NEXT UP: Eight non-conference games are on the docket this week highlighted by the debut of a new stadium and a trio of Big 12 powers taking on Pac-10 foes. The new Stanford Stadium debuts as the Cardinal takes on Navy. The Big 12 vs. Pac-10 matchups find Oklahoma at OREGON and Nebraska at USC, as well as ARIZONA STATE at Colorado. Other games feature Fresno State at WASHINGTON, Baylor at WASHINGTON STATE, with the game played at Seattle's Qwest Field, Stephen F. Austin at ARIZONA and Portland State at CALIFORNIA. INSTANT REPLAY: The Pac-10 is in year two of instant replay and this season all Division I-A conferences have agreed to utilize a uniform system of replay. Therefore, all games involving Pac-10 teams this season will have instant replay in place. One significant change from a year ago is a coaches challenge element. Each coach will be allowed to challenge the on-field ruling one time per game. The coach must have a team time out available to challenge a ruling. After review, if the call on the field is reversed, the team time out shall be restored. If the on-field ruling is not reversed, the time out counts as one of the three permitted the team that half. Following is a summary of instant replay in the Pac-10 after one week:

SERIES NOTES FOR THE GAMES OF SAT., SEP. 16:

OKLAHOMA (2-0) at OREGON (2-0) - 12:30 PDT - ABC regional telecast - **The Series:** This is a rematch of last year's Pacific Life Holiday Bowl, won 17-14 by Oklahoma. Oregon and Oklahoma have met six times with the Sooners winning all six games. With the exception of the Holiday Bowl game last season, the other five games in the series all were played at Norman, making this the Sooners' first trip to Eugene. Oklahoma is coached by Bob Stoops, brother of Arizona coach Mike Stoops. . . . **Last Year:** Oregon and Oklahoma met in the Pacific Life Holiday Bowl with the Sooners hanging on for a 17-14 victory. QB **Brady Leaf** came off the bench midway through the fourth quarter to rally the Ducks from a 17-7 deficit to 17-14 and had Oregon driving for the winning score late. However, an Oklahoma interception deep in their own territory put an end to the UO comeback and sealed the win for the Sooners.

BAYLOR (1-1) at WASHINGTON STATE (1-1) @Qwest Field, Seattle - 2:00 PDT - **The Series:** Washington State and Baylor have met just four times with the Baylor leading the series 3-1. The most recent meeting came in the 1994 Alamo Bowl, won by WSU 10-3. . . . **Last Meeting:** Washington State and Baylor met in the 1994 Alamo Bowl at San Antonio with the Cougars winning a 10-3 defensive struggle. The WSU offense marched for a touchdown on the opening drive of the game for what would prove to be enough for the victory. The Cougar defense limited a Baylor team that had been averaging nearly 33 points per game to just eight first downs and 151 yards total offense (74 rushing, 77 passing). The WSU offense could muster just seven yard rushing for the game, but QB Chad Davis passed for 286 yards and the Coug defense did the rest.

PORTLAND STATE (2-0) at CALIFORNIA (1-1) - 3:15 PDT - Comcast local cablecast - **The Series:** First meeting.

FRESNO STATE (1-1) at WASHINGTON (1-1) - 3:30 PDT - FSN Northwest local cablecast - **The Series:** Washington and Fresno State have split two previous games. Washington won 49-14 in 1979, Fresno won 35-16 in 2004. Both previous games were at Husky Stadium. . . . **Last Meeting:** Washington and Fresno State met in the season opener at Husky Stadium in 2004 with the Bulldogs breaking open a close game in the fourth quarter to take a 35-16 victory. UW actually outgained Fresno 360-262 and had more first downs (20-11), but was done in by five turnovers, including four interceptions.

ARIZONA STATE (2-0) at COLORADO (0-2) - 5:00 MDT/4:00 PDT/MST - TBS national cablecast - **The Series:** First meeting. . . . **Coaching Note:** The last two head coaches at Boise State square off in this game. ASU's **Dirk Koetter** compiled a mark of 26-10 in three year's (1998-2000) as Boise State head coach before joining the Sun Devils in 2001. His assistant head coach for those three seasons was Dan Hawkins. Hawkins succeeded Koetter as head coach and went 53-11 in five seasons leading the Broncos before making the move to Boulder this year.

