## **Colorado Head Coach Dan Hawkins**

## On If He Planned on Playing Tyler Hansen as Much as He Did

"Yeah, we wanted Cody [Hawkins] to kind of start off the game and get going. Let Tyler take a look at what was going on, be able to talk to him a little bit and kind of confirm what we were seeing, versus what we thought, and then get it going a little bit and see how the whole thing went."

### On Hansen Not Knowing All of the Offensive Sets

"That's a lot of it. I thought [Offensive Coordinator] Mark [Helfrich] did a good job of just simplifying things a little bit for Tyler, so that he could use his legs. Obviously, you have to have some throws in there. He knows it all, he's a very smart kid, but we wanted to make sure that we did things that he was going to have some success at. We didn't want to overload him too much, even though he knew most of it. Some of the things that we had Cody doing, or Cody had a little more command on, because of his expertise and his experience; we let him run those plays. There was a little bit of a flow, there was a little bit of a time where we let Tyler do some of the plays that Cody had, and some of the plays Cody did that were Tyler's."

## On His Decision to Take off Tyler Hansen's Redshirt Now

"Maybe it was because of his legs, you know he can really run. It was a huge sacrifice for him, but I think it also speaks to the kind of camaraderie we have on our team. We've been messing around with **Eugene** [Goree] playing offensive line, and he's had to make that switch. Obviously for Matt [Ballenger] to take a step back a little bit, versus him stepping forward, and even Cody had to give a few things up. I'm just really pleased with our program and our guys, because I think they're really getting what this whole thing is about. I think that's the biggest lesson for them. It's not something that you want to do necessarily, but we talked to Tyler, it's not something we would have made him do. We just said, 'How do you feel about it?' And he didn't hesitate an instant; I mean he was on it."

#### On When He Decided to Use Tyler Hansen

"Before we started going on Tuesday. I think we just looked at where we were on offense, and what it is we wanted to do and what we thought we could do. We felt like his athleticism at quarterback was going to give us another dimension, and it did."

#### On the Current State of the Quarterback Position

"The best thing about it is, again, I think we've got a number of kids that are just more concerned about the team and winning, than they are about themselves. I gave **Nick Nelson** a big hug in there; down the road, I say that all kids get their just-do in the end, you can't buy respect, you can't buy those things. I think for all of those guys to just say, 'I'm here, I'll do what you want me to do, however you want me to do it. I'll play, not play, I'll signal.' Matt [Ballenger] went over and ran scout team [this week]. He's a big guy and he's the closest thing we had to Josh Freeman. Again, that was a huge sacrifice for him to go over there and do that. Our coaches do

a great job of just loving each guy up and making them feel important. Like I told Nick and Matt, that's a lot of humble pie; but they've all eaten it and eat it again, and the man that can deal with it is going to come up aces in the end."

On If He is Concerned about Colorado's Passing Game "Are you concerned about the stock market?"

#### On Keeping Tyler Hansen a Secret

"I don't think they prepared for it; which, by the way, I have got to give the local media mad props. For being out there and watching it everyday and not saying anything, that's huge right there. I know a lot of coaches bust on the media and I appreciate you guys doing that. I know we talked a long time ago, when you guys wanted the gates to be open, so you could come in there and watch practice and I said, 'Hey, if I can trust you, you can trust me.' That was big, that scored a lot of points with me; because I said, 'Let's see how far this thing goes, because one of those guys just may not be able to stand it and throw it out there.' That's huge props to all of you who watch practice everyday. [Kansas State] plays teams that run zone read, and run the quarterback around and do that; but they're obviously not practicing that, and they have to adjust some of their schemes, in terms of what they do. I think it did help us, it did."

## On Keeping Hansen in the Game After he Threw an Interception

"It's one of those things again, people always think the quarterback has got my last name and I don't look at it quite as harshly. But at the same time, I say, 'Hey, the kid is playing pretty good.' I didn't hold it against [Tyler Hansen]. It is hard to tell a quarterback to never throw an interception. That is a hard concept."

