# **Colorado Head Coach Dan Hawkins**

#### On Texas Being As Good As Their Ranking

"I said before that they're a good football team. They're very solid, Colt [McCoy] is playing great. A couple times I was asked no how we could exploit their weaknesses, and I'm going, 'Not this team, they don't have that.' They are very solid."

## **On Lack Of Producing Points**

"We missed three kicks, so we've got to get that done; we could have gotten on the board earlier with that. We had a hard time running the football and a hard time getting any consistency with anything. Running the football, getting protection, they did a good job on defense. We just have to be able to take advantage of opportunities. If we can make some field goals, it's 14-9 and you got a little more momentum, your spirits are a little bit higher and you have a little bit better opportunity to do some stuff there. You've got that positive and negative thing going on, where when you don't make them then it becomes tough. Nothing against Aric [Goodman], I told him and said, 'I love you and that's a part of the beauty of it. You've got to have the courage to jump in there and say, 'Hey that's me and I'll be back.' But if we get a couple of those and then had the long interception and we couldn't really capitalize after that."

## On Coming In To the Game As Underdogs

"We knew they were very good and that we'd have to play very well to get some things goings. You don't ever come in with a negative attitude necessarily, but we knew they were good."

#### On Watching Tape on Texas Before the Game

"We watched offensively, but we didn't watch their defense, mostly all of their stuff from last year."

### On Getting Pressure on Texas QB, Colt McCoy

"We did ok. We kind of gave up that [big play] at an inopportune time. Colt made a great play on that first drive and flipped it out there. We're trying to come off and tackle the quarterback and he flicks it out there. They hade a couple of other long ones in there, so it was hard out. It is a game of emotion, and despite your greatest pleas or one-liners, you need to have a little credence, a little proof in there. By and large they did a pretty good job. We just have to tackle a little better I think and get some answers on special teams and offense.

# On the Play of Colorado QB, Cody Hawkins

"You look at stats and again, I don't know where he was, but I'm sure it wasn't great. But you have to get your running game going to compliment your play-action and then you have to be able to protect as well. He functionally didn't play great, but that's kind of residual of the circumstance too."

## On the Play of Colorado's Backup QB, Matt Ballenger

"He did a nice job. He came in and threw a good ball to Patrick [Williams]. It's kind of like a team in general too, it's great to see him get some snaps and get some work done, and move the club a little bit."

# On Being Surprised About Running Game

"I don't know if 'surprised' is the right word. We always feel

like you have to be able to run the football a little bit to keep your offense going. When we didn't run it like we wanted to, then it became a big adjustment game."

# On the Offensive Line's Injuries

"It's harder to play offense; they get more pressure on the quarterback and your running game isn't as good."

# On Injuries to RB, Darrell Scott, And FS Ryan Walters

"[Darrell] tweaked his ankle. We'll see [about Walters], initially they thought it was a sprain, but we'll see where he is with that."

# On the Game Being A Measuring Point

"Like I said, we're playing a tough stretch. I think we have a good pulse of where we're at and where we're going, and I like that. We have to continue to get some depth and experience, and continue to get quality recruits like we have. We'll get there. We have some weak players in certain areas and as we continue to establish depth and get experience in there, we're going to be okay. As you play these really good football teams, the margin for error is really, really slim; that's just the nature of it."

# On the Quality of Texas' Athletes

"They have a lot of good players. I think every one of them had some success, to some degree. A lot of that is a case of just having fresh bodies to run in there and being big, strong, fast, and physical."

# On What He Said To His Team, Following the Loss

"I told them, 'Hey, I still love you guys. I still believe in you and I believe in the staff.' You've heard this before, but there's no quick path to the top. You find out what you're made of when you go through the valley a little bit. By the same token, you don't just shirk your responsibility; you say, 'Hey, it was me. Here's what I did and here's where I need to get better.' You come out of these things and find out what your team is made of. I feel very good about what they're made of. We talk to them all the time about being abnormal and different. In these situations, it doesn't matter if it's football or life, a common thing that most people do is point fingers. They'll sit on the sideline and criticize; everybody will point out what's wrong and what needs to be fixed. But you just have to keep taking a step towards the middle and say, 'What can I do? Let's get better, let's stay positive, and keep working on the things we need to work on.' I believe in our guys and I believe in our staff, we just have to keep working is all."

