BYLAWS WE ARE REFERENCING TODAY–

- × 11.7.4.3 Off-Campus Recruiting – At Any One Time.
- × It is permissible for a CU coach to leave the Boulder campus to engage in off-campus contact/evaluation before another coach, who is off campus, actually returns to campus, provided the total number of coaches recruiting on behalf of CU at any time, does not exceed the permissible number. The coach being replaced must complete his/her recruiting activities before another coach may begin any off-campus recruiting activity. Further, the replaced coach may not engage in additional recruiting activities until after he/she has returned to the CU campus.

“TAGGING” DURING OFF-CAMPUS RECRUITING

- ✘ NCAA rule mandates that there are a limited number of coaches that can be in the “recruiting mode” for CU at any one time (MBB = 3; WBB=3; FB=7; Soccer=2).
- ✘ Remember, it is permissible for coaches to “cross paths” when they are out there on the recruiting road, in that coach A can depart the CU campus to go recruiting, before Coach B actually returns to the campus.

“TAGGING BACK IN” DURING RECRUITING

- ✘ Once the coach returns to the CU campus, he/she is eligible to go back out on the road again.
 - + The coach may “tag” the coach coming off the road, as soon as they come out of the gym, off the field or out of the school or home and complete their recruiting activities—it can be that tight of a tag, if you will.
- ✘ In order for the “tagging out” coach to tag back into off-campus recruiting, the coach **MUST** return to the CU campus (it cannot simply be to touch down at the Denver airport).
