



# Tolan sparks Buffs to third-place finish

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. — The Colorado men's golf team put two players in the top 10 and the Buffs finished third overall Saturday in the Tucker Invitational.

CU pulled within two strokes of the lead on two occasions but couldn't get over the hump in the race for the team title.

Pepperdine held on to win the Tucker at even-par 864. San Diego State ended up four strokes behind, and CU was seven back of the Waves.

CU's showing was its third-best ever in the 53-year history of the Tucker.

CU junior Derek Tolan (73-215) finished seventh individually and sophomore Luke Symons (73-216) was ninth, recording his first top-10 as a college player.

"I got a lot out of my game this week," Tolan said.. "I had a really good start here and then just kind of hung in there."

CU will return to inter-collegiate action Oct. 15-16 at The Prestige At PGA West in La Quinta, Calif.
