The 11th annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship takes place at Kansas City's Arrowhead Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 2, at 7:00 p.m. (CST) under the television cameras of ABC Sports.

Media registration will be available on-line in mid-October at www.big12sports.com under the Media Center link. Registration will only be accepted on-line for accredited media who meet posted Big 12 Guidelines.

General public tickets are available at all Ticketmaster outlets, by phone at (800) 676-5488 or online at ticketmaster.com. Group tickets and premium ticket packages are available through Arrowhead Stadium at (888) 992-4433.

Tickets are priced at \$80, \$70, \$60 and \$50, plus handling fee.

In the 10-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

Gautt Honored by OU

During last Saturday's game, the University of Oklahoma honored former player Prentice Gautt. Gautt, a former administrator in both the Big Eight and Big 12 Conference offices, was the first black football player at OU. To commemorate his contributions, the 38 yard-line was marked with a crimson stripe at both ends of the field. Gautt, who passed away in 2005, wore No. 38 when he played for the Sooners. Also during the evening, the university announced an endowed scholarship in Gautt's name. This marks the anniversary of the first year Gautt played for Oklahoma.

Big 12 BCS Success

The 2005 season marked the third straight and fifth time in the last six years that a Big 12 team played in the BCS National Championship game. Since the inception of the the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship game and leads all conferences with its five appearances. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

Big 12 Preseason Media Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in three of the last four seasons (UT/OU-05, OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Last year the media accurately predicted Texas to win the South and Colorado to win the North. Overall the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 11-of-20 times. Following are this season's projections.

BAYLOR (4-4, 3-1)
This Week: Texas A&M
Next Week: at Texas Tech

Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week, Shawn Bell set school records with 394 passing yards and five touchdown passes in last week's win against Kansas.

Bell moved into fourth place on Baylor's career passing yards chart with 5,406 yards and moved into first place on BU's single-season passing chart with 2,323 yards on the season.

Baylor's 18-point comeback tied for the largest fourth-quarter comeback in school history, matching the 1936 game in which Texas led 18-0 only to see Baylor win 21-18.

The Bears' defense has recorded at least one turnover in 10 consecutive games.



COLORADO (1-7, 1-3)
This Week: at Kansas
Next Week: Kansas State

Inside linebacker Thaddaeus Washington had a career-high 19 tackles vs. Oklahoma, giving him 311 for his career, the 13th player in school history to record 300 in a career (he stands 11th all-time). In the process, he passed his position coach, Brian Cabral, who posted 297 between 1974-77.

Colorado went 67:47 without being penalized and did not commit a penalty two weeks ago against Texas Tech. CU's first penalty last Saturday at OU was with 7:13 left in the first quarter, with the previous coming in the first overtime possession vs. Baylor.

Mason Crosby is 11-of-12 on field goal attempts in the final 8½ minutes of games. His six misses this year have been from an average of 49.8 yards. He has accounted for CU's only points in a game six times during his career to keep the Buff's 218-game scoring streak in tact.



IOWA STATE (3-5, 0-4)
This Week: at Kansas State
Next Week: Kansas

Bret Meyer has 905 pass attempts for his career, moving up to eighth on the Big 12 career list. Meyer's 44 total pass and rush attempts last Saturday give him a career total of 1,279 offensive plays, good for fourth in Big 12 history.

Milan Moses, in his first game returning kickoffs, tallied 88 yards on three returns last Saturday. Moses also made his first receptions of the year, grabbing two passes for 19 yards.

Bret Culbertson's 52-yard field goal against Texas Tech was a career-long and the eighth-longest in school history. It was also the first 50-yarder made by an ISU kicker since Oct. 18, 2003; and the longest field goal made by a Cyclone since Nov. 21, 1998, when Jamie Kohl booted a 54-yarder vs. Kansas.



KANSAS (3-5, 0-4)
This Week: Colorado
Next Week: at Iowa State

Senior running back Jon Cornish rushed for a career-high 196 yards vs. Baylor to mark his sixth 100-yard rushing game of the year. It was his 10th career 100-yard game, moving him in sole possession of fifth place on KU's all-time list.

Freshman linebacker Arist Wright recorded his first career interception, returning it 28 yards for a touchdown, in the loss to Baylor. It marked KU's first defensive TD of the season and longest INT return of 2006.

Kansas' 35 first-half points against Baylor were its most since scoring 49 against Toledo in 2004.

Scott Webb moved into fourth place on the KU's all-time PAT kicks made list with 81.



KANSAS STATE (4-4, 1-3)
This Week: Iowa State
Next Week: at Colorado

The Wildcats rushed for a season-high 262 yards last Saturday, the most since rushing for 307 last year against North Texas.

Freshman Leon Patton totaled 274 all-purpose yards against Missouri with 112 yards rushing, 38 receiving and 124 on kickoff returns.

Against the Tigers, junior running back James Johnson rushed for a career-high 127 yards on 20 carries with his first career touchdown.

With Patton and Johnson each rushing for over 100 yards, K-State had two 100-yard rushers in a game for the first time since Allen Webb (147) and Darren Sproles (135) vs. Nebraska in 2004.

