Head Coach Dan Hawkins

On poor performance this week...

"We talked about this a lot every week. Games can come down to four or five plays you have to make. We had two turnovers, one on offense and one on special teams that hurt us a bunch. Head Coach Bill Snyder

On overall thoughts on the game...

"We had our moments. We were blessed by Colorado giving up a substantial amount of penalties and they are probably unhappy about dropping passes. They dropped a number of throws. I thought we covered pretty well. We dropped a ton of balls. We had four or five interception balls that were right in our hands that we failed to catch. We are not without our issues on defense, but we played well on defense. We just did not coach well and play well on offense."

On the defensive performance...

"I felt our defense played extremely well. I thought our coaches did a great job. I think our offense put them in some ridiculous situations. We had three or four guys out there on the defensive side that did not practice all week with all the flu stuff going around. I thought they played lights out and I am awfully proud of them."

On containing Colorado quarterback Tyler Hansen...

"We changed up our rush patterns quite a bit. We were probably in the position where if you get real good at the pass rush, which we have not been infamous for, but if you are flying all over the place, it is pretty easy to miss him. We just tried to keep him in front of us which probably gave him a little more opportunity to throw the football."

On Jeffrey Fitzgerald...

"Jeff just plays well. That is what he is supposed to do and he has been playing with effort. Jeff is one of those guys who was limited in practice all week and we did not know until game time if he would be strong enough to play. I appreciate him a great deal."

On why he is disappointed despite the win...

"The name of this game for us is trying to get better. We got better on defense and I am proud of that. We did not get better on offense. It is all about preparing well and playing well. It is no more complex than that. If you finish well, it means you played well and prepared well. If you do not, that means you did not prepare well or play well. Half of our game we did not prepare well or play well."

On Brandon Banks' abilities on special teams...

"If he gets the ball in his hands, he has some capabilities because of his speed to get out of the gate, but they contained him fairly well. It is not like he is going to do it every time. I say this to him many times and I'm sure I will say it again; it is not all about Brandon. We have a bunch of guys back there on returns and if they do their job, then he has a chance to utilize his skill. If they do not do their job, he does not have his chance to do that."

On Emmanuel Lamur's performance and leadership...

"Emmanuel gets better on a pretty consistent basis. I have been pleased with his improvement. I truly have. He is a leader to a certain degree, but he is not where we would like him to be. He is still feeling his own way around. He is just making sure that he has all of his stuff right, but he has tried to put himself out there a little bit."

On his mentality after two consecutive wins...

"My thinking is we went into the Texas Tech game with an opportunity to improve ourselves and we did not do it. So it was significant for us to come back. I knew we could be better and that is all I can ask of these young guys."

On what his team can do now to improve...

"We need to go to practice, prepare well and be better players; and we need to be better coaches. That is what will help our football team. Do not misunderstand me, I am just angry. I am proud of them and I am proud that collectively, we have won a ball game. I am proud wherever we are in the conference and that we have won however many games we have. If that was the only deal, I would be a happy camper. But that is not what we are about and that is not what we are trying to be about. And I do not want them to feel good about playing poorly or coaching poorly."

Sophomore Quarterback Tyler Hansen

On what happened after the first drive...

"We just did not execute. There is always one guy missing a sign. We didn't play solid football. It's just frustrating and disappointing. We should have won that game."

On wide receiver's not getting open...

"A couple of times the wide receiver's couldn't get open. They were doing good in coverage making it tough for us to find open guys. Their defense did a good job tonight."

On if Kansas State made an adjustment after the first drive...

"I don't think so. They did stuff that we have seen before. It's pretty much on us to execute. But we just didn't get it done."

Wide Receiver Scotty McKnight

On the defensive pressure faced by Tyler Hansen...

"I don't think we were really having trouble getting open. I think Tyler (Hansen) was getting some pressure and that was hard on him."

On why Colorado struggled with penalties today...

"I have no idea. I really couldn't tell you. It comes down to discipline and focus. I think there comes a time out there where guys get unfocused and maybe get too caught up in the game. Part of playing at this level is that you've got to stay focused and know your assignment – do only what you can do and don't try to do other people's jobs. That starts with the snap count and it carries on to other parts of the game. You've got to practice the way you want to play. If you're jumping offsides, if you're holding, if that's happening to you, then that's something you need to work on extra at practice. You can't make mistakes like that. We've just got to clean it up."

On losing their fire on the road offensively...

"I felt like after that first road, 'Okay, we're going to roll today on offense,' and we just got stagnant and things weren't working out for us. That's on us as an offense. We've got to help our defense out. They played pretty well for the most part. We've got to do everything right in every phase of the game. The Big 12 is a tough conference and this is a good football team, so hats off to them, but we've got to come out and execute. We've got to be smarter. That's something we've got to thrive on. We've got to be a smart team who doesn't make technique mistakes. We can't make many mistakes. That's got to be our deal."

