Big 12 BCS Success

The 2005 season marked the third straight and fifth time in the last six years that a Big 12 team played in the BCS National Championship game. Since the inception of the the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship game and leads all conferences with its five appearances. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

Big 12 Preseason Media Poll

BAYLOR (3-3, 2-0)

This Week: at Texas
Next Week: Kansas

Linebacker Joe Pawelek registered career highs with 14 tackles and 11 solo efforts vs. Colorado. He intercepted a pass in the end zone in the third overtime to end the game and also created another interception in the second quarter.

Shawn Bell became the fourth quarterback in Baylor history to reach 30 career touchdown passes. He joins Cody Carlson (32), J.J. Joe (31) and Jeff Watson (30). Bell is the only QB in that club with fewer than 27 interceptions (Bell has 14).

Trent Shelton and Dominique Zeigler are BU's most prolific receiver duo in school history, combining for 276 receptions as teammates, eclipsing the previous school mark of 265 established by Reggie Newhouse and Robert Quiroga during the 2000-02 seasons.



COLORADO (0-6, 0-2)

This Week: Texas Tech
Next Week: at Oklahoma

Colorado gained 117 yards in the first quarter against Baylor, the third straight game the Buffs exceeded the century mark for the period; CU had 154 at Missouri after netting 156 at Georgia.

Terrence Wheatley had the first multiple interception game (two) of his career in the triple overtime loss to Baylor and the first by a Buff since Thaddeaus Washington swiped two at Nebraska on Nov. 26, 2004. His eight career interceptions are now tied for 16th all-time.

Quarterback Bernard Jackson rushed for 93 yards for the second consecutive week, and now has 271 over the last three games (311 on the year). Jackson also threw his first career touchdown pass last Saturday.



IOWA STATE (3-3, 0-2)

This Week: at Oklahoma
Next Week: Texas Tech

Linebacker Alvin Bowen, the nation's leading tackler (14.33 tackles per game), had 17 tackles including a tackle for loss to lead the Iowa State defense against Nebraska.

Wide receiver Todd Blythe has 115 career receptions, ranking sixth on the all-time ISU list. His 2,186 receiving yards rank him second on the all-time Cyclone career chart.

The 131 passing yards allowed by Iowa State against Nebraska was the fewest since giving up 58 to Kansas State on Nov. 20, 2004.

The combined attendance total of 110,856 the last two weeks marks the largest back-to-back home game total in school history. ISU set its attendance record two weeks ago and had its second-largest crowd ever with 55,338 for Nebraska.



KANSAS (3-3, 0-2)

This Week: Oklahoma State
Next Week: at Baylor

Kansas' defense has not allowed a 100-yard rusher in 19 straight games.

The Jayhawks' three losses this season have been by six points or less with two in overtime and a three-point loss in the final minute.

Jon Cornish rushed for 128 yards last week against Texas A&M marking the fifth time in six games this season he has surpassed the century mark. Cornish has rushed for 100-plus yards nine times in his career which ties him with Clark Green (2002-05) for fifth on the KU all-time list.

Junior punter Kyle Tucker has pinned opponents inside the 20-yard line 13 times in the last five games.



KANSAS STATE (4-2, 1-1)

This Week: Nebraska
Next Week: at Missouri

The Wildcats racked up a season-high 357 total yards last Saturday - the most since the offense generated 384 yards against Texas A&M last season.

Freshman running back Leon Patton rushed for 151 yards on 21 carries, had 117 yards on kick returns and 33 yards receiving for 301 all-purpose yards - a K-State freshman record and tied for fifth all-time. Patton, the Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week, had a 95-yard kick off return for touchdown. It was the first time a Wildcat tallied more than 300 all-purpose yards since Darren Sproles set the school record with 351 against Louisiana-Lafayette on Sept. 18, 2004.

Josh Freeman became the first true freshman to start under center at KSU since 1976. Freeman hit on 10-of-15 passes, including his final six in the last four minutes vs. Oklahoma State when he led the Wildcats on scoring drives of 92 and 58 yards in the come-from-behind win.



MISSOURI (6-0, 2-0)

This Week: at Texas A&M
Next Week: Kansas State

MU is 6-0 for the first time since 1973 - and only the fourth time ever (1899, 1960, 1973, 2006). Missouri's seven-game win streak (dating back to last year's Independence Bowl) is the fourth-longest active streak in Division I-A, tied for the third-longest winning streak in MU school history, and is the first time since 1968 that the Tigers have won seven straight games.

The Tigers have yet to trail in a game this season. In 360 total minutes of play, Mizzou has held the lead for 331 minutes and 50 seconds, and has been tied for the remaining 28 minutes and 10 seconds.