#### On Kansas' Win This Weekend Against Iowa State

"We caught a little bit of that game earlier today on TV, they did a nice job. Again, that was one of those games were it was turnover, after turnover, after turnover. Normally Kansas is a really good team, in terms of that, but it doesn't matter who you are, when you turn the ball over that much it's really hard to win. Iowa State had to kick a couple of field goals, instead of getting touchdowns, and it was hard for them to deliver the knockout punch. Kansas came out [after halftime], scored right away and got the momentum going. They have a good football team, so once they took care of the ball they were a lot better off."

# Texas Head Coach Mack Brown

#### General

"Fun game for us. I'm proud of the guys, proud of the coaches. This is a tough place to play. For a homecoming night game, Colorado would be fired up. I thought our guys played really really well."

"We're happy to be 5-0. Road wins are tough. The guys did a good job in El Paso, and a good job here tonight, and we're excited about Dallas next week."

"Tonight is another example of this team doing what it's supposed to do. And that's come out here and be ready to play a good football team and domintate the game."

## On Play Of Defense

"I'm proud of our defense, especially when they came out with two turnovers in the red zone. We forced them into three field goals which they missed."

"Our defense is playing so much better than in the first game against Florida Atlantic. We're much better up front, the secondary is growing up, and the guys have done a great job coaching them."

"I thought the guys rushed the ball so well. They didn't give Cody (Hawkins) much chance to throw the ball. A lot of tipped passes and that's because of pressure."

"The running game again was obsolete tonight. For two weeks in a row Arkansas and Colorado would line up and run the ball, and both of them did. And we've done a good job of stopping them."

## On Play of Colorado

"Colorado changed up what they had been doing. They put a lot of guys on the line of scrimmage. Blitzed everytime again. But Colt (McCoy)'s so good and so accurate, that he just threw the ball down the field and helped us score 38 points."

# On Play of Chris Ogbonnaya

"We'd known what Chris could do, and that's why we felt like we didn't need to look at him a lot in the non-conference schedule because we've seen him for four years."

"We know he's smart, he's got great hands in the passing game."

"I thought he was the best back on the field tonight."

"We were planning on using Chris a lot tonight."

"When their offense scored their only touchdown against our one defense he made the great run to answer very quickly."

## On Answering any Adversity

"Both sides of the ball handled adversity very well. We needed some adversity. We had some at different times, and I thought the guys handled it really well. They never got shook, they stayed in the game and played hard for 60 minutes."

# On Play of Offensive Line

"I thought they played really well because they picked up so much junk. It was just everywhere, and that's why we had a couple big screens, and we hit the counter-play twice with Chris (Ogbonnaya)."

"You just have to be patient when someone's blitzing as much as they were."

## On Play of Colt McCoy

"He's just playing so well. He's amazing because he's playing with so much confidence, and he knows where everybody is."

"Even on the plays he's not proud of, the long return for the interception is man coverage, and the guy makes a good break on it. Maybe he could have had it a little further out. But he had it to the right guy."

# On Playing Oklahoma Next Week

"It's what these two teams should have mid-season. It's two top five football teams that are playing really well. We'll have everybody in America talking about the game next week, and that's what we all want."

"It's fun. It's what Texas and OU have wanted forever, and we have got it back. With 90,000 plus Gameday, plus everybody in America."

"They're very good. They're very deserving of number one, and I think we're a team that's getting better"

# **Colorado Players**

## **CB Jalil Brown**

GENERAL-"It was a tough loss, we were giving it our all out there and tried our best, but unfortunately it didn't work out the way we planned for it to go."

ON TEXAS OFFENSE-"They were right there with teams like Florida State and West Virginia, but I feel like they were a little more gelled. Their offense worked a little better than the previous teams we've played."

ON COLT MCCOY-"It's always tough preparing for a dual threat quarterback like that. He can scramble out of the pocket but also through the long ball. You have to be in a position for both and you can't be leaning one way or the other."

ON MENTAL STATE OF TEAM-"I feel like our team has come together a long ways compared to previous seasons I've been here. We'll be right there to bounce back and be ready to play Kansas. I'm looking forward to the upcoming games."

# CB Cha'pelle Brown

ON DEFENSE-"Yeah I did get an interception but I gave up a touchdown too. We still have a lot of work to do, but we'll be back ready next week, ready to go."