#### On Not Kicking a Field Goal at the end of the Game

"At that point right there, one, I had confidence in the offense, which that didn't happen and I just felt like hey, we had one blocked and we had one missed so we're probably better off, just for the psyche of the whole team to say, hey, lets put it on the line and go. That's not to discount **Aric** [**Goodman**] by any means. I just said hey, I thought we had a good play but unfortunately we didn't get it but we wanted to get a first down and ended on offense right there."

## On What Can be Done to Improve the Passing Game

"We just have to keep working, we have to be creative. A little smoke, a little mirrors, move people around a little bit and use the weapons that we have and keep battling and scratching to try and move the football. It's been well documented that we've been dinged and we have to be creative and work our way around it. I think our guys are doing an awesome job with that."

## On Using Cody Hawkins at QB on Final Offensive Drive

"It kind of started out with Cody. I think we felt a little bit better with him out there just in terms of what we may have to do or see or change things. It just is easily could have been Tyler [Hansen] but we left Cody out there."

## Colorado Head Coach Dan Hawkins Continued

## On Going Through Tough Stretch of Losing

"I said before I knew we were going to go through a tough stretch and we have. I kind of told our guys the other day that horrible, awful, despicable Florida State team that we should have never lost to has lost one game so far. That Texas team, they're doing alright too."

#### On If He Has Ever Taken a Redshirt Off a Quarterback

"I don't know necessarily that I've ever done it with a quarterback. We have done it with other players before. When I was at Boise State we had a defensive back and we were getting ready to play Hawaii and had a bunch of guys dinged up and you need defensive backs against those guys. We said, 'Hey, its up to you, we're good either way.' It is a huge sacrifice and we're fortunate to have a guy with Tyler's physical abilities and his intangibles of being able to sacrifice for the team."

#### On the Fumble Caused by Cha'pelle Brown

"That was huge, that was big. Again, it's just one of those things that has happened for us a little bit through the stretch is we haven't really had a bunch of momentum changers and igniters, but our defense stepped up and made the plays they had to make and that was big right there. It's a one-point game so anything can matter, but I think more than anything else it just shined a little bit of a light on us and gave our guys a little bit of juice to kind of go alright, lets go. That was the other thing too; when we went for it on fourth down I thought it was awesome, because I really love the chemistry of the guys. All of the defensive guys were saying, 'Do it again, we've got your back. We'll stop them, whatever you want to do; kick it, go for it, whatever you want to do and we'll stop them.'

#### On Colorado's Defensive Steam

"I thought **Ron Collins** and **Greg Brown** did a good job of mixing it up. I think they had a little bit of a problem because our guys did a good job of disguising some things and bringing some things that we haven't shown necessarily before. As it kind of got down to crunch time at the end we went with our base package and tried to keep everything in front of us. I thought there were enough nice change ups to throw them off guard a little bit."

## On Running a Two-Quarterback System

"I hate it. But it is what it is. I didn't like the fact that I was so slow and short and not very athletic either but I had to deal with that. Again, the awesome thing is that these guys are great with it and they're supportive of each other. We'll deal with it as it goes. I think in all honesty if you don't have two guys that can put their ego aside and have enough faith in their coach and their team then you have problems. Both of these guys are studs about that and they've been very supportive of each other, rallying around each other, helping each other out. That's why we end up winning.

## On Playing 22 Freshman So Far This Season

"As you just kind of go along each guy sometimes learns and grows and moves. I'm looking at these guys and loving where they're at and I think they're having a lot of success and playing pretty well against a tough schedule as they continue to grow and get better and our staff can continue to put more wrinkles in the game plan and have more buttons to push on the space shuttle, you've got something really good."

## Kansas State Head Coach Ron Prince

#### General

"That was a great football game. We've been trying to put ourselves in a position here for three years to be able to have a close ball game like that, with the ball, to have a two-minute drive to go win it, and we didn't get it done. We came up short."

"Credit Colorado on both sides of the ball and the kicking game."

"They did a good job of keeping our returns down. We'll look back and have plenty of what-ifs, plenty of second-guessing to do, I didn't obviously do a good enough job with our offense this week".

"We were there, close to make a play and we didn't make it. I don't want to take anything away from Colorado great effort, they ran the ball, tried to keep the game short."