Junior Defensive End Marquez Herrod

On the K-State running game...

"You know, I think that's what they focus on. They focus on running the ball and managing the clock. They got a good, fast, hard running guy back there. You know they stick with it. We stopped them a few times, but they always kept coming back to the run."

On how they adjusted to K-State's option running...

"They got us a couple times. I mean, we practiced the option, we were ready for the option. It's just kind of guys fitting up in the right places."

Senior Linebacker Marcus Burton

On being able to slow down Daniel Thomas...

"I think it was difficult when he has the speed and size that he has. He's able to stretch out the field and make certain cuts, and at the same time he's able to run people over. It's difficult defending a guy like that, but I think we just have to do a better job of doing our job."

**QUICKLY** This the first pre-Noon kickoff this year for the Buffaloes, who have kicked off at 5:10 (twice), 9:07, 1:30, 7:45 and 6:21 ... This was CU's 69th game in the state of Kansas, and the Buffs now own a record of **34-30-5**; the games and wins are the most in any state other than Colorado ... CU is now 1-2 for the sixth time in Big 12 play (but has never had an 0-3 start) ... Inexplicably, CU is **3-11** in the second Big 12 road game of the year, including 10 straight losses ... **First Career CU Action: ILB Brandon Gouin** (kickoff return unit), **TE Luke Walters** (FG/PAT unit)... **QB Cody Hawkins** appeared late in the first half due to his familiarity with the two-minute drill (CU was 4-for-5 this year in the drill behind Hawkins prior to today) ... **Second Quarter Blues:** CU had three turnovers in the period, now with seven on the season; the Buffs committed 13 of 24 turnovers last year in the second stanza ... This was the ninth straight year the Buffs have played both Sunflower State schools back-to-back weeks: CU swept four encounters, the Kansas schools swept twice and there have been three splits ... Colorado ran the last eight plays of its first drive in plus territory and the last 10 of the game in the zone, but did not reach or cross the 50 in the 45 plays in-between ... Colorado is now **59-29-3** on artificial turf dating back to the

1989 season but is 0-4 on the fake stuff in 2009 ... **TB Rodney Stewart** is now 8-of-8 in his career on 3rd-&-1 carries (3-of-3 this season) ... **PK Aric Goodman** had made 26 straight PAT kicks prior to his first quarter miss; he is 49-of-51 in his CU career (his other miss was when Iowa State blocked his first try last November in a 28-24 CU win) ... The 6 points by CU was its fewest against Kansas State since a 38-6 loss in Manhattan in 1984 ... The last two games in the series have produced just 53 points (CU won 14-13 last year); that's the fewest over any two-game span in the series since 1965-66, when CU posted back to back shutouts (36-0 and 10-0) for 46 total points ... CU's 60 yards rushing was a low against the Wildcats since 1999, when the Buffs had 25 tries for 10 yards (as was its 244 yards of total offense; CU had 214 that year) ... It was the first time K-State held CU to zero touchdown passes since a 12-0 Buff win in Boulder in 1996.

**ROAD WOES** Colorado is **2-17** on the road in three-plus seasons under Dan Hawkins, though over the last 22 seasons, CU stills owns the 13th best road record in the nation (**59-47-1**; 56.1), though the recent woes have eight teams now on CU's heels. Colorado's last road win was at on Oct. 27, 2007 at Texas Tech (31-26); the Buffs have dropped 10 straight road games since, including against Florida State in Jacksonville last year but not including the '07 Independence Bowl against Alabama or the 2008 CU-CSU game in Denver. If including the latter, CU has dropped nine straight away from Folsom Field.

**TODAY'S PUNCH VS. PUNCH** Kansas State won this one with two kickoff returns for 71 yards; starting at its own 31 and 41 after CU's two kickoffs, it was the first time an opponent started a drive after a kickoff at or beyond the 40 and just the third time beyond the 30. *Colorado came in ranked fourth in the nation in kickoff return defense, allowing 16.6 yards per return; Kansas State is ranked seventh in the nation in kickoff return average, with a 27.9 average for 30 returns.* By contrast, CU has started just 2 of 37 drives inside their own 25 prior to today, but did so three out of five times this afternoon.

**WR SCOTTY McKNIGHT (6-61, 0 TD)** He extended his school record for the most consecutive games catching at least one pass to 31 games (32 including postseason; CU doesn't count bowls in school records). With six receptions today, he moved past Charles E. Johnson (1990-93; 127) into sixth place with 130, and the 61 yards enabled him to vault past Monte Huber (1967-69; 1,436) into eighth place all-time in receiving yards with 1,437.

• K-State improved its Big 12 record to 3-1 and it is the first time since the 2000 season that K-State held a 3-1 mark in Big 12 play (K-State finished 6-2 in the Big 12 in 2000)... The Wildcats are now 4-0 at Bill Snyder Family Stadium this season and own a five-game home field winning streak... Since 1990 the Wildcats are 105-23-1 (.814), including a 51-17-1 (.739) mark in league action... Head coach Bill Snyder's career record now stands at 141-71-1 (.662)... K-State is now 30-59-5 (.319) in Homecoming games and have won three of the last four.