With a sack last week, Ian Campbell now has nine on the season and moved into a tie for eighth place on the K-State single-season charts. Campbell also recorded a career-high nine tackles in the contest.



MISSOURI (7-1, 3-1)
This Week: Oklahoma
Next Week: at Nebraska

Chase Daniel now holds the MU single-season touchdown passing record with 19. He also moved into 10th place in single-season passing yardage with 2,003 yards and into 10th place for single season total offense with 2,250 total yards on the season.

Tight end Chase Coffman moved into sixth place in career receiving yards with 856.

Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week, senior safety David Overstreet's 41-yard fumble return for a touchdown was his first career score.

Wide receiver Will Franklin tied the MU record with five touchdowns this season of 30 yards or more with a 52-yard TD catch in Saturday's win against K-State.

Defensive end Brian Smith, third in the Big 12 with 7.5 sacks this season, suffered a broken hip in Saturday's game.



NEBRASKA (6-2, 3-1)
This Week: at Oklahoma State
Next Week: Missouri

Maurice Purify has caught 17 passes this season with 16 being for first downs, including three touchdowns. Purify is averaging 24.5 yards per catch, and has 10 receptions of more than 20 yards this season.

With his 15 completions, Zac Taylor became Nebraska's career leader in pass completions with 359. The previous record was 353 set by Dave Humm from 1972-74.

Linebacker Steve Octavien returned to the field against Texas for the first time since the USC game and totaled a career-high 10 tackles, including seven solo stops. He also had two tackles for loss, a forced fumble and a pass breakup.



OKLAHOMA (5-2, 2-1)
This Week: at Missouri
Next Week: at Texas A&M

The Oklahoma defense is holding opponents to an average of 77.25 rushing yards over the last four games, and 169.5 yards of offense.

Starting in place of the injured Adrian Peterson, Allen Patrick established career highs with 35 carries for 110 yards in the win over Colorado. It was the highest rushing total by a CU opponent this season. The Buffaloes entered the game ranked No. 9 against the rush at 77.3 yards per game.

Oklahoma plays four of its last five regular-season games on the road for the first time since 1986 when it went on a five-game win streak to capture the Big Eight title.



OKLAHOMA STATE (4-3, 1-2)
This Week: Nebraska
Next Week: at Texas

Dantrell Savage eclipsed 100-yards for the first time with a 134-yard rushing effort against Texas A&M. His two TDs this season have been on 70- (FAU) and 60-yard (TAMU) scampers.

Redshirt freshman safety Andre Sexton recorded a career-high 15 tackles Saturday, marking the highest total by a Cowboy this season.

Three of the four catches by sophomore fullback John Johnson have been for touchdowns. Of his 10 career catches, five have been for TDs.

Zac Robinson was forced into action after Bobby Reid suffered a concussion in the first-half of the Texas A&M game. Robinson threw for 94 yards and three touchdowns, on 7-of-16 passing.



TEXAS (7-1, 4-0)
This Week: at Texas Tech
Next Week: Oklahoma State

Texas heads into Saturday's game at Texas Tech with a school-record 16-game road winning streak and has won 28 of its last 29 road contests.

Pressed into duty because of injury, walk-on Ryan Bailey connected on his first collegiate field goal attempt from 22 yards out with 0:23 left to lift UT to a 22-20 win at Nebraska and earn Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week honors.

Offensive tackle Justin Blalock has made 46 consecutive starts, putting him in second on UT's career list behind Dan Neil (49, 1993-96).

Colt McCoy's 55-yard touchdown pass to Limas Sweed in Saturday's win at Nebraska was his fifth TD pass of 50 or more yards this season and his fourth in the last four games.



TEXAS A&M (7-1, 3-1)
This Week: at Baylor
Next Week: Oklahoma

Stephen McGee has not thrown an interception in his last 103 pass attempts. For the season, McGee has thrown one interception in 204 attempts.

The Aggies are 7-1 for the first time since 2001. It's the 15th time in Dennis Franchione's 24 seasons as a head coach that his team has won seven or more games.

Using a balanced offensive attack, the Aggies have rushed for 1,631 yards (203.9 ypg) and passed for 1,667 (208.4 ypg) this season.

A&M has played one overtime game each of the last three seasons.

Texas A&M is averaging less than one turnover per game over the last seven contests.



TEXAS TECH (5-3, 2-2)
This Week: Texas
Next Week: Baylor

Junior Alex Trlica moved into sixth place on Tech's all-time scoring list with 225 points surpassing Lin Elliott (1988-91) to become Tech's all-time scoring leader at the kicker position.

With two sacks against Iowa State senior defensive end Keyunta Dawson moved into a tie with Calvin Riggs (1983-86) for fourth place on the school's career sacks list with 18.5.

Graham Harrell went 31-for-40 with six touchdowns and no turnovers at Iowa State. The last time a Tech quarterback threw for six touchdowns in a game was B.J. Symons when he threw eight against Texas A&M in 2003.

Tech closes the regular-season with three of its last four games at home.