### On Play of Defense

"I was very pleased with our defensive effort, particularly in the second half. That's one of those games where the head coach ought to be able to get us some scores there at the end, and I was unable to do that."

"I thought our defense, by and large, tried to play a very sound game. We'll look back at this one and say, 'What it? and woulda, coulda, shoulda. But the reality is we didn't."

## On too Many Third and Longs Given up Defensively

"I don't look at it that way. Yeah, we'd like to stop all the third downs. The one third down at the end, the third-and-15, that was a real big play on their part. We were in maybe the only coverage the particular route could've hurt us in and it did."

## On Play of Colorado Freshman Quarterback Tyler Hansen

"I had a pretty good sense that they would run the ball by whatever means they could. I had a sense they'd use all three runners, I had a sense that they could use a couple of different quarterbacks."

"His game in particular I wasn't familiar with. But the idea of the quarterback running with the ball from that position, a lot of people are doing it these days and he was definitely a factor and able to convert. That was very positive for him."

## **Colorado Players**

## **LB Brad Jones**

ON WINNING —"it feels pretty good. We lost three games in a row and it just feels so good to get back to our winning ways."

ON PRE-GAME SPEECH-"We were at a fork in the road. We lost three games and two of them we probably shouldn't have lost. This game was a pivotal point in our season, where it could go either way and it seemed like this win was the culmination of all the hard work we have put in."

ON QB JOSH FREEMAN-"He is better in the sense that he cannot take a sack. I had him three or four times that I thought were sacks and he will just throw it to the feet of his receiver and make sure its not intentional grounding. He is just really good at avoiding sacks. He is a big dude. The quarterback is never bigger than me."

ON THE OFFENSE-"The offense did such a great job. I don't know what to say. We were so impressed with the play of the offense, as a defense. We were amazed. They knew we were doing good and they were taking it to their defense. I was just so excited for my offense to be playing this well."

## FS Ryan Walters

ON WIN – "We were fortunate to come out and play tough all game. Their offense had a great quarterback and some good receivers. I'm proud of the way we played and I'm proud of our team effort."

ON PLAY OF SECONDARY-"We didn't want to give them time to sit back and pick us apart, which they are capable of doing. He's got a great arm. We were trying to not let him think and get rid of the ball quickly."

ON OFFENSE-"I'm proud of our offense. They kept the ball in their hands and did a great job of getting first downs to get the time off the clock. Tyler Hansen did a great job and Cody [Hawkins] did a great job as well."

ON DEFENSE-"We did a great job up front of getting them in second and long and third and long situations."

## CB Cha'pelle Brown

ON THE DEFENSE-"It was big. Me and Ryan [Walters] talked about it all week. We said if we had to hold them to zero that is what we were going to do. We didn't do that but the offense helped us out today so we got the job done."

ON QB JOSH FREEMAN-"He likes to pass more than run but if he has to run he will. I saw a couple plays where it took three guys to get him down. We prepared the same way though. We had to prepare for him passing the ball."

ON MENTAL STATE OF TEAM-"I feel good about the team. The coaches were never down on us, they just made sure we got back up. We have another week and another tough game ahead of us. One game at a time, so we're getting ready for Missouri."

## **CB Gardner McKay**

ON SPECIAL TEAMS PLAY – "Every play on the field, it is like defense for me. So special teams is like defense to me."

ON TEAM EFFORT-"You have to give it to both of us, offense and defense. We just went out there and wanted this win. I think the key thing was to finish this game."

ON QB JOSH FREEMAN-"He's really good. We tried to do our best to shut him down but obviously he is a good quarterback."

## **WR Josh Smith**

ON WIN –"Yes it feels good. This team is very capable of going out there and getting a win. Good things happen when this team plays together. That is what we did and that is how we showed up today. We had a big win over Kansas State, who was a tough opponent. I'm glad we rallied and got together and did what it takes to get that end result."

ON CATCH ON THIRD-AND-15-"I got my reps cut down because of the injuries. I knew as long as I was on the sidelines I would continue to stay ready. Just because I'm not in there every play doesn't mean I'm not ready to go. I know when those guys see me come out on the field they put their best food forward so I knew on the third-and-fifteen the team was counting on me. I make every play for the team."

