QUICKLY...The University of Colorado (8-13, 1-9 Big 12 Conference) travels to play the University of Kansas (10-11, 3-7 Big 12) on Sunday, Feb. 13, at 12 p.m. MST in Allen Fieldhouse in Lawrence, Kan. The game will be televised by the Metro Sports Network in Kansas but will not be available in the Boulder-Denver area.

BUFFS ON THE AIR...Colorado women's basketball regular and post season games are broadcast live on KKZN AM 760, Boulder's Progressive Talk station. **Tim Smile** will handle play by play duties and is joined by USA Basketball's **Carol Callan** with the color commentary.

31ST SEASON...Colorado is in its 31st season of varsity women's basketball sporting an all-time record of 585-326 (.642). The Buffaloes have made 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, all since 1988, including six Sweet 16 appearances and three trips to the Elite Eight (1993, 1995 & 2002).

BUFFS SEARCHING FOR SECOND LEAGUE WIN...Colorado lost its sixth straight game in Big 12 play with a 58-55 setback at home against Missouri on Feb. 9. The Buffs, who hadn't lost six straight since the 1984-85 season, are in 12th place in the league standings at 1-9, one game behind Missouri and Oklahoma State who are each 2-8. The Buffaloes will be looking to avoid their first seven game losing streak since the 1984-85 season when they play at Kansas on Sunday. CU will also be trying to avoid double digits in league losses which hasn't happened since a 4-12 Big 12 campaign in 1999-2000. Senior point guard **Veronica Johns-Richardson** has taken over the team lead in scoring (10.0 ppg) and also paces the Buffaloes in assists (66) and steals (44). Johns-Richardson has been solid from the field in league games hitting 52.1 percent from the field (37x71), fifth best in the Big 12. Sophomore forward **Jasminia Ilic** is second in scoring (9.8 ppg) and actually leads the Buffs in scoring during Big 12 games (11.3 ppg). Ilic also has a team-leading 26 3-point field goals. Sophomore forward **Anna Nedovic** tops the Buffaloes in rebounding (6.6 rpg) and is just a handful of points behind Ilic and Johns-Richardson in the scoring column averaging 9.7 per game. The freshman duo of forward **Jackie McFarland** and center **Kara Richards** have nearly identical outputs, combining for 18.5 points and 11.7 rebounds per game. Richards, who has started all 21 games, is averaging 9.3 points and 5.4 rebounds per game and is second on the squad in field-goal percentage (.468, 80x171). McFarland, a two-time Big 12 Rookie of the Week, is averaging 9.2 points and is second on the squad at 6.3 rebounds per game. Junior **Whitney Law** is sixth on the squad in the scoring column at 7.2 points per game and tops Colorado in both free-throw percentage (.714, 20x28) and 3-point field-goal percentage (.425, 17x40).

COLORADO FALLS TO MIZZOU ON LAST SECOND SHOT...**Whitney Law** had a pair of career-highs and a second career double-double but Missouri's LaToya Bond stole the show as the junior guard hit a 3-pointer at the buzzer to beat the Buffaloes 58-55, Wednesday night at the Coors Events Center.

On the final play of the game the Tigers had Bond matched up one-on-one with Colorado's **Veronica Johns-Richardson**. Johns-Richardson knocked the ball away, but Bond recovered it and while falling backwards, took the shot from 20 feet. The buzzer went off as the ball was in the air and Missouri's bench erupted as the Tigers ended an eight-game skid.

With two and a half minutes remaining the Tigers were up by six but Colorado fought back. Johns-Richardson, who had 11 points, scored on a running layup with 13 seconds left to tie the game at 55.

Law tied a career high with 14 points and grabbed a personal-best 12 rebounds. Junior center **Tami Garnett** scored a career-high nine points and had six rebounds for Colorado while senior forward **Sarah Lini** had a personal-best eight rebounds. The Buffaloes, who have lost six straight, hit just 5-of-14 from the foul line, 3-of-9 in the second half.

Colorado led for the majority of the game but the Tigers took the lead for the first time with just over six minutes remaining. At halftime the Buffs were up 34-25.

KANSAS TRYING TO GET BACK TO .500...The Jayhawks will be looking to climb back to .500 after a 57-54 loss at Oklahoma State on Wednesday dropped them to 10-11 overall. KU is tied for eighth place in the Big 12 with Texas A&M at 3-7. Kansas has the lowest scoring offense in the Big 12 (57.8 ppg) but offsets its offensive woes with the third-best scoring defense in the league (56.2 ppg). Junior forward Crystal Kemp leads the Jayhawks, averaging 13.8 points and 8.8 rebounds per game. Junior guard Erica Hallman is second in scoring (12.2 ppg) and leads the Jayhawks with 109 assists.

