In a program known for producing top-caliber linebackers, University of Colorado senior linebacker and defensive captain Jordon Dizon has gone above and beyond the expectations demanded in Buffalo country. Since 1990, CU has sent 15 linebackers to the NFL; those players combined to start just 19 games at linebacker in their true freshman seasons. Dizon has been terrorizing the Big 12 and the rest of the nation since he started 11 games in his true freshman season. Dizon leads the nation with 144 total tackles in 2007, averaging 13.1 per game. His 424 career tackles rank him second in the nation among active players, and the total ranks him fourth on the all-time list at Colorado. A fiery leader with an unquestioned work ethic, Dizon represents the high-character student-athlete head coach Dan Hawkins relies upon to forge the blue, twisted steel of the Colorado defense.