ON PHYSICAL CONDITION-"I'm fine. After that win I'm feeling real good. I'm not feeling one injury right now. When we get those end results like that I feel good. But I'll let you know in the morning."

ON SPEICAL TEAMS PLAY-"I love the extra attention. I like the people behind me knowing I can make big plays on special teams. That's what I wanted to bring to the table when I took the role. I want to make guys kick the ball away from me. I want them to be scared to kick it to me because they know that I'm a threat. It takes a lot of courage to be out there and take on those tasks."

## WR Scotty McKnight

ON THE GAME —"I thought it was going to be a more high scoring game but the defense really stepped up and held them. We had some opportunities out there that we missed and the defense really bailed us out. They played great and saved us. Obviously it feels great to get a win after a few weeks of not getting one."

ON USING TWO QUARTERBACKS-"We knew this week that we might use Tyler [Hansen] in the game. We've seen it all year, he is an excellent player. He is very mature for his age and has a great arm. Not to discount Cody [Hawkins] at all because he is an incredible leader on this football team and we need him just as much. I'm glad they established both of them tonight and it went fairly smoothly for our first time. They were both able to make some plays to help us win tonight. We look forward to figuring this out and getting the job done."

ON TOUCHDOWN CATCH—"Oh man, that thing was pretty. Its like he wrapped it up and threw it in the air for me like it was Christmas time. I got out of my break and was like 'Oh my God this thing is nice.' There was no challenge in catching that ball it just fell into my gloves."

## **Colorado Players**

## **DL/OL Eugene Goree**

ON TRANSITION TO OFFENSIVE LINE-"It's going good. It's pretty much the same fundamentals. Set in and push in the front. I am still learning how to read defenses. I just play my position the best I can."

ON TYLER HANSEN-"It was real smooth. We put him in there and he made plays. And it went well after that. "

## **DT George Hypolite**

ON DEFENSE-"I think we played really well. We gave up one big play. It was a combination of a miscommunication and just getting put in a bad situation, and they hit us for a touchdown. But outside of that, I think we played very well."

ON JOSH FREEMAN-"He (causes) a lot of problems because he is a big guy and he has a really electric arm. He is not necessarily elusive; he is just very hard to bring down. So he makes a lot of plays, not necessarily with his feet, but he is able to stay in the pocket, take hits, bounce off, and still throw the ball pretty accurately. He did a lot out there today. He had a few big scrambles and he made a few big plays with his arms. As long as you can still contain a guy like that and make tackles, you did a good job."

ON GETTING STOPS-"We figured our offense gave us 14 points, they only had 13 and it was the fourth quarter, and we had to step up and make a big play. If they can't score, they can't win. As a defense collectively we did a great job of everyone trusting each other and doing their job."

ON GOING INTO THE 4<sup>TH</sup> QUARTER-"I really don't think we had to say anything. We have gotten to the point as players where we know how it's supposed to qo."

## **QB** Tyler Hansen

ON SETTLING DOWN-"I knew I was going to play a little bit so I kind of prepared my mind for the game and just stayed calm and tried to do the best possible. On the second series, it started to slow down and I was starting to make plays. I was kind of stressing out after the fumble on the first play. I thought I was not going to play the rest of the game."

ON SORENESS-"My legs kind of hurt right now, but I will be alright. Just going to go in the cold tub and take care of my body a little bit."

ON GIVING UP REDSHIRT-"On Sunday, after the Kansas game, Coach Helfrich brought me in and asked me if I would be up for it. He said I could really help the team out. After that, I said absolutely. I miss playing. I miss being out there in the lights. I want to compete. It was a lot of fun."

ON CATCHING KANSAS STATE OFF-GUARD-"They obviously weren't expecting all that running, but they adjusted pretty well after that. I heard a couple guys talking like 'who is this guy.' They were trying to get into my head because they knew I am a freshman."

ON SPLITTING SNAPS WITH CODY HAWKINS-"I like it, it's fun. It mixes it up a little bit. You can see who is going in and who

is going out. They have to put in new personnel. It helps a lot."