WHO WANTS TO WIN AT HOME???...Colorado and Kansas share the odd distinction of having better conference records on the road than they have at home. The Jayhawks are just 1-3 in Allen Fieldhouse during Big 12 play with the win coming over Missouri on Jan. 22 (65-60). KU is 2-4 on the road picking up wins at Missouri and at Colorado. The Buffaloes' lone Big 12 win came on the road at Missouri on Jan. (56-51). CU is 1-4 on the road in Big 12 play, 0-5 at home.

COLORADO-KANSAS SERIES...This will be the 55th meeting between Colorado and Kansas with the Buffaloes holding a slight 28-26 edge. Kansas' 65-60 win in Boulder on Jan. 25 broke CU's eight game win streak in the series dating back to the 2000-01 season. Colorado has won the last four meetings at Allen Fieldhouse including a 59-49 decision in 2003-04. KU's last win in Lawrence over CU was a 78-56 decision on Jan. 15, 2000. CU will be looking to even its overall series with the Jayhawks in Lawrence, as KU holds a 12-11 lead.

BUFFS WELL BALANCED...Talk about balance, CU's top five scoring leaders are averaging between 9.2 and 10.0 points per game. Veronica Johns-Richardson leads the squad at 10.0 per outing followed by **Jasmina Ilic** at 9.8, **Anna Nedovic** at 9.7, **Kara Richards** at 9.3 and **Jackie McFarland** at 9.2. Only seven total points separate Johns-Richardson (211), Ilic (205) and Nedovic (204) with Richards (196) likely to join the 200-point club on Sunday. CU is on pace to have its lowest scoring average for a single-season leader since Michell Irving averaged exactly 10 points per game in 1975-76. On three occasions CU's scoring leader at the end of the season has been below 11 points, the last coming in 1998-99 when Linda Lappe averaged 10.7 per contest.

UNDERCLASSMEN SHINE FOR BUFFS...This season, Colorado has received 65.4 percent of its scoring and 63.7 of its rebounding from either freshmen or sophomores, leading the Big 12 in both categories. Four of CU's top five scorers are underclassmen (two freshmen, two sophomores) and the Buffs' top three rebounders are sophomore Anna Nedovic (6.6 rpg) and freshmen Jackie McFarland (6.3 rpg) and Kara Richards (5.4 rpg). CU just beats out Nebraska (63.0 percent) and Texas A&M (60.2 percent) in scoring and has a wide margin over second place Oklahoma State (55.5 percent) and third place Texas A&M (50.7) in rebounding. FABULOUS IN FEBRUARY...Colorado is 147-94 (.610) all-time in games played in the month of February. On games played on Feb. 13 the Buffaloes are 6-3 overall, 2-2 on the road.

McFARLAND HEADS HOME...Freshman **Jackie McFarland** heads back to the Sunflower State for the first time as a Buff, Sunday at Kansas. McFarland, a 6-3 forward, is a native of Derby, Kan., where she was an all-state player at Derby High School and holds the career and single-season scoring record.

VJ FROM DOWNTOWN...Senior **Veronica Johns-Richardson** has taken sole possession of 10th place on Colorado's career 3-point field-goals made list. She passed Emily Waner by hitting her 52nd career 3 against Kansas State on Jan. 29 and now has 54. She has 23 treys on the season, helped by a school-record tying seven against Northern Colorado on Dec. 29. Johns-Richardson is currently 9th in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage this season at .393.

WORKING OVERTIME...Colorado's 76-70 overtime loss to Oklahoma State was its second extra session this season marking the ninth time the Buffaloes have played multiple games in overtime in any one season. Colorado has had three overtime games in one season on three different occasions, the last coming during the 1995-96 season which was also the last season CU had multiple overtime games. The loss also snapped Colorado's four-game winning streak in overtime games. Seven of CU's last eight overtime games have come on the road including a 76-74 win at Washington this past December. Overall the Buffaloes are 16-16 in overtime games.

A RARE DROUGHT FROM THREE...Colorado was 0-for-8 from the 3-point arc in its win over Missouri marking the first time in 76 games the Buffs have gone without a 3-point field goal. The last time CU was shut out from downtown was during its 94-60 loss to Oklahoma in the 2002 NCAA Elite Eight (Mar. 25, 2002). Colorado was near matching its school record streak of 78 games set from Jan. 22, 2000 to Mar. 23, 2002.

