



CU settles for share of 3rd in opener

FORT COLLINS — The University of Colorado women's golf team slipped one spot to finish third at the season-opening Ptarmigan Ram Fall Classic on Tuesday.

California held on to win with a three-round total of 868, followed by Washington State at 887. Colorado, the defending champion, finished with 891 to tie Brigham Young for third.

Sophomore Dominique Pytlewski shot a 1-under-par 71 to jump from 10th place to fifth in the final standings, four strokes off the winning pace of 214 shot by Cal's Shannon Yocum.

Julie Kim added a sixth place finish for CU with a 219.

The Buffs play in the Ron Moore Denver Invitational in Highlands Ranch Sept. 17-18.
