Oklahoma State head coach Mike Gundy

On team's effort

"That's quite an effort by our team. We made a number of mistakes tonight. We had three fumbles and the interception. It was really a good team effort. We showed a lot of heart tonight in coming back. Obviously, the first half wasn't very good."

On Alex Cate's first-half struggles

"I know there will be some talk about Alex Cate not playing real well. And he really didn't play that well, he understands that. He had some situations that didn't go his way. He's very much part of this team, and he's worked very hard. He deserved the right, and he had an opportunity to play. He's been in this program a number of years, and we felt like he was next in line so he's who we went with. That falls on me."

On switching to Brandon Weeden

"At halftime, we felt like we needed a spark, so we made the change and put Brandon in. Brandon made some nice plays for us. He put us in position and gave us a chance to win the game, which we did."

On coming out flat

"Perrish Cox had the big return to start the game. From that point on, not only in special teams, but in all three phases, we were pretty flat for about two quarters. I was a little concerned about that. Throughout the season in college football, it's difficult to get these guys to play at a high level so many weeks in a row. That's our job as coaches. We have to do a better job of getting them ready to play."

On Brandon Weeden's performance

"He did play well. Surprised may be the right word. He's shown signs of that, but he just hasn't been out there enough. The last time he was out there was against Grambling, and the game was somewhat put away. You're not really sure how a young man is going to react. He performed pretty well tonight. He ran around and made a couple plays when protection broke down. Obviously, he gave us a chance to win the game."

Oklahoma State linebacker Patrick Lavine

On the defense

"It's a good feeling because we've made a difference since I first came in. Now Coach Gundy will tell us we're going for it on fourth down, and that shows how much confidence he has in us. We have come a long ways, and we'll continue to get better."

On the Cowboys' offense

"It's just one of those games. We're a team, and we're going to have days like this. The defense is going to be down, and they're going to have to put more points on the board. It just worked out for us, and we stepped up and played big."

"We try to go out there and play like the offense is going to have the best game every night. That's how we look at it. We have faith in them just like they have faith in us. As long as one of us is doing well, we're going to be able to win the game."

Oklahoma State safety Markelle Martin

On the Bedlam game

"It's a fun atmosphere with the fans. You feed off the fans and it's just one of those things you just can't wait because you know it's going to be exciting."

Oklahoma State wide receiver Justin Blackmon

On a possible BCS berth for OSU

"We hear about the chance (of a BCS berth), but we try not to listen to it. We try to take it a game at a time. You can't overlook anybody or else you're going to get beat."

On the game against Colorado

"Very glad this game is over and excited to get a little break this weekend."

Colorado head coach Dan Hawkins

On if the defense got tired

"No. They're a good football team so I thought our guys battled and scrapped, and I'm really, really proud of them. They are very electric on offense and have a lot of skill players, and it's tough to keep a group like that bottled up the entire time. But they battled. They did a good job."

On if he knew much about Oklahoma State's Brandon Weeden

"No, not really. You see those guys a few snaps here or there."

On Colorado's kickoff return for a touchdown

"Well those guys have been doing a great job. Those guys up front have been doing a great job all year, and B-Lock's (Brian Lockridge) got speed so they did a nice job. That was a huge, huge momentum shift in the game so it was nice to see because they've done a nice job all year."

On having a good start on the road and the future of Colorado

"They were better, yeah. I think that was a lot of it. I love these dudes. They bring it every day, they do. They believe, and they keep fighting and keep learning. These guys are going to be a good football team. They're going to be good."

On what he told his team

"I tell them, 'Hey that was great effort. Could you have a play here or there and would you love to win that football game? Sure you would.' Those guys shouldn't hang their heads. They battled, and they brought it like a good football team's supposed to and they did everything they're supposed to do. We came up on the short end. They feel bad. They do, but I love those

guys and I love their effort and I love their intensity and I loved the way they competed. They did everything right. They've got nothing to hang their head about that way."

On Alex Cate and when Brandon Weeden completed a pass and the Oklahoma State offense improved

"We've talked about that before. This game's so funny. Mike (Gundy) and I talked before the game. You get a little momentum. That's all it is. You get a little wind underneath your wings and you get a little confidence, you get going, a guy makes a play. Had Alex (Cate) made a play in there, in might have been different."

On if he thought about sticking with Cody Hawkins when he was playing well

"Totally. You're always thinking about that. You are, but Tyler came in and made a nice throw, and Markques made a nice catch."

Colorado quarterback Tyler Hansen

On how frustrating it is to getting so close to almost beating the #12 team on national television

"It's real frustrating. We were so confident in the first half and third quarter, we played real well tonight. It's real disappointing we were that close."

On why the team isn't making the plays necessary to finish games

"Some of it is experience, some of it is people doubting themselves because of what has happened in the past. It just comes with getting experience - the more we play, the more plays we'll make."

On going for it on 4th-and-2 instead of kicking the game-tying field goal in the fourth quarter

"We all knew as a team if we got that fourth down, we were going to score and seal the game. There was no hesitation, we were going for it. I was going to the sideline saying we're going for it. It didn't work out that way, but we still had confidence in our defense to make a stop. But if we had made that fourth down we would have won the game."

