## CAMP/CLINIC PHONE CALLS

Telephone calls to an individual (or his/her parents, guardians, relatives or coach) that relates *solely* to institutional camp and clinic issues (e.g., missing registration information) is not subject to the restrictions on telephone calls. No recruiting conversation can occur and the staff member cannot use the call to convince the individual to come to camp.

A football student-athlete from another BCS school decided he wanted to transfer from his institution. This young man took the appropriate steps in following through with this request by asking for, and obtaining, a release from his scholarship. However, the institution from which he was transferring exercised the option of not giving an unconditional release to the young man. Therefore, they allowed MOST schools to contact him but restricted some schools from doing so. The student-athlete exercised his right to appeal this restriction because he wanted to explore a transfer to some of those "restricted" schools. Schools do not always utilize this option, so contact Compliance if you have a student-athlete who is considering a transfer. We want to work with you every step of the way if you have reservations about releasing a transfer student-athlete to a certain school.