## **QB Cody Hawkins**

ON QB SITUATION-"I don't know, I was just so excited for him to get out there. Tyler [Hansen] is one of my good friends. You come to Colorado not necessarily for the individual success, but when you are putting on the line against such great teams, I want to win football games. Going out and working hard and doing as much as I can for the program is my job. That is how I am going to make my living every day, by working hard and trying to be a leader. Whether that means I am on the field or not, I just have to help the team win any way I can."

ON DAD'S PHILOSOPHY-"A lot of it has to do with the type of guys we are recruiting and the type of program we have. No one really tries to stand out as an individual. I think the biggest thing for us is that everyone in this program puts the program first in every way. We all have a lot of respect for Tyler as a person. You guys might be shocked at what he did tonight, but he does that every day at practice. We knew Tyler would be given the opportunity to help our football team. He laid it on the line for us. I know it was a tough decision, but he did it. He is a great player who is helping our team. Everyone on our team owes him a big pat on the back."

ON STRUGGLING PASSING ATTACK-"I think a lot of it has to do with situations. The way the we have been running the ball it would kind of be foolish to throw it, because there is no point in putting it in the air when Rodney [Stewart] is making plays and our offensive line is performing as well as it can. I think with the guys we have and the running back we can move the ball whenever we want. And we can throw the ball when we need to."

ON SPLITTING SNAPS WITH TYLER HANSEN-"I think Coach Helfrich does an awesome job of preparing us. He makes sure all of us know the game plan well going into the game. Regardless of who the guy is, you need to know every single aspect of the offense and the game plan. Although you might not get all the reps in practice you have to know that stuff. On Tyler Hansen's first touchdown pass, he has never run that play; that was always one of my plays. We got into a situation on the field that, Tyler did an awesome some of running a play he has never run before. It's a testament to how hard he is working and visualizing stuff. He threw a dime of a touchdown pass. We know he can go out there and do it on a constant basis. He is not only a running quarterback he has the whole package. It just turns out he can make a lot of plays with his feet. The guy is going to have an awesome future. I am always going to be a team guy."

## **TB Rodney Stewart**

ON FIRST TOUCHDOWN-"It was unbelievable. It wasn't what I thought it would be. Because I have played so many games, probably if I had scored in one of the first games it would have been more exciting."

## **Kansas State Players**

## QB Josh Freeman

ON THE LAST PLAY- "If I had got out to the right, I might have been able to get it to the end zone for my receiver to make a play"

ON COLORADO—"They were bringing pressure at key moments. They were rolling coverage and blitzing well. They played well. They're not a bad football team. They have good players; I just think they're struggling to find an identity."

GENERAL- "We knew it would be a dogfight, we just couldn't pull out a win. The game played out a lot like Coach Prince told us it would. We know who we are; we just wish we could get some plays back. We just have to come back and learn."

## **DE Ian Campbell**

GENERAL— "A loss always hurts. We showed improvement on defense but also a lot of things we need to fix. Part of us getting better is getting used to each other and getting more confident with each other. We definitely had no quit at all."

ON COLORADO OB TYLER HANSEN- "In this game, in this day and age, you need to be ready for anything. He was a decent runner and able to play the quarterback read game. He did a good job."

## **RB Logan Dold**

ON THE DEFENSIVE STRUGGLE—"We knew it was going to be a tough game in tough environment. Our defense played good, but Colorado's defense played great. They held us to 13 points, which is a lot lower than we are used to."

ON THE OFFENSE—"Our running game showed a little tonight. Colorado just did a great job of stopping it. What it came down to is that our offense wasn't able to execute like we're used to."

ON HANGING TOUGH— "We knew the whole game that we were right there with them. We knew that a play or two could have changed the game. We never gave up."

ON HIS ROLE ON THE TEAM—"We're all here to win. I'm just going to do my part."

## **DB Joshua Moore**

ON THE DEFENSE— "The defense just has to perform a little better. We only gave up 14 points but that wasn't good enough. I feel disappointed because we didn't win.