NEBRASKA (2-0) at USC (1-0) - 5:00 PDT - ABC national telecast - **The Series:** USC and Nebraska have met just twice with USC winning 31-21 at Lincoln in 1969 and the teams battling to a tie, 21-21, at Los Angeles in 1970. . . . **Last Meeting:** Ranked heavyweights USC and Nebraska, coached by John McKay and Bob Devaney, battled to a 21-21 tie in an early-season game at Los Angeles in 1970.

STEPHEN F. AUSTIN (0-2) at ARIZONA (1-1) - 7:00 MST/PDT - FSN Arizona local cablecast - **The Series:** First meeting.

NAVY (2-0) at STANFORD (0-2) - 7:00 PDT - FSN Bay Area local cablecast - **The Series:** Stanford and Navy have met three times and have a symmetrical 1-1-1 series mark to show for it. Navy got a win at Stanford (25-0) in 1954, the teams battled to a 7-7 tie on The Farm in 1965, and Stanford opened last season with a 41-38 win at Annapolis in the first game for **Walt Harris** as Cardinal head coach. This game marks the debut of the new Stanford Stadium with a scaled-down seating capacity of 50,000. . . . **Last Year:** The Walt Harris era at Stanford began with a season-opening 41-38 victory at Navy.

PAC-10 NOTES:

OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: The Pac-10 has compiled a mark of 11-6 (.647) against non-conference foes in the first two weeks of the season. Of the 17 non-conference games, the home team has won 15 times.

ARIZONA: Wildcats are starting three redshirt freshmen on the offensive line--OG **Daniel Borg**, OT **Ebon Britton** and C **Blake Kerley**. . . . Not only has PK/P **Nick Folk** connected on four of five field goal attempts, he is averaging 48.1 yards on 10 punts, with four downed inside the 20-yard line, and five of his seven kickoffs have been touchbacks. . . . LSU game snapped a streak of four straight games dating back to last year in which Arizona had scored on its opening possession. . . . Senior WR **Syndric Steptoe** has a streak of 19 straight games with at least one reception.

ARIZONA STATE: Game at Colorado this week is coach **Dirk Koetter's** 100th game as a head coach. He has a mark of 61-38 (.616) in his ninth season, three at Boise State and in his sixth at ASU. . . . QB **Rudy Carpenter** passed for a career-high five TDs to five different receivers vs. Nevada last week. Carpenter is 6-1 as the Sun Devil's starter and has passed for more than 300 yards in five of his seven starts. . . . Junior TE **Zach Miller** has 103 career receptions and needs just 13 more to pass former All-America TE Todd Heap for most career receptions by a Sun Devil tight end (115). . . . ASU defense has returned an interception for a TD in each of the first two games. . . . Devils outscoring opponents 42-7 in the second half. . . . ASU defense allowing just 2.5 yards per rush and has yet to surrender a rushing TD.

CALIFORNIA: Soph QB **Nate Longshore** completed 22 of 31 passes (.710) for an even 300 yards and four TDs in win vs. Minnesota. Completions, yards and TDs were all career highs. It was Cal's first 300-yard passing performance since 2003 (Aaron Rodgers). . . . Three of the TD passes went to fellow soph WR **DeSean Jackson**. Four of Jackson's 11 receptions this season have gone for TDs. . . . All-Pac-10 CB **Daymeion Hughes** picked off two passes vs. Minnesota raising his career interception total to nine. . . . Cal defense has not allowed any fourth-quarter points in first two games.

OREGON: Win at Fresno State was **Mike Bellotti's** 92nd win as Oregon head coach, making him the all-time winningest UO coach. He surpassed Rich Brooks' mark of 91 (1977-94). Bellotti now stands at 92-42 (.687) as head coach of the Ducks. . . . QB **Dennis Dixon** had career highs for completions and passing yardage in hitting on 23 of 36 (.639) for 240 yards in win at Fresno State. He has not thrown an interception in Ducks' first two games. . . . Eight of Oregon's nine offensive TDs this year have come via the rush.

