### Young Guns

Three Big 12 teams returned their starting quarterbacks from last season - Baylor (Shawn Bell), Iowa State (Bret Meyer) and Nebraska (Zac Taylor) return QBs that started the majority of their team's games in 2005. Three-quarters of the league's teams (9-of-12) feature quarterbacks that were spot starters in previous seasons, or are first-time starters.

### Record Setters

Adarius Bowman (Oklahoma State) set a Big 12 Conference record with 300 receiving yards in last Saturday's win over Kansas. Bowman broke the mark of 255 yards established by Texas Tech's Joel Filani on October 15, 2005, against Kansas State.

Colorado place kicker Mason Crosby became the first player in league history to be named Player of the Week eight times during their career. Crosby was selected Special Teams Player of the Week following Saturday's performance in the win over Texas Tech. It marked the eighth time in his career to receive the honor, surpassing seven-time winners Ricky Williams (Texas), Eric Crouch (Nebraska) and Kliff Kingsbury (Texas Tech).

### Big 12 BCS Success

The 2005 season marked the third straight and fifth time in the last six years that a Big 12 team played in the BCS National Championship game. Since the inception of the the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship game and leads all conferences with its five appearances. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

### Big 12 Preseason Media Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in three of the last four seasons (UT/OU-05, OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Last year the media accurately predicted Texas to win the South and Colorado to win the North. Overall the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 11-of-20 times. Following are this season's projections.

**BAYLOR (3-4, 2-1)**

**This Week:** Kansas  
**Next Week:** Texas A&M

Shawn Bell's fourth quarter touchdown pass in the loss at Texas was the 32nd TD pass of his career, tying Cody Carlson's school record. He also became the fifth quarterback in Baylor history to eclipse the 5,000-yard plateau in career passing yards and now has 5,012.

The Bears have outscored opponents 64-7 in the first quarters of the last eight games

Paul Mosley's 56-yard run against Texas was the longest by a Bear this season.

Trent Shelton has caught a TD pass in each of the last four games.

Cornerback C.J. Wilson tied his career high with seven tackles, equaling his total from last week's game at Colorado.



**COLORADO (1-6, 1-2)**

**This Week:** at Oklahoma  
**Next Week:** at Kansas

Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week, Mason Crosby's 56-yard field goal against Texas Tech is the second-longest in the NCAA this season, behind only an Alex Serna 58-yard kick for Oregon State. His 53-yarder enabled him to join UCLA's Justin Medlock as the only kickers in the nation with two of over 50-plus this season. Crosby now owns six of the eight longest field goals in school history.

Colorado did not commit a penalty in last Saturday's game for just the fourth time in its history, the first time since Sept. 21, 1985, against Ohio State in Boulder.

Co-Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week, Ryan Walters had the first two interceptions of his career Saturday against Texas Tech, marking the second straight game a Buff has picked off two passes.



**IOWA STATE (3-4, 0-3)**

**This Week:** Texas Tech  
**Next Week:** at Kansas State

Mike Brandtner's 73-yard punt against Oklahoma is the longest of his career. The effort ties for the seventh-longest in school history with Rich Miller who kicked a 73-yarder against Nebraska in 1973.

The safety recorded by Iowa State last Saturday at Oklahoma was the Cyclones' first since the 2005 season opener.

Stevie Hicks' 58-yard run on the last play of the first half at Oklahoma was the longest of his career. With 83 yards on 13 carries, Hicks now ranks eighth on the all-time ISU career rushing list with 2,545 yards.

Todd Blythe's three receptions Saturday give him 118 career grabs, moving him into a tie for fifth in the ISU record books with Dennis Ross (1985-88).



**KANSAS (3-4, 0-3)**

**This Week:** at Baylor  
**Next Week:** Colorado

Kansas forced four Oklahoma State turnovers and has caused at least one in 37 of its last 41 contests, including 14 of its last 17 games.

KU held OSU scoreless in the first half to record its second first half shutout of the season (South Florida).

Freshman quarterback Kerry Meier had three touchdown passes last week for a total of nine on the season. Meier has had multiple TD pass completions in all four games played this season. Meier also rushed for a career-high 70 yards on a career-high 20 carries.

Senior running back Jon Cornish has had six rushes of 30-plus yards this season, including a 35-yard run last Saturday.



**KANSAS STATE (4-3, 1-2)**

**This Week:** at Missouri  
**Next Week:** Iowa State

Kansas State freshman quarterback Josh Freeman earned his second career start last Saturday and finished the night 23-for-47 for 272 yards. Freeman's 272 yards were a career high and the most ever by a KSU true freshman quarterback.

Senior wide receiver Jermaine Moreira caught six passes against Nebraska, giving him 113 for his career. His 113 career catches rank seventh all-time at K-State. Also, with 86 receiving yards, Moreira moved into eighth place with 1,582 career receiving yards.

Jeff Snodgrass has 20 career field goals, the seventh-most in school history and also has four 50-plus yard field goals, which are the second-most in school history, one behind Martin Gramatica. His 10 field goals this season are the 10th-most in single-season school history.