AGAINST THE NATION'S BEST...Colorado's loss to Iowa State dropped the Buffaloes to 0-4 against ranked teams this season. Colorado has lost 10 straight against teams ranked in the two major polls dating back to the 2003-04 campaign. The Buffs' last win over a ranked team came in the 2003-04 league opener at Baylor where CU took care of the No. 24 Bears 69-59 on Jan. 7. CU is 47-90 all-time against ranked opponents and has a 27-25 mark in Boulder. As of the most recent polls, Colorado has three remaining games against ranked teams.

BUFFS CONTINUE SUCCESS IN PRESEASON...With a five-game winning streak in December, Colorado clinched its fifth straight season with a record of .500 or better during the nonconference regular season schedule. The Buffs have only finished below .500 twice during the

COLORADO WELL REPRESENTED WITH BIG 12 ROOKIES OF THE WEEK...Colorado has had players voted as the Big 12 Rookie of the Week three times in 2004-05.

Forward Jackie McFarland has received the honor twice -- on Dec. 6 and Jan. 3. Center Kara Richards earned the award in the first week of the regular season, back on Nov. 22.

Most recently, McFarland was cited for her performance over the holiday break where she averaged 10.7 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.0 assists and connected on 68.4 percent of her field goals (13-of-19). McFarland had 16 points on a career-best 8-of-13 shooting against Washington, which included the game-winning layup with under two seconds left in overtime. McFarland made all three of her shots from the field and had five rebounds against Northern Colorado. She then recorded her second career double-double by scoring 10 points and recording a career-high 11 rebounds against Manhattan while adding four assists, two blocks and two steals.

In her first effort, McFarland led Colorado and established career-highs with 23 points and eight rebounds in CU's five-point loss at Wyoming on Dec. 1. She hit 8-of-14 from the field (.571) and 7-of-8 from the line (.875) against the Cowgirls. She then registered her first career double-double with 19 points and a new career-best 10 rebounds against Creighton on Dec. 4. She hit 9-of-10 from the free-throw stripe and added two blocks, one steal and one assist. For the week McFarland averaged 21.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 1.0 bpg.

Richards averaged 13.5 points, three rebounds and 1.5 blocks in her first two collegiate games. The Graham, Texas, native scored 13 points and pulled down six rebounds in her first game, a Colorado win over Loyola Marymount. She was the first Buff freshman to start the season opener since Linda Lappe in 1998. Richards hit 7-of-10 from the floor for 14 points in CU's loss to Nevada.

FRESHMAN LEADERS IN THE BIG 12...Colorado's duo of **Kara Richards** and **Jackie McFarland** are featured prominently in the Big 12's freshman statistics. Richards is third in scoring (9.3 ppg) and McFarland is fourth (9.2 ppg) among all league freshman. McFarland is second in rebounding (6.3 rpg) while Richards is just behind in third (5.4 rpg). Richards is also second in field-goal percentage at .468 (minimum of 50 attempts) and fifth in blocks (1.00 bpg) and fifth in assists (1.48 apg). McFarland is third in field-goal percentage (.466), sixth in blocked shots (0.85) and 10th in assists (1.15 apg). Reserve guard **Yari Escalera** is fourth in assists (1.81 apg), sixth in steals (1.0 spg) and 10th in 3-point field-goal percentage (.290).

SOME STREAKS ENDING...Prior to the loss against Creighton, Colorado had won 10 straight games at home following a road loss. The three-game losing streak is also the program's first since the 2001-02 season (78-67 at No. 3 Oklahoma on Jan. 2, 70-68 vs. No. 21 Texas on Jan. 6. and 75-72 at No. 14 Kansas State on Jan. 9) and the losses to Wyoming and Creighton were CU's first back-to-back setbacks against unranked teams since the 2000-01 season (72-70 vs. CSU on Dec. 6 and 92-66 at Iowa on Dec. 10).

A BARRY GOOD MILESTONE...By coaching the Buffaloes against Loyola Marymount in the season opener, head coach **Ceal Barry** passed legendary track & field coach Frank Potts for the most events coaches in school history at 642. She already holds the CU record for wins in any sport (420) and has coached in more games (659) than any coach in school history.

HOWARD LEAVES THE BUFFALOES...Leslie Howard, a 5-10 sophomore forward from Salem, Mo., has left the CU basketball program for personal reasons. Howard played

in the first four games of the season averaging 6.3 points and 3.5 rebounds per game including a career-high 14 points against Pennsylvania on Nov. 26. She played 24 games in a Colorado uniform averaging three points and just over one rebound per contest.

FOR OPENERS...Colorado improved to 26-5 all-time in season openers and has won 17 of its last 18. The Buffs are 19-3 under Ceal Barry in season-opening games and have won the last five. This season marked the first time since the 1999-2000 season the Buffs didn't open the season in Boulder (at Denver) and the first time since 1996-97 (at BYU) the Buffs didn't begin the season in the state of Colorado.