OREGON STATE: WR/PR **Sammie Stroughter** returned a punt 64 yards for a TD at Boise State last week, the second straight week he has returned a punt for a score. The Pac-10 season record for most punts returned for a touchdown is three by seven different players, most recently UCLA's Maurice Drew last year. . . . TB **Yvenson Bernard** has averaged 132.0 yards per game over his last 10 games. . . . Beavers are outscoring opponents 35-7 in the first quarter. . . . TE **Joe Newton** appears to be all the way back from the leg injury that cost him the 2005 season. Newton has eight receptions in first two games, three of them for touchdowns. . . . Opponents have averaged just 112.5 yards passing against OSU and the Beavs have allowed just one TD pass.

STANFORD: Newly-constructed Stanford Stadium will make its debut for the Cardinal home opener against Navy this week. The new stadium will seat 50,000 spectators. . . . Stanford is known for recruiting nationally and this year's roster shows players from 26 different states, plus Canada and Sweden. . . . WR **Evan Moore** seems to be fully recovered from hip injury that caused him to miss almost all of last season. In first two games, Moore has eight receptions for 146 yards, including two TD receptions as San Jose State last week. . . . QB **Trent Edwards** has five TD passes and just one interception through first two games.

UCLA: QB **Ben Olson** has completed 73% of his passes (38-52) with five TDs and just one interception in his first two games running the Bruin offense. . . . All five of UCLA's offensive TDs have come through the air. . . . UCLA run defense allowing just 82.5 yards per game after giving up 232.8 yards per game in '05. Overall, UCLA defense allowing 235.5 yards per game as opposed to 468.1 last year. More defense-opponents in first two games have converted just 2-of-24 third-down conversion attempts. Opponents have rushed for just one TD in two games. . . . Bruins only had to punt one time in last outing vs. Rice. . . . PK **Justin Medlock** has connected on 5-of-6 field goals this year, including a 51-yarder in last game.

USC: **C.J. Gable** became the first true freshman to start a season opener at tailback for the Trojans when he lined up on the opening play in SC's 50-14 win at Arkansas. He rushed 51 times on 11 carries and scored the Trojans' first TD of the season on a three-yard run. USC spread the rushing around at Arkansas with six different running backs getting carries as the Trojans rushed for 192 yards. . . . USC led the Pac-10 and was second in the nation in turnover margin last year and started the season at Arkansas 5-0, forcing five turnovers, giving up none. . . . PK **Mario Danelo** was good on 3-of-3 field goal attempts at Arkansas extending his streak to 14 consecutive made. . . . And speaking of toes, kickoff man **Troy Van Blarcom** had eight touchbacks on his nine kickoffs at Arkansas.

WASHINGTON: Huskies have piled up 504 yards rushing in first two games. RB **Louis Rankin** has rushed for 257 yards on just 27 carries, a 9.5 yards per carry average. As a team, UW is averaging 6.2 yards per rush. . . . Husky offense has had an 81-55 run/pass ratio so far this year. . . . Three of Washington's five rushing touchdowns this year have been runs longer than 30 yards. . . . On the other side of the ball, Dawgs have allowed just two rushing TDs in first two games. . . . P **Sean Douglas** is averaging 52.1 yards per punt, including an 82-yarder at Oklahoma. Four of his eight punts have been downed inside the 20-yard line.

WASHINGTON STATE: Starting RB **DeMaundray Woolridge** sat out the Idaho game with a thigh bruise, but four different backs picked up the slack by each rushing for 60 yards or better as the Cougars piled up 344 yards rushing in 56-10 win vs. the Vandals. . . . WSU's 637 yards total offense against Idaho was the Cougs' sixth highest single game total ever and the 56 points were the most in a game since 1997 (77 vs. Southwestern Louisiana). . . . Washington State has scored in 251 consecutive games dating back to 1984. Only Michigan (264) has a longer current streak of games without being shut out. . . . Cougs have given up just one TD pass in first two games. . . . SS **Eric Frampton** has led WSU in tackles in each of the first two games recording nine stops in each contest.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE: Of the 18 games involving Pac-10 teams so far this season, the home team has on 16 times, the visitor just twice.
