Employment




- ❑ SAs are permitted to work during the academic year, vacation periods, & summer.
- ❑ Must be paid the “going-rate” for work actually performed
- ❑ Must fill out an employment form BEFORE they start working... (this is available online!)
- ❑ Jobs obtained by assistance from Athletics Staff must be monitored closely.

Employment, cont.





- Fee-for-lesson: ok in non-institutional facilities, paid for by recipient or guardian (not YMCA, MHH, etc.), no playing lessons.