ON TEXAS-"The quarterback [Colt McCoy] was pretty good. We have to go back to the drawing board and get back to work. We missed a lot of plays today."

ON UPCOMING GAMES-"We're ready to fight. It's all right, we'll be back next week. It's a good Kansas team and we just have to get better this week."

### **WR Patrick Williams**

ON TOUCHDOWN CATCH-"It's always good to make plays for the team. I would have enjoyed it a lot more if it would have come in a victory. We didn't play well enough as a team to come out and deserve a win."

ON TEXAS DEFENSE-"I tip my hat to them, they definitely flew around and made plays. They pressured our quarterback and when you get that kind of pressure on the quarterback, you're going to have a tough time out there. Our offensive linemen played well, but we didn't play well enough as a team to come out with a victory."

"We knew what they were going to do on defense. They came out and played man and challenged us to run the ball and it didn't go how we wanted it to but that is a part of college football. You have to make plays and adjust with on the fly."

ON TEAM MORALE-"We're a resilient team, we're not going to stay down on this loss. We have a lot of football in front of us, we're in it for the long run. We have Coach Hawk's back 100%. We believe in our teammates, our coaches, our scheme, we understand that there's going to be some bumps and bruises along the way. It takes a special type of person to come back tomorrow and get working and grinding. We understand that every loss hurts, but we're not going to hang our heads on it. We're going to take it as a learning lesson and continue to get better."

# **QB Cody Hawkins**

ON TEXAS-"Texas is a great football team and they're going to play like it. We didn't play with the capability we can. We didn't make enough plays to win and could not get into a rhythm. Tonight we were just struggling to find ourselves, but we just have to keep coming out. We did a decent job staying positive and staying together. The bottom line is we have to come out and execute."

ON OFFENSE-"You have to score points, especially in the redzone. The most important thing for our offense is to put it in the end zone. Regardless of if we got the field goals or not, we weren't playing our best and weren't getting the job done."

ON TEXAS DEFENSE-"They are a good defense, we could have done a lot of things better. They definitely did a good job and schemed stuff up. They did just enough things to make you change what you were doing. They were physical and fast and well schooled."

ON RUNNING GAME-"We got a lot of young guys, we're trying to plug some young guys in there and up front we're also very young. We've got three guys who had never started before and Nate Solder going through a position switch. We've just got to keep coming out and getting used to things. It was definitely a tough test. We just have to keep getting better, look at the film, and put it behind us tomorrow, we have a lot of potential but we have to put it together on a consistent basis."

# LT Nate Solder

ON OFFENSE-"We did some things good and some things not as good as we should have done. We definitely could have played a lot better- we didn't play to our potential."

ON TEXAS DEFENSE-"They were pretty straight up, they did a little stunting here and there. They're not as fast as Florida State. I give them a lot of credit."

ON DE BRIAN ORAKPO-"He is a good player, I give him a lot of respect. He can move well, he uses a lot of different moves."

# **DT George Hypolite**

ON OFFENSIVE LINE OF TEXAS-"They're very big and do a good job in their system of moving left to right. They gave Colt McCoy time to make plays. Their offense sets up for the kind of guys they have. They did a good job."

ON COLT MCCOY-"We try to attack the same way, but you're still conscious of it. You want to make sure you keep him boxed in and keep him in the pocket because he showed tonight that he can do a lot of damage outside the pocket. You have to take your hat off to the Texas team, they made the plays when they needed to."

ON MENTAL STATE-"From the neck up we have to tighten things down. Our goal should be to become more detail-oriented. A lot of the things we gave up on defense were not assignments, it was just missed tackles. We were picking them right and we had guys where they needed to be and we just missed tackles. We have to clean it up defensively."

ON THE WIN—"We came out strong and put up 14 quick points. I give a lot of credit to the defense. They played awesome. They gave us a lot of good field position."

ON OPENING BIG 12 PLAY—"It's the first game of the Big 12. That's all the motivation that we need. You can't over look Colorado. They're a great team. The defense played well. They did a lot of different things that we weren't ready for."

ON THE RED RIVER SHOOTOUT— "We are going to enjoy the win and get back to work tomorrow for OU. They're a good team and they deserve to be number one. We feel confident in our coaches and our team, but we have little things to correct."