If we had won, it might be a little different. The defense can build off of this game."

ON HIS INTERCEPTION—"When I saw the post-corner, I just undercut the route."

## **DB Tysyn Hartman**

GENERAL—"We wanted to string two wins together, and we didn't."

ON THE DEFENSE—"The defense played good today but not great. It was definitely an improvement [from previous weeks] but it wasn't enough."

ON TEAMMATE JOSHUA MOORE—"Josh has had a great couple of games. It's good to have him give us a spark"

ON OKLAHOMA—"I don't know much about Oklahoma, except that it's a Big 12 game and we need it."

## K Brooks Rossman

GENERAL—"We try to make field goals at the beginning of the game so it doesn't come down to having to make them at the end."

## **WR Brandon Banks**

GENERAL- "It was a hard-fought game. That was a good football team. Unfortunately we couldn't make enough plays to win. I love to play in games like that but tonight wasn't our night."

ON WHO IS TO BLAME FOR THE LOSS- "Everyone had miscues out there tonight. We miscue as a team and we lost as a team."

ON COLORADO'S DEFENSE—"They had a good scheme as a defense and executed very well."

## LB Ulla Pomele

ON COLORADO QB TYLER HANSEN- "He was good, very athletic. You definitely have to be prepared for something like that. We were able to adjust and in the second-half did a lot better at being able to read our keys."

## LB John Houlik

GENERAL – "It was a huge loss. We really wanted to come out here and get a win. We haven't had consecutive road wins since 2003. We didn't quit, we kept playing until the end. Every Big 12 game is tough so we need to look at film and get better."

**QUICKLY** Colorado opened in its nickel defensive package for the sixth straight game ... K-State was the fourth opponent in seven games to score on its opening drive against the Buffs (EWU, FSU and Texas all scored TDs); CU committed a turnover on its first possession for the second time this year (INT at FSU) ... The Wildcats were the nation's 13th ranked team in third down conversions (49.3%) coming into the game and opened 3-of-4; KSU then missed its next 11 attempts and finished the game 3of-15 ... CU had two turnovers tonight, 14 on the season (two in every game); 12 have occurred in the first half, and nine in the second quarter, which means just two after halftime ... This is the first time that CU has won two games in a season scoring less than 20 points (with the WVU 17-14 overtime win) since 1998, when the Buffs beat Baylor (18-16) and Texas Tech (19-17); all four of the aforementioned were in Boulder ... The 14 points were the fewest CU scored in winning a game since Oct. 8, 1992, when the Buffs won 6-0 at Missouri ... Dan Hawkins is now 2-19 when his teams have not scored 20 points (I-A/FBS), both wins this season ... CU's 23-14 record against North teams continues to be the division's best since 2001 ... The Buffs snapped a 7-game losing streak to it's 1-70 compadres, Kansas, K-State and Missouri.

**242 & COUNTING** CU extended its school-record consecutive games scoring streak to **242** games, extending it in by halftime 219 times. This is now the third longest active streak in the nation, trailing Michigan (295) and Florida (249); Washington State's streak of 280 ended today with a 69-0 home loss to USC. CU's streak is also the ninth longest of all-time (UCLA owns the eighth, 245 games, between 1971 and 1992); the Buffs were last shutout nearly 20 years ago, 7-0 at Nebraska on Nov. 12, 1988.

FIRST CAREER ACTION QB Tyler Hansen saw his first career action tonight, getting in from scrimmage on CU's last series of the first quarter; it was in the game plan to get him 10-15 snaps, see what he could do and take it from there. OG Eugene Goree, who started practicing at guard for the first time on Oct. 8, saw his first career action on offense (he remains listed at both DT & OG).

**OB TYLER HANSEN (14-7-1, 71, 1 TD PASS; 19-86, RUSH)** He was just the 10th true freshman quarterback to take snaps in a game for the Buffs since 1973. His 86 yards rushing were the most by a CU QB in a game since Bernard Jackson had 105 against Kansas State in 2006.