**MISSOURI (6-1, 2-1)**

**This Week:** Kansas State  
**Next Week:** Oklahoma

Missouri has held five of its seven opponents to under 100 yards rushing. The Tigers rank third in the Big 12 in rushing defense, surrendering 88 yards per game.

Will Franklin totaled a game-high 119 yards on four receptions against Texas A&M.

Jorvorskie Lane's 127-yard rushing effort last Saturday was the first 100-yard game surrendered by the Missouri defense this season.

William Franklin is second in the Big 12 and 15th nationally in receiving yards per game with 86.14.

Quarterback Chase Daniel is averaging 277.29 yards of offense to rank second in the Big 12 and ninth in the nation. He needs 59 yards to reach 2,000 for the season.



**NEBRASKA (6-1, 3-0)**

**This Week:** Texas  
**Next Week:** at Oklahoma State

Nebraska won its 800th game in program history while snapping a four-game losing streak in Manhattan, Kan. The Huskers joined Michigan (855), Notre Dame (816) and Texas (806) as the only Division I schools with 800 wins.

The 21-3 win Saturday at Kansas State marked the first time this season Nebraska did not commit a turnover. The Huskers have not thrown an interception in three games.

With its sixth win, the Huskers are bowl-eligible for the 44th time.

The Nebraska defense has held an opponent to under 100 yards rushing four times this season.



**OKLAHOMA (4-2, 1-1)**

**This Week:** Colorado  
**Next Week:** at Missouri

Adrian Peterson suffered a broken collarbone against Iowa State and is out indefinitely. He sustained the injury while scoring his 40th career touchdown. Peterson now has 3,968 rushing yards in his career, good for No. 4 on the OU career list.

Garrett Hartley was 2-of-2 on field goals against Iowa State and is 12-of-13 on the season to rank second nationally. His lone miss was a block on a game-winning attempt in the closing seconds at Oregon.

Over its last three outings the OU defense has surrendered an average of 188.3 yards. Since giving up 501 total yards at Oregon, OU has given up a total of 565 in the last three games.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (4-2, 1-1)**

**This Week:** Texas A&M  
**Next Week:** Nebraska

Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week, Adarius Bowman set a Big 12 single game receiving record with 300 yards against Kansas. He had 13 catches, four of which went for touchdowns in a 16-minute time span. Bowman leads the nation in receiving yards per game (123.8) and is second in yards per reception (22.5).

Sophomore quarterback Bobby Reid broke head coach Mike Gundy's school record for total offense with 457 yards in the KU game. He threw five TD passes and ran for another, all in the second half.

The Reid-to-Bowman 300-yard game also set a Big 12 record for a passing/receiving duo.

The Cowboys' offense ranks second in the Big 12 and seventh nationally, averaging 38.2 points per game.



**TEXAS (6-1, 3-0)**

**This Week:** at Nebraska  
**Next Week:** at Texas Tech

Colt McCoy set a UT record for most TD passes in a game with six, besting the mark of five set by James Brown in 1994 and equaled by Chris Simms in 2001. He has thrown at least one TD pass in all seven of his collegiate games and has 1,229 passing yards on the season to rank fourth on the freshman passing yardage list.

Big 12 Co-Defensive Player of the Week, Tim Crowder registered seven tackles, four for loss, three sacks, forced two fumbles, batted down a pass and registered two quarterback hurries in the win over Baylor.

Robert Killebrew's 31-yard return of a fumble recovery in the fourth quarter was his second TD of the season. He also recovered a blocked punt in the end zone for a TD against Sam Houston State.

The Longhorns have forced 10 fumbles over the last two games. In the first five games, UT had forced just four fumbles.



**TEXAS A&M (6-1, 2-1)**

**This Week:** at Oklahoma State  
**Next Week:** at Baylor

Jorvorskie Lane rushed for a season-high 127 yards and tied his career-best with 28 carries. Lane now has four career 100-yard rushing games. Lane added a touchdown run, giving him 14 for the season. The school record is 19 by Joel Hunt in 1927.

Quarterback Stephen McGee made his first career catch with a 12-yard reception that came when his pass was batted into the air at the line of scrimmage. With the pass and catch, McGee has now used 16 different receivers this season, which matches a school record.

Melvin Bullitt tied for the team lead with 11 tackles with two of those going for lost yardage. He also broke up two passes as the Aggie defense kept the Missouri offense out of the end zone in the second half. The Aggie defense held Missouri to a season-low 74 rushing yards.



**TEXAS TECH (4-3, 1-2)**

**This Week:** at Iowa State  
**Next Week:** Texas

Sophomore PK Alex Trlica needs two points to become Texas Tech's all-time leading scoring kicker. He currently has 219 career points (27 FG, 138 XP) and trails former Tech great Lin Elliott (220, 1988-91). Overall, Trlica is sixth on the Tech career scoring list.

The Red Raiders are playing back-to-back road games for the first time since the 2003 season. Tech faced Colorado in Boulder last weekend and meets Iowa State in Ames on Saturday. The Red Raiders close the season with three of four games at home.

Keyunta Dawson continues to move up the sacks list with 17 in his career. He has three and a half on the season and is tied with two former Red Raiders in fifth place on the career list. He needs a sack and a half to tie for the fourth place spot.