# COLORADO BUFFALO FOOTBALL / POSTGAME NOTES

Colorado Buffaloes vs. Texas Longhorns, Folsom Field, Boulder, Colo. (October 4, 2008)

**QUICKLY** Tonight's sellout crowd of **53,927** was the first at Folsom Field since the 2005 finale against Nebraska (54,841 on Nov. 25); it was CU's first sellout for homecoming since 2003 (when No. 1 Oklahoma was the opponent) ... The opponent has scored on its opening drive against the Buffs three times in five games including tonight ... Colorado is now **21-15-1** all-time when wearing its all-black uniforms; a three-game winning streak was snapped tonight ... Texas' 14 first quarter points was a season high by an opponent; no one had scored more than a TD against the Buffs in the opening stanza ... PK Aric Goodman tied the school record, held by several, for the most missed field goals in a game with three in the first half; the last time that happened was in CU's 29-7 loss to Oklahoma in the 2002 Big 12 Championship game, when Pat Brougham missed on tries from 41, 32 and 33 yards ... Colorado and Texas actually ran the same number of plays in plus territory in the first half (12); the Longhorns gained 82 yards and scored twice, while CU totaled only 13 yards ... QB Cody Hawkins' third quarter fumble was the CU's first second half turnover this season; the first eight were all committed in the first half, seven in the second quarter ... **FB Jake Behrens** caught his third TD pass of his career, tonight's 7-yard more than twice the distance of his first two (1, 2).

FIRST STARTS OT Matt Bahr made his first career start, as he moves into the right tackle spot for an injured Ryan Miller, who is out for the year with a fractured fibula (he had surgery as planned on Friday). TE Ryan Deehan made his first career start as CU opened in a two tight end formation.

FIRST CAREER ACTION OG Shawn Daniels saw his first career action tonight, getting in from scrimmage; ILB Tyler Ahles saw his first game time, coming on kickoff coverage; QB Matt Ballenger and OG Ethan Adkins entered their first CU game on offense in the fourth quarter.

**CB JALIL BROWN** The sophomore made his first career interception near the end of the first quarter, returning it 57 yards; Brown has been a force on CU's special teams since the middle of last season (33 special teams points in the last 10 games), but has seen a lot of playing time on defense in 2008 as he is the nickel back. **Team Note:** CU has six

interceptions this season, returning the six-pack of steals for 142 yards, or 23.7 per.

**240 & COUNTING** For the 23rd time in the streak, CU did not score until the second half in extending its scoring run to **240** consecutive games. That is the fourth longest active streak in the nation, trailing Michigan (293), Washington State (278) and Florida (248), and is the ninth longest of all-time (Note: Michigan and UF extended their streaks today; WSU plays UCLA tonight). CU was last shutout in the first half last Oct. 20, trailing Kansas 3-0 in an eventual 19-14 loss; this was the 14th time CU scored in the third quarter to add to the streak. CU was last shutout nearly 20 years ago, 7-0 at Nebraska on Nov. 12, 1988.

**OB CODY HAWKINS (33-13-0, 118, 1 TD)** With 96yards of total offense, Hawkins cracked CU's top 10 in total offense, finishing the game with 3,573 yards, ninth all-time. He passed Craig Ochs (3,530) and Steve Vogel (3,501) into the top 10. His ratio of touchdowns to interceptions in the red zone grew to 23-to-1 with the 7-yard TD toss to Jake Behrens.

\*\*POB MATT BALLENGER (4-3-0, 61, 1 TD)\*\* He threw a touchdown pass in his first career appearance, and in doing so, became the first non-starting QB at Colorado to have one in game since 2004, when James Cox had one in a 19-14 win over lowa State (a game best remembered for Mason Crosby's 60-yard field goal).

WR PATRICK WILLIAMS (4-50, 1 TD) Williams moved up on CU's all-time list for receptions (89, 14th) and yards (897, 24th). His 28-yard TD reception late in the game was the second of his career, the other coming against lowa State in 2006.

**DEFENSIVE POSITIVES** The Buffs had two interceptions of Colt McCoy (in 30 attempts); he had thrown just one in 100 tries coming into the game ... Texas rushed for three yards or less on 27 of 46 attempts, and seven of the 23 completions went for five yards or less ... Allowing for the two long plays of 65 and 51 yards made by Ogbonnaya, the Longhorns had 74 plays for 316 yards, a modest 4.3 per play.