—He is not the first true freshman quarterback to see action after the season opener; in 2000, **Craig Ochs** saw action in game four, also versus Kansas State. In 1992, **Koy Detrmer** appeared in the second half at Minnesota in game three and rallied the Buffs to a 21-20 victory. In 1986, Bill McCartney opened up the competition at quarterback after the fifth game of the year, as true frosh **Marc Walters** 

appeared for the first time in game seven (Nebraska), and started the season finale at Kansas State when CU needed the win to secure a Bluebonnet Bowl bid (in that game, Walters set the CU record for single game passing efficiency for any amount of attempts—353.3, completing 4-of-6 passes for 150 yards with 2 TDs and an interception). Now in 2003, true frosh **QB Joel Klatt** saw some mop-up duty in game seven at Baylor (went 0-for-3), and then saw action in two other games as the upback on the punt unit.

**OB BREAKDOWN** Here is the breakdown of tonight's snaps by each CU quarterback:

Hawkins (6-of-11, 35 yards) moved into fourth place in all-time career completions with 353, passing Koy Detmer (350).

**RUNNING GAME (57-247, 1 TD)** Colorado had season highs in rushing attempts (57) and yards (247); the 57 tries were the most since 63 against Miami-Ohio last year, and the most in league play since 66 at Missouri in a 42-35 overtime win in 2002. It was the most yards since 277 against Nebraska last November.

\*\*P \*\*TB RODNEY STEWART (29-141, 1 TD)\*\* With his third 100-yard rushing game, he tied Lamont Warren for the most 100-yard games by a freshman, true or redshirt, in CU history with three (Warren had three as a true frosh in '91). It was the 21st 100-yard game by any freshman in school annals, and Stewart also scored his first career touchdown on his 4-yard run in the second quarter. He earned eight first downs in the game.

considering its gained 51 on the three 17-yard plays on its opening second half possession, the Wildcats had just 38 yards on its other 20 plays in plus territory, or 1.9 per. Kansas State had just six three-and-outs coming into the game all season, but had three in a row in the second quarter and six in the game; KSU also had scored in all but one quarter this season and were shutout twice tonight; the Wildcats had come in averaging 43.3 points per game, eighth in the NCAA, but that number dropped to 39.0.

K-State was the fourth opponent in seven games to score on its opening drive against the Buffs (EWU, FSU and Texas all scored TDs); CU committed a turnover on its first possession for the second time this year (INT at FSU) ... Kansas State had just six three-and-outs coming into the game all season, but had three in a row in the second quarter ... **TB Rodney Stewart** scored his first career touchdown on his 4-yard run in the second quarter ...

**242 & COUNTING** CU extended its school-record consecutive games scoring streak to **242** games, extending it in by halftime 219 times. This is now the third longest active streak in the nation, trailing Michigan (295) and Florida (249); Washington State's streak of 280 ended today with a 69-0 home loss to USC. CU's streak is also the ninth longest of all-time; the Buffs were last shutout nearly 20 years ago, 7-0 at Nebraska on Nov. 12, 1988.

FIRST CAREER ACTION QB Tyler Hansen saw his first career action tonight, getting in from scrimmage on CU's last series of the first quarter; it was in the game plan to get him 10-15 snaps, see what he could do and take it from there. OG Eugene Goree, who started practicing at guard for the first time on Oct. 8, saw his first career action on offense (he remains listed at both DT & OG).

**OB TYLER HANSEN** He is just the 10th true freshman quarterback to take snaps in a game for the Buffs since 1973.

—He is not the first true freshman quarterback to see action after the season opener; in 2000, **Craig Ochs** saw action in game four, also versus Kansas State. In 1992, **Koy Detrmer** appeared in the second half at Minnesota in game threeand rallied the Buffs to a 21-20 victory. In 1986, Bill McCartney opened up the competition at quarterback after the fifth game of the year, as true frosh **Marc Walters** appeared for the first time in game seven (Nebraska), and started the season finale at Kansas State when CU needed the win to secure a Bluebonnet Bowl bid (in that game, Walters set the

CU record for single game passing efficiency for any amount of attempts—353.3, completing 4-of-6 passes for 150 yards with 2 TDs and an interception). Now in 2003, true frosh **QB Joel Klatt** saw some mop-up duty in game seven at Baylor (went 0-for-3), and then saw action in two other games as the upback on the punt unit.