SECOND AT COORS...Colorado placed second at the 18th annual Coors Classic, Nov. 26-27, at the Coors Events Center. The Buffaloes took care of business with a 69-49 win over Pennsylvania in the first round, but fell to then No 2 ranked, and now top-ranked, LSU 75-44. Freshman **Kara Richards** was awarded All-Tournament team honors after achieving career-highs with 11 rebounds and six assists against Penn and 10 rebounds, three steals and two blocks against the Tigers. Leslie Howard scored a career-high 14 points against Penn while **Anna Nedovic** and **Whitney Law** each had 10. LSU held Colorado to a school record low 24 percent shooting in the championship game. Preseason Player of the Year candidate Seimone Augustus took home tournament MVP honors.

PRESEASON TOURNAMENTS...Colorado is 86-31 all-time in preseason tournaments, including a solid 30-6 mark in the Coors Classic. The Buffaloes have won 23 of their last 29 preseason tournament games and went 5-1 last season winning the WBCA Classic and Coors Classic Tournament championships.

LIGHTS, CAMERA, BUFFS...The Colorado Athletic Department and Fox Sports Rocky Mountain have agreed to televise seven Buffs' women's basketball games this season. Add that to the three national Fox Sports Network games scheduled through a combination of Big 12 and Pac 10 Conference pacts, CU women's basketball is scheduled for a school-record 10 regular season television games this winter.

TOUGH SCHEDULE...Colorado's schedule is once again a tough one, with the Buffs facing nine teams that played in the 2004 NCAA tournament. The Big 12 offers one of the toughest schedules in the nation, as seven members played in the NCAA's a season ago, with Texas and Baylor making the Sweet 16. Colorado's Coors Classic alone featured three teams who played in the NCAA Tournament last season, Penn, LSU and Maryland.

HEAD COACH CEAL BARRY...Ceal Barry is in her 22nd season at Colorado, and 26th overall has a collegiate head coach. Barry's overall coaching record is 509-278 with the win total ranking 20th among active NCAA Division I coaches. At Colorado Barry has led the Buffaloes to a 426-236 record, including 13 20-win seasons and 12 trips to the NCAA Tournament.

As a head coach Barry is 27-22 against Kansas.

BUFFS PICKED SEVENTH, SIXTH IN BIG 12 POLLS...Colorado was picked to finish seventh in the annual Big 12 Coaches Preseason poll while the media said the Buffaloes would finish sixth in their preseason poll. Texas was the overwhelming favorite in both polls. The Longhorns received 11 of 12 first place votes in the coaches poll (coaches aren't allowed to vote for their own teams) and 12 of 14 first place votes in the media poll. Colorado was picked fifth in both the 2003-04 and 2002-03 preseason polls only to achieve a higher standing by the end of the season. CU enjoyed a third-place finish last season and a fourth-place showing in 2002-03. The Buffs have not finished lower than fourth in the Big 12 standings since the 1999-2000 season.

NATIONAL POLLS...Six of CU's 2004-05 opponents are in the current top 20. LSU is in the top spot in both the AP and coaches polls while Baylor is ranked seventh in the AP poll and eighth by the coaches. In the coaches poll Texas Tech is 12th, Iowa State is 14th, Kansas State is 16th and Texas is 17th. In the AP poll, Texas Tech is 13th, Iowa State is 14th, Kansas State is 16th and Texas is 17th.

HOME SWEET HOME...The Buffs are 321-97 (.768) at home all-time, with an even more impressive record at the Coors Events/Conference Center, turning in a record of 288-76 (.791). Under head coach Ceal Barry the Buffs are 236-75 (.759) at the CECC. CU has turned in six undefeated seasons at home in 28 seasons, including three consecutive years from 1980-83. Most recently the Buffs were perfect at home in 1993-94 when they went 13-0 at the CECC, 27-5 overall. Colorado owns the seventh-longest home winning streak in NCAA history, going for 53-straight during the early 80s.

THE BUFFALO STAMPEDE...Coach Ceal Barry's television show airs on Fox Sports Rocky Mountain on Friday evenings at 7:30 p.m. The show incorporates all of CU's athletic department and is filmed on location in and around Boulder and is produced by BuffVision, the partnership that brings us the fantastic video boards at Folsom Field.

UP NEXT...Colorado will return home to host the University of Oklahoma on Wednesday, Feb. 16, at 7 p.m. in the Coors Events Conference Center. The game will air live on Fox Sports Net Rocky Mountain.
