

Iowa State vs. Colorado Notes

Iowa State 17, Colorado 10

Team Notes

- *Iowa State is bowl-eligible for the first time since 2005.
- *Paul Rhoads is the first ISU coach to win six games in his initial season since 1915, when Charles "Uncle Charlie" Mayser led Iowa State to a 6-2-1 record. A.W. Ristine (6-3-1, 1902) and Clyde Williams (7-1, 1907) are the only other two ISU rookie coaches to reach this mark.
- *ISU's defense matched a season-low for points in a first half (3 today, and vs. Baylor).
- *The 10 points by Colorado are the fewest by the Buffs in the ISU-CU series since Oct. 15, 1983 (a 22-10 ISU win).
- *ISU is now 27-of-33 in the red zone this season, after scoring in all three efforts today.
- *This is the first time ISU has held three league opponents to 10 or fewer points since 1965.

Individual Notes

ALEXANDER ROBINSON

- *Tallied 138 rushing yards today. This is his fifth 100-yard game of the season, and eighth of his career. Three of those eight games were against Colorado. He is the 12th Cyclone to cross the 1,000-yard mark in a single season (1,002), and now has 2,170 career yards (12th in ISU history). He is the first ISU back with a 1,000-yard season since Stevie Hicks (2004).
- *His 30 carries today are a career high (29 vs. Colorado in 2007). The last ISU running back to carry the ball 30 times in a game was Jason Scales (31 at Nebraska, 2007).
- *Notched his third touchdown reception of the season, and career, with a 20-yard scoring catch.

AUSTEN ARNAUD

- *Now has 27 career touchdown passes, passing Seneca Wallace (26 in 2001-02) for fourth place on the ISU career chart.
- *116 passing yards today gives him 4,609 for his career.

MARQUIS HAMILTON

- *Caught his 10th career touchdown pass.
- *Now has 118 career receptions, tying for eighth place (Dennis Ross, 1985-88) on the ISU career chart.
- *Now has 1,445 career receiving yards, tying for eighth place (Jon Davis, 2003-06) on the ISU career chart.

DARIUS DARKS

*Logged his first career rush, a 14-yard gain on an end-around.

GRANT MAHONEY

*Made all three kicks today, and is now 83-for-102 in total kicks (81.3 percent) in his ISU career.

NATE FRERE

*Grabbed his first career interception.

JAMES SMITH

*Recovered his sixth career fumble.

STEPHEN RUEMPOLHAMER

*Recovered his third career fumble.
