### Playing in the Big Time

Four Big 12 quarterbacks made their first career starts last Saturday - Kerry Meier (Kansas), Chase Daniel (Missouri), Colt McCoy (Texas) and Graham Harrell (Texas Tech). Two other signal callers - Paul Thompson (Oklahoma) and Stephen McGee (Texas A&M) got the starting nod for just the second time. Meier and McCoy are freshman while Daniel, Harrell and McGee are sophomores.

### Oh Brother

Kansas and Kansas State both had a Meier starting at QB in the season opener. Senior Dylan was behind center for the Wildcats while little brother freshman Kerry started in his first career game for the Jayhawks. It marked the first time in Big 12 history that brothers started at quarterback simultaneously at conference schools.

### Length of Game

The average length of game in the Big 12 for Week 1 of the 2006 season was 3:07. This total includes the triple overtime game at Iowa State. The average regulation game time was 3:04 as all 12 schools played at home. By comparison, the average length of game in the Big 12 last season was 3:28.

### Big 12 BCS Success

The 2005 season marked the third straight and fifth time in the last six years that a Big 12 team played in the BCS National Championship game. Since the inception of the the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship game and leads all conferences with its five appearances. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

### Instant Replay

The Big 12 Conference will employ instant replay again this season. In an experimental year in 2005, the Big 12 used its model of replay in 78 games, with 96 plays reviewed, 33 overturned (35 percent), and a 1:33 average length of review.

### Big 12 Preseason Media Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in three of the last four seasons (UT/OU-05, OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Last year the media accurately predicted Texas to win the South and Colorado to win the North. Overall the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 11-of-20 times. Following are this season's projections.

**BAYLOR (0-1, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Northwestern State  
**Next Week:** Washington State (Seattle)

Wide receiver Trent Shelton has caught at least one pass in 34 straight games, tying Reggie Newhouse's school record.

Baylor's attendance of 42,733 was its largest for a season-opener since 1973 (46,000 vs. Oklahoma).

Daniel Sepulveda recorded his 70th 50-yard punt, extending his school record.

Paul Mosley's third quarter fumble was his first since the first half of Baylor's 2004 game against Iowa State, snapping a streak of 248 consecutive carries without a fumble.



**COLORADO (0-1, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Colorado State (Denver)  
**Next Week:** Arizona State

Mason Crosby became CU's all-time leading kick scorer in last Saturday's game. With 235 points, he is now second all-time in overall scoring, trailing only Eric Bieniemy, who scored 254 points between 1987-90. Crosby is tied for the most field goals in a CU career with 48.

The 288 yards allowed by CU were the fewest in a season-opener since 2001 (Fresno State had 287), the 11th time in the last 20 the opponent has failed to reach 300 yards.

The Buffs have scored in 211-consecutive games, the sixth-longest streak in the nation.



**IOWA STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** UNLV  
**Next Week:** at Iowa

Iowa State picked up its first overtime win in six tries with its triple-OT thriller over Toledo.

Todd Blythe's five catches give him 95 for his career and ranks him ninth in Cyclone history. His two overtime touchdown receptions give him 20 career touchdown catches, extending his school record.

Bret Meyer rushed for three touchdowns in a game for the first time in his career. He was responsible for five touchdowns (pass/run), one off the school record held by Bret Oberg who was responsible for six touchdowns against Oklahoma on Oct. 21, 1989.



**KANSAS (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** UL Monroe  
**Next Week:** Toledo (Friday)

Kansas set an all-time high with over 28,100 season tickets sold for the 2006 season. Saturday's attendance of 44,025 is the largest for a Kansas home opener since 1994 (48,100).

Head Coach Mark Mangino has signed a new five-year contract extending through Dec. 31, 2010.

Senior Jon Cornish's 69-yard touchdown run was the second longest of his career. His 140 yards rushing were a career-high and marked the fifth 100-yard rushing game of his career. Cornish also set a career-high with 156 all-purpose yards.

In the first quarter, freshman Kerry Meier threw his first career TD pass to junior Marcus Henry, who caught his first career TD.



**KANSAS STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Florida Atlantic  
**Next Week:** Marshall

Jeff Snodgrass' 52-yard field goal in the second quarter was the third 50-plus yarder in his career. His career-long is 57 yards against North Texas last season.

Ten Wildcats made their first career starts on Saturday, six on defense and four on offense.

Senior Yamon Figurs returned a punt 81 yards for a touchdown in the second quarter, his first career punt return for a TD. He also totaled 113 yards on four kickoff returns and 16 yards receiving for 218 all-purpose yards.