• K-State is 43-24 (.642) against schools from the Big 12 North... Kansas State is now 20-44-1 (.308) against Colorado and under head coach Bill Snyder the Wildcats are 6-11-1 (.333)... Since the 1996 season and under Bill Snyder, the Wildcats are 27-19 (.587) in games played in the month of October... Since 1990, the Wildcats are 122-22 (.847) when scoring first and are 137-5 (.965) when leading at the half.

• Kansas State surrendered just six points to Colorado on Saturday... This was the lowest point total allowed by the K-State defense since Aug. 30, 2008 against North Texas... This was the lowest point total allowed to a Big 12 opponent since Oct. 8, 2005 against Kansas, a 12-3 K-State win.

• Kansas State finished the afternoon with a time of possession of 34:17... This is the seventh time this season K-State has held the edge in time of possession this season, and own a record of 5-2 in those games.

• The Wildcats held Colorado to 244 yards of total offense on Saturday... K-State neutralized the Colorado rushing attack by allowing just 60 rushing yards... This season, K-State's defense has held opponents to an average of 246.8 yards of total offense in games played at Bill Snyder Family Stadium... The Wildcats are allowing opponents an average of 34.5 rushing yards this season at home.

• With Josh Cherry's 24-yard field goal in the first quarter, Kansas State extended its scoring streak to 160 consecutive games... The streak is the 10th longest in the nation and the second longest in the Big 12 behind Nebraska's 170-game streak... This is the fourth time this season K-State has scored on its opening drive (three touchdowns and one field goal).

• Running back Daniel Thomas rushed 20 times for a career-high 145 yards and a touchdown... His nine rushing touchdowns this season are the most by a K-State running back since James Johnson rushed for 12 touchdowns in the 2007 season... This was the first time since Sept. 26 against Tennessee Tech that Thomas surpassed the 100-yard barrier... Combined with the 21 yards rushing by Keithen Valentine, K-State's top two running backs have now rushed for 1,161 yards on 211 carries (5.5 yards/carry).

• Wide receiver Brandon Banks caught three passes for 14 yards, returned three punts for 10 yards and one kickoff for 41 yards, to finish with 80 all-purpose yards... Banks is the 11th player in school history to surpass the 3,000-yard barrier for all-purpose yards and currently ranks ninth in school history... Banks improved his school record total for kick return yardage on Saturday to 758 yards on 24 returns (31.6 yards/return)... Banks improved his career receiving yardage total to 1,417 and currently ranks 15th in school history.

• Senior tight end Jeron Mastrud caught one pass for 11 yards... It marked the 24th straight game Mastrud has caught a pass, which is the third-longest streak by a Wildcat since 1990, but the longest by a tight end... Mastrud now has 1,193 career receiving yards and remains second for receiving yards by a tight end in school history... Mastrud now has 102 career receptions and ranks 10th in school history for career receptions and needs four receptions to tie Quincy Morgan (1999-00; 106 receptions) for ninth.

• Grant Gregory made his fourth straight start and the fourth of his career on Saturday... Gregory finished the contest 9-of-18 for 80 yards... Gregory also tallied 11 rushes for 27 yards and a touchdown... Gregory has now rushed for three touchdowns this season... Gregory's passing yard total of 80 yards was the lowest by a K-State quarterback in a victory since Sept. 18, 2004 against Louisiana-Lafayette, when Dylan Meier finished with 52 yards on 7-of-10 passing.

• Ulla Pomele recovered a fumble by Colorado QB Tyler Hansen with 12:48 to play in the second quarter... Corey Adams recovered the second Colorado fumble with 3:35 to play in the second quarter on a muffed punt by Jason Espinoza... Both fumble recoveries came inside the Colorado 20 and resulted in 10 points for the Wildcats... This season, Kansas State owns a turnover differential of +10 over its opponents.

• Pomele finished the day with a team-leading seven tackles, five solo stops including his first sack of the season.

• Sophomore defensive back Emmanuel Lamur picked off his first two passes as a Wildcat on Saturday... The Wildcats have intercepted its opponents 11 times this season, compared to just four interceptions last season after eight games... When K-State records an interception this season, the Wildcats are 4-3... Lamur finished with five total tackles, four solo.

• Senior defensive lineman Jeffrey Fitzgerald finished Saturday's contest with three tackles, including two solo stops... Fitzgerald carded 1.5 sacks on the day and bumped his season total to six.

• Josh Cherry converted a 24-yard field goal for K-State's first points on the day... Cherry later made a 27-yard FG with 11:24 to play in the second quarter... Cherry is now 3-of-5 on field goal attempts at Bill Snyder Family Stadium... Cherry has now converted his last four field goal attempts and is perfect on his attempts in Big 12 action.