## POSTGAME NOTES

- Saturday night's loss to Colorado dropped the Wildcats to 19-44-1 against the Buffaloes all time, including a 5-27 mark on the road... However, the Wildcats are still 7-6 against the Buffs since the inception of the Big 12 Conference (1996)... K-State is now 26-24 (.520) in Big 12 road games since the inception of the conference, while the Wildcats are 61-38 (.616) all-time in Big 12 games.
- The Wildcats marched 61 yards in 11 plays on their first drive of the game... The scoring drive capped off by a Brooks Rossman 37-yard field goal was the first time this season K-State tallied a field goal on its game-opening drive... The Wildcats have now scored on their first possession of the game five times this season.
- Kansas State blocked a 48-yard field goal attempt by Colorado's Aric Goodman in the second quarter... Ian Campbell blocked the kick, while Ray Cheatham recovered... It was the Wildcats' nation-leading seventh blocked kick of the season, one shy from tying the school record of eight in 2003... It was also Wildcats' first blocked field goal since Oct. 9, 2005, against Kansas (Derek Marso)... The Wildcats have now blocked 48 kicks in the Big 12 era (1996) and have 32 blocked kicks since 2002, which is tied for third in the nation.
- The Wildcats recovered their fourth fumble of the year as Ulla Pomele forced a Rodney Stewart fumble in the first quarter, which was recovered by Joshua Moore at the K-State 28-yard line... Kansas State recorded another turnover in the first half as Moore intercepted a Tyler Hansen pass with 3:12 left in the second quarter... It was Moore's first interception of the season and the second of his career.
- The Kansas State defense held Colorado to just 14 points Saturday night... It was the lowest point total given up in a conference game since Baylor scored 14 points on Oct. 27, 2007... Furthermore, the 353 yards surrended by the K-State defense was the fewest since giving up 348 yards to lowa State on Nov. 3, 2007.
- Quarterback Josh Freeman started his 27th career contest on Saturday... The junior quarterback finished the evening 20-of-41 with 237 yards and zero interceptions... Freeman has now gone 143 pass attempts without an interception... The last time Freeman threw an interception was at Louisville, which broke a 144-attempt streak without a pick to begin the season... Freeman remains tied for second with Michael Bishop (1997-98; 36) on the K-State career passing touchdown list with 36 career passing touchdowns... Freeman needs one touchdown pass to tie Ell Roberson (2000-03; 37) for the K-State career record.
- Josh Freeman also tallied seven carries for 42 yards and one touchdown, including a 17-yard run for a score in the third quarter... Freeman has now rushed for at least one touchdown in six of the Wildcats' seven games this season... Freeman now has 13 rushing touchdowns this season, while his career rushing TD total now stands at 19... Freeman has 25 total touchdown this season, eclipsing his mark of 22 all of last season.
- Senior place kicker Brooks Rossman hit 2-of-4 field goals this evening, including a long of 53 yards... The 53-yarder was the longest of his career and tied for the eighth-longest in school history... Rossman's previous career high also came against Colorado, a 52-yarder on Oct. 13, 2007... After being true on 7-of-9 field goal attempts this season, Rossman dropped back to second in career percentage at 78.4 (29-of-37)... Rossman missed a 47-yard field goal later in the quarter, which broke a streak of 10-straight makes... Rossman's last miss prior to Saturday was a 45-yarder at lowa State on Nov. 3, 2007.
- Freshman defensive end Brandon Harold recorded two tackles for loss... The East St. Louis, III, native now has 10.5 tackles behind the line of scrimmage... Harold came into tonight's game third in the Big 12 and 22nd nationally in TFLs... He was also tops nationally among freshmen in tackles for loss heading into tonight's contest.
- Kansas State was successful on its fourth fake punt this season as Attrail Snipes took an end-around from up-man Tysyn Hartman 27 yards for the first down... The other three fake punts this year have been converted by Hartman.
- Saturday marked the first time that Kansas State lost by one point since losing 38-37 at Oklahoma on Sept. 29, 2001.