Sophomore defensive end Ian Campbell was named Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week for his effort in the win over Illinois State. Campbell tallied eight solo stops in the contest, including five tackles for loss, three of which were sacks.



**MISSOURI (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Mississippi  
**Next Week:** at New Mexico

Big 12 Offensive Player the Week, Chase Daniel set a Missouri record with five touchdown passes in his first career start. He was 23-of-32 for 320 yards with a pass rating of 207.44.

Junior Will Franklin caught four passes for a career-high 138 yards and a pair of touchdowns. He now has five careers TDs.

Junior running back Tony Temple rushed for a career-high 119 yards on 19 carries, marking the second 100-yard rushing game of his career (2005 vs. Baylor).

Senior linebacker Marcus Bacon recorded a team- and career-high 12 tackles, along with his first career fumble recovery.



**NEBRASKA (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Nicholls State  
**Next Week:** at USC

Saturday's attendance of 85,181 was a Memorial Stadium record. The previous record was 78,268 against Texas on Nov. 2, 2002. The crowd is also the fifth-largest ever to see Nebraska play, trailing only games at Penn State (1982, 2002) and two appearances in the Rose Bowl (1941, 2002).

Nebraska's victory extended its nation-leading season-opening win streak to 21 games, dating back to a 17-13 loss to Florida State in the 1985 season opener.

Zac Taylor's 287 passing yards are the third-most in his career and his seventh career game with more than 200 yards.



**OKLAHOMA (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Washington  
**Next Week:** at Oregon

The Sooners improved to 7-1 in season openers under head coach Bob Stoops and to 42-2 in home games under Stoops.

The 69-yard touchdown connection between Paul Thompson and Adrian Peterson in the third quarter was the longest scoring play by a Sooner since a 72-yard touchdown catch by Mark Bradley from Jason White in 2004 against Oklahoma State.

Adrian Peterson produced his 17th 100-yard rushing game on Saturday, moving him into fourth place on OU's all-time list, two shy of Joe Washington's 19.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at Arkansas State  
**Next Week:** Florida Atlantic

Perrish Cox was named Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week. Cox returned the opening kickoff 96 yards for a touchdown. He also totaled 72 yards on three punt returns, including a 41-yarder.

Twelve true freshman Cowboys made their debuts on Saturday.

Three newcomers (Perrish Cox, Adarius Bowman and Keith Toston) accounted for OSU's first three touchdowns.

Mike Hamilton's 155-yard rushing effort marked the fourth time the sophomore tailback has eclipsed the 100-yard mark in his career.



**TEXAS (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Ohio State  
**Next Week:** at Rice

The Longhorns extended their nation-leading winning streak to 21 games and their home winning streak to 16 games. The home streak marks the second-longest active streak in the nation behind only USC (27). It also ties the fourth-longest stretch in school history.

UT held North Texas to 95 total yards, the second-best defensive effort for Texas since 1990. In 2001, Texas held Kansas to 67 yards, the only other time it held an opponent to under 100 yards during that span.

Texas held North Texas to just eight rushing yards, tying the fifth best effort since 1990. The Longhorns have held seven opponents to 10-or-less rushing yards in that span.



**TEXAS A&M (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** UL Lafayette  
**Next Week:** Army (San Antonio)

Kerry Franks' 51-yard kickoff return was the longest by an Aggie since 2003 when Jason Carter had an 89-yard touchdown against Nebraska.

Courtney Lewis had his 29th and 30th rushing touchdowns of his career, moving past Saturday's honorary game captain Leeland McElroy to a tie for No. 6 on the school career rushing TD list.

The Aggies lost four fumbles, while gaining only one turnover. In the Franchione era, A&M improved to 4-18 in games with an even or minus turnover margin. A&M is 13-1 when winning the turnover battle.

Chad Schroeder's six catches for 101 yards and a touchdown set career-highs for him in catches and yardage.



**TEXAS TECH (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at UTEP  
**Next Week:** at TCU

The Red Raiders have won 10 straight at home, their longest streak since winning 11 straight between Sept. 15, 1973, and Nov. 23, 1974.

Sophomore quarterback Graham Harrell became the first underclassmen QB to earn the starting nod since Kliff Kingsbury back in 2000.

Senior Robert Johnson established a Texas Tech single-game record for receptions when he caught his 15th late in the fourth quarter. He reached the 100-yard receiving mark for the fourth time in his career.

TTU held SMU to 189 yards, 118 rushing and 71 through the air.