On if he knows that the team is playing for their coach's job

"We don't look at it that way. We always hear that Coach Hawkins is solid right now and his job is pretty certain, and he's going to be here. We're playing for ourselves and for the team and for some pride right now."

Colorado running back Brian Lockridge

On the sideline being more excited than it has been in recent games

"Even though we're not getting the wins, we still have plenty of pride. We're trying to stride off of it, even though we're still losing games, we have pride. We still want to go out there and perform at a high level. We want to do our best and play and win."

On his kickoff return for a touchdown in the fourth quarter

“I had some great blockers, I just ran as fast as I can and made a play on the kicker. I owed one to the team and it was a pivotal time in the game, and that’s what we needed in a response to their score. I was grateful to give the team a score, but it didn’t end quite the way we wanted it to.”



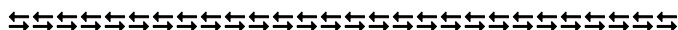

Beatty**, who was scratched from the travel squad Wednesday afternoon (concussion); **ILB Jeff Smart** traveled but did not play (pinched nerve); **Shaun Mohler** started in his place, his second start of the year (also started the opener versus CSU) ... **DE Conrad Obi**, who has been playing on the FG/PAT Defense unit, recorded the first block of his career (FG) and CU's fourth of the season ... Colorado did not have a sack for the first game this season ... At one point, OSU had run 23 plays for 53 yards in CU territory, but its next three after that all went for touchdowns (45, 47 and 28 yards) ... **P Matt DiLallo** had 10 punts in the game, his and the team's most since punting 11 times at Missouri in 2007.

QB SWITCH Cody Hawkins filled in for Tyler Hansen for three drives in the first half while Hansen had his hand X-rayed (negative). Hawkins led the Buffs to a fifth score in the seven times he has engineered the 2-minute drill this season, leading CU to a late first half TD.

THREE & OUTS Colorado came into the games among the national leaders in forcing "three-and-outs," when the opponent is held to three plays then punting (or less if forcing a turnover or if stopped on fourth down without earning a first). The Buff defense forced six more today, upping the season total to 50 through 11 games (CU entered tied for 14th in the nation).

WR MARKQUES SIMAS (11-90-1 TD) tied two school records tonight: the 11 receptions for the most in a single game, and catching at least seven passes in three consecutive games. He missed by 10 yards (actually 8 with correct spots by the stat crew) of a third straight 100-yard game.

Oklahoma State Post-Game Notes vs. Colorado

Nov. 19, 2009 - Boone Pickens Stadium

:: Fifth-year head coach Mike Gundy is now 36-25 in his career and 2-1 all-time against Colorado.

:: OSU is now 19-26-1 in the all-time series against Colorado.

:: In improving to 9-2 on the season, OSU reached the nine-win mark for the ninth time in school history.

:: Gundy becomes just the second coach in OSU history to lead multiple teams to nine wins. The Cowboys were 9-4 under Gundy in 2008. Pat Jones guided OSU to 10-2 campaigns in 1984, 1987 and 1988.

:: Serving as Oklahoma State captains for tonight's game were linebacker Patrick Lavine, cornerback Perrish Cox and offensive lineman Andrew Mitchell.

:: OSU wore all black uniforms (pants, jerseys) in a game for the first time since the 1994 season.

:: Senior Perrish Cox's 67-yard punt return for a touchdown in the opening quarter was the second punt return touchdown of his career (the other was in 2007) and his sixth career kick return for a touchdown.

:: Junior quarterback Alex Cate and freshman wide receiver Tracy Moore became the 19th and 20th different Cowboys to start a game on the offensive side of the ball for OSU this season. It was the first-career start for both players.

:: Senior running back Keith Toston became the 13th different Cowboy to top 1,000 rushing yards in a season. He has 1,130 yards rushing on the year.

:: OSU has now had a 1,000-yard rusher 18 times in its history.

:: The Cowboys have now had a 1,000-yard rusher in three-straight seasons for just the second time in school history. Preceding Toston were Kendall Hunter (1,555 yards in 2008) and Dantrell Savage (1,272 in 2007). Prior to that trio, OSU had three consecutive 1,000-yard rushers in 2002-03-04 (Tatum Bell in '02 and '03, Vernand Morency in '04).

:: With 172 yards on the ground against Colorado, Toston also notched his fourth 100-yard rushing game of the season and the seventh of his career.

:: Adding even more to Toston's accomplishments, he moved into the top 10 on OSU's career rushing chart and into the top five on the school's rushing touchdown list. He now has 2,637 career rushing yards (10th) and 27 rushing touchdowns (tied for fifth).

:: Junior kicker Dan Bailey moved into ninth place on OSU's all-time scoring list. He now has 220 points in his career.

:: Colorado's block of Bailey's 53-yard field goal attempt in the second quarter was the first field goal OSU has had blocked since Oct. 29, 2005 against Texas.

:: Senior linebacker Donald Booker led OSU with nine tackles, bringing his team-leading total to 80.

:: OSU recorded a season-high five quarterback sacks against the Buffs. The Cowboys' previous high was four, which came against Texas A&M on Oct. 10.

:: Senior linebackers Andre Sexton and Patrick Lavine continued to move up OSU's career tackles list. Lavine had eight against CU, bringing his total to 288 (16th). Sexton added three to his total, and his 304 stops rank 12th in school history.
