with 86 tackles and a 9.6 tackles per game average.



TEXAS TECH (8-1, 5-1)

This Week: at Oklahoma State
Next Week: Oklahoma

Texas Tech leads the nation in passing yards, averaging 428.8 yards. The Red Raiders have finished atop the NCAA in the category each of the last three seasons.

Senior running back Taurean Henderson enters the Oklahoma State game with a career-best two-game 100-yard rushing streak (109 vs. Texas A&M, 136 at Baylor). He has posted seven 100-yard rushing games in his career.

Henderson is the Big 12 all-time career touchdowns leader with 67 and in scoring with 408 points. He presently ranks second in career receptions (289) and fourth in rushing touchdowns (49).

Senior free safety Dwayne Slay set a Big 12 single-season record when he forced his eighth fumble in last week's win over Texas A&M.

Instant Replay

The Big 12 has two main principles with regard to review:

- A standard of **indisputable video evidence** for any on-field call to be changed;
- A review must have a **direct, competitive effect** on the game, such as a change of possession, scoring play, etc.

Plays that **MAY** be reviewed with the use video replay:

1. Plays governed by sideline, goal line and end line:

- a) Scoring plays, including a runner breaking the plane of the goal line.
- b) Pass complete/incomplete/intercepted at sideline, goal line and end line.
- c) Runner/receiver in or out of bounds.
- d) Recovery of loose ball in bounds.

2. Passing Plays:

- a) Pass ruled complete/incomplete/intercepted in the field of play and end zones.
- b) Touching of a forward pass by an ineligible receiver.
- c) Touching of a forward pass by a defensive player.
- d) Quarterback (passer) forward pass or fumble (if ruled incomplete, the play is finalized).
- e) Illegal forward pass or illegal handing beyond the line of scrimmage.
- f) Illegal forward pass or illegal handing after change of possession.
- g) Forward or backward pass thrown from behind the line of scrimmage.

3. Other detectable infractions:

- a) Runner ruled not down.
- b) Forward progress errors with respect to first down.
- c) Touching of a kick.
- d) Number of players on field.
- e) Clock adjustments.
- f) Fourth-down/try fumble plays.

Plays that **MAY NOT** be reviewed with the use of video replay:

1. Holding.
2. Offside/encroachment.
3. Pass interference.
4. Personal fouls (e.g., late hits).
5. Illegal blocks.
6. Illegal formations.
7. Face mask.
8. Taunting/excessive celebration.
9. False starts.
10. Roughing the passer/kicker.
11. Fighting participants.