Dating back to his high school days, Chase Daniel has won 37 of his last 38 starts as a QB, including his first six as a collegian. Additionally, Daniel was a starting WR as a sophomore for Southlake Carroll (Texas) High School, which went 16-0 that year, giving him an overall mark of 53-1 in his last 54 games played as a starter.



NEBRASKA (5-1, 2-0)

This Week: at Kansas State
Next Week: Texas

Cody Glenn's 148 rushing yards at Iowa State were the most by a Nebraska player in a Big 12 game since Cory Ross ran for 194 yards against Missouri in 2004.

Nebraska has 18 rushing touchdowns after rushing for 10 touchdowns all of last season.

The win was the Huskers' 799th all-time, leaving NU one victory shy of becoming the fourth program in Division I to collect 800 all-time wins.

Nebraska leads the Big 12 and is seventh nationally in total offense with 463.8 yards per game.



OKLAHOMA (3-2, 0-1)

This Week: Iowa State
Next Week: Colorado

With 213 all-purpose yards (109 rushing, 10 receiving, 94 kickoff returns) against Texas, Adrian Peterson eclipsed the 4,000 all-purpose yardage mark (4,091) and moved into seventh place on OU's all-time records list. His 21 100-yard rushing games are second all-time at OU, two behind Steve Owens' school-record 23.

Defensive End C.J. Ah You set a career high vs. Texas with eight tackles. His previous best of six tackles was established against Oregon last year in the Holiday Bowl.

Calvin Thibodeaux tied a career high with three tackles for loss (Texas A&M, 2005). The total is the highest for a Sooner against Texas since Jimmy Wilkerson had three in 2001.



OKLAHOMA STATE (3-2, 0-1)

This Week: at Kansas
Next Week: Texas A&M

Senior defensive end Victor DeGrate has recorded a sack in four consecutive games. His two sacks against KSU give him five on the season, which ties his career high set last season.

Sophomore quarterback Bobby Reid tossed two touchdown passes against the Wildcats, giving him 12 for the season. OSU had 11 touchdown passes total in 2005.

Senior wide receiver D'Juan Woods extended his string of consecutive games with a reception to 26.

Freshman Keith Toston set career highs with 14 carries and 109 yards in the Kansas State contest.

OSU leads the nation with a 35.4-yard kickoff return average.



TEXAS (5-1, 2-0)

This Week: Baylor
Next Week: at Nebraska

The Longhorns won their 17th consecutive Big 12 game to extend their own league record. Texas won its 44th Big 12 game since 2000, now two ahead of the nearest team on the list, Oklahoma (42).

With their fumble return for a TD early in the fourth quarter, the Horns have 51 returns (fumble, interception, punt, kickoff, blocked kick) for TDs since 1999. Texas trails only Miami (57) and Virginia Tech (55) in that category over that span.

After going through the first three games without intercepting a pass, UT's defense has logged six interceptions in the last three games.

Colt McCoy moved into a third-place tie with James Brown for most TD passes in a season by a UT freshman with 12 - he trails only Major Applewhite (18) and Shea Morenz (13).



TEXAS A&M (5-1, 1-1)

This Week: Missouri
Next Week: at Oklahoma State

Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week Stephen McGee posted career highs in completions and attempts with a 25-for-45 effort for 240 yards with no interceptions against Kansas. For the season McGee has thrown one interception on 155 attempts.

McGee used eight different receivers: four wide receivers, two tight ends and two running backs in the come-from behind win at Kansas.

The Aggie defense limited Kansas to 113 rushing yards on 27 carries (4.2 per carry), which was 48 yards below KU's season average coming into the game.

Against Kansas, the Aggies were held scoreless in the first quarter for the first time this season and the first time since last year's Colorado game.



TEXAS TECH (4-2, 1-1)

This Week: at Colorado
Next Week: at Iowa State

Missouri's opening field goal marked the first points Texas Tech has given up at home since allowing an SMU field goal in the first quarter of the season opener. The Red Raiders had not given up a touchdown at home this season prior to the MU game.

Senior wide receiver Joel Filani scored his sixth touchdown of the year last Saturday.

Tech's defense has allowed 147.3 pass yards per game, first in the Big 12 and eighth nationally.

Pontiac will donate \$5,000 to the Texas Tech general scholarship fund after fans voted the game-winning touchdown against Texas A&M as the weekly Pontiac Game-Changing Performance. TTU is now a finalist for the \$100,000 Pontiac Game-Changing Performance of the Year, which will be voted on at season's end.