INJURY REPORT TB Darrell Scott (ankle sprain).

# COLORADO BUFFALO FOOTBALL / HALFTIME NOTES & QUOTES

Colorado Buffaloes vs. Texas Longhorns, Folsom Field, Boulder, Colo. (October 4, 2008)

against the Buffs three times in five games including tonight ... Colorado came into tonight 21-14-1 all-time when wearing its all-black uniforms; that includes three straight wins (5 of the last 6), two this year (CSU, West Virginia) ... Texas' 14 first quarter points was a season high; no one had scored more than a TD against the Buffs in the opening stanza ... Tonight was an official sellout (number coming in the third quarter), CU's first sellout for homecoming since 2003 (when No. 1 Oklahoma was the opponent); CU also sold out the previous year for a 35-31 win over No. 13 Kansas State ... Texas was 2-of-3 on 3rd-&-1 in the first half; the Buffalo D has been strong all year in that situation, allowing the foe to convert just 6-fo-11 times when faced with 36 inches or so for a first ...

**PK Aric Goodman** tied the school record, held by several, for the most missed field goals in a game with three in the first half; the last time that happened was in CU's 29-7 loss to Oklahoma in the 2002 Big 12 Championship game, when **Pat Brougham** missed on tries from 41, 32 and 33 yards ... Colorado and Texas actually ran the same number of plays in plus territory in the first half (12); the Longhorns gained 82 yards and scored twice, while CU totaled only 13 yards ...

CU was last shutout in the first half last Oct. 20, trailing Kansas 3-0 in an eventual 19-14 loss; the Buffs of course have the nation's fourth longest active scoring streak at 239 games; in this run, CU scored in the second half 22 times to extend it (13 times in the third quarter, nine times in the fourth, the latest score coming with 3:39 to play against Florida State last year).

FIRST STARTS OT Matt Bahr made his first career start, as he moves into the right tackle spot for an injured Ryan Miller, who is out for the year with a fractured fibula (he

had surgery as planned on Friday). **TE Ryan Deehan** made his first career start as CU opened in a two tight end formation.

**CB JALIL BROWN** The sophomore made his first career interception near the end of the first quarter, returning it 57 yards; Brown has been a force on CU's special teams since the middle of last season (33 special teams points in the last 10 games), but has seen a lot of playing time on defense in 2008 as he is the nickel back. **Team Note:** CU has five interceptions this season, returning the quintet of steals for 142 yards, or 28.4 per.

GENERAL—"We need to get the run game going in the second half. The defense is doing a reasonably good job, but we needed to follow that interception with a touchdown. We need to come out and make plays in the second half."

# No. 5/5 Texas 38, Colorado 14 October 4, 2008 Folsom Field – Boulder, Colo.

#### **TEAM NOTES**

- \* With the win, Mack Brown racked up his 194th career victory. He moved into a tie for 22<sup>nd</sup> place with Howard Jones on the all-time wins list for the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision. Jones won 194 games in 29 years at Syracuse, Yale, Ohio State, Iowa, Duke and USC
- \* Texas opened the season with five straight wins for the fifth time in Mack Brown's tenure.
- \* Texas opened Big 12 play with a victory for the 10th time in Mack Brown's 11 seasons at Texas and is 3-0 in Big 12 road openers during that stretch.
- \* Texas has taken a 10-7 lead in the series with Colorado and has won six of the last seven, including four straight.
- \* Texas has scored 236 points over its first five games, the most for Texas since 1915 (281).
- \* The Texas defense has held its opponent to 14 points or less in the first five games of a season for the first time since 1991.
- \* Texas is outscoring opponents 38-9 in the first guarter this season.
- \* Texas has not allowed a TD in the first quarter this season.
- \* Texas is outscoring opponents 132-29 in the first half this season.
- · Texas has produced at least 400 yards of total offense in 64 of its last 95 games. The Longhorns are 87-2 when recording more than 400 yards of total offense in the Mack Brown era.
- \* With 11 receptions, Colt McCoy and Quan Cosby have tied the UT record for completions between a QB and a WR with 131, matching the number between Chris Simms and Roy Williams (2000-02). McCoy and Cosby passed Major Applewhite and Kwame Cavil's 124 completions (1998-99).

#### MACK BROWN ERA MARKS

- \* UT is now 92-3 when outrushing its opponent.
- \* UT is now 80-13 when outpassing its opponent.
- \* UT is now 53-7 when passing for more than 250 yards.
- \* UT is now 79-7 when scoring first.
- \* UT is now 104-12 when scoring more than 20 points.
- \* UT is 90-7 when leading at halftime.

#### INDIVIDUAL NOTES

#### Rashad Bobino

\* - Bobino's fumble recovery in the fourth quarter was his first of the season and the third of his career.

#### **Quan Cosby**

- \* Cosby caught a pass in his 36<sup>th</sup> consecutive game.
- \* With 11 receptions, Colt McCoy and Quan Cosby have tied the UT record for completions between a QB and a WR with 131, matching the number between Chris Simms and Roy Williams (2000-02). McCoy and Cosby passed Major Applewhite and Kwame Cavil's 124 completions (1998-99).

#### **Cody Johnson**

- \* Johnson extended his UT freshman running back record by rushing for a TD in each of his first five games.
- \* With two rushing TDs, Johnson now has six on the season.

### **Hunter Lawrence**

\* - Lawrence's 46-yard field goal was the longest of his career. He remained perfect on the season, making his only field goal and all five of his PAT attempts. He is now 4-of-4 on field goals and 24-of-24 on PATs this season.

#### Colt McCoy

- \* McCoy moved his career record as a starter to 25-6. He is now tied with James Brown (25-13-1) and Peter Gardere (25-16) for fifth place on the UT all-time list.
- \* McCoy increased his UT career TD pass record to 67 with two TD passes in the game. He now has 16 on the season.
- \* McCoy's 67 career passing TDs are tied with Major Applewhite for the most thrown by a Texas QB. Officially, Applewhite tallied 62 TDs during his career, but if you included bowl games, he posted 67 TD passes.
- \* With 262 passing yards, McCoy moved into fourth on UT's all-time passing list with 7,153 yards, moving ahead of Chris Simms (7,097, 1999-2002).
- \* With 301 total yards, McCoy moved into second on UT's all-time list with 8,132 (7,153p/979r), passing James Brown (8,049, 7,638p/411r, 1994-97) and Major Applewhite (8,059, 8,353p/-294r, 1998-2001). McCoy trails only Vince Young, who posted 9,167 total yards (6,040p/3,127r) from 2003-05.

#### Chris Ogbonnaya

- \* Ogbonnaya's 111 receiving yards in the first half are the most in UT history by a running back in a half.
- \* Ogbonnaya's 116 receiving yards are the second-most in a game by a running back in UT history (120, Eric Metcalf, vs. Rice, 1985).
- \* Ogbonnaya's 65-yard TD reception in the first quarter was the longest of his career, bettering his 46-yard TD reception against Rice earlier this season.
- \* The 65-yard reception was the seventh-longest by a running back in UT history.
- \* Ogbonnaya's receiving TD was the third of his career. All three have come this season.
- \* Ogbonnaya also recorded a 23-yard reception.
- \* Playing primarily as UT's third-down back, Ogbonnaya entered the Colorado game with seven carries for 22 yards on the season. He tallied nine carries for 71 yards and a TD.
- \* Ogbonnaya set single-game career highs in both carries (nine) and rushing yards (71). His previous highs were seven carries against UCF (2007) and Sam Houston State (2006) and 33 yards against Oklahoma State (2006).
- \* Ogbonnaya's 13-yard TD run late in the second quarter was his first of the season and the fifth of his career.
- \* Ogbonnaya's 51-yard run in the third quarter was the longest of his career, bettering a 26-yard run against Oklahoma State in 2006.

#### Jordan Shipley

- \* Shipley has now caught at least one TD pass in all five games this season.
- \* With his TD reception, Shipley tied Herkie Walls (1982) for third on UT's all-time list of consecutive games with a TD reception at five.
- \* Shipley's 16-yard TD reception in the first quarter was his seventh of the season and the 16th of his career.
- \* Shipley is now tied for third on UT's all-time TD receptions list with 16 (B.J. Johnson, 200-03; Mike Adams, 1992-96).

#### **Aaron Williams**

\* - Williams' forced fumble in the fourth quarter was the first of his career. He has now caused a turnover in two consecutive games after returning an INT 81 yards for a TD against Arkansas.
