QUICKLY...The University of Colorado (8-10, 1-6 Big 12 Conference) will travel to Ames, Iowa to face No. 19 Iowa State University (15-2, 5-1 Big 12) on Wednesday, Feb. 2, at 6 p.m. in the James H. Hilton Coliseum.

BUFFS ON THE AIR...Wednesday's game at Iowa State will be broadcast live on AM 1190, due to a conflict with the men's game which will air on AM 760. **Tim Smile** will handle play by play duties and is joined by USA Basketball's **Carol Callan** with the color commentary.

31ST SEASON...Colorado is in its 31st season of varsity women's basketball sporting an all-time record of 585-322 (.645). The Buffaloes have made 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, all since 1988, including six Sweet 16 appearances and three trips to the Elite Eight (1993, 1995 & 2002).

LEAGUE SEASON WELL UNDERWAY...After a much needed road win at Missouri last week, Colorado has lost three games in a row for the third time this season and second time in conference play. Colorado is 1-6 in the current league standings and is tied with Oklahoma State for 10th place, one-half game ahead of Missouri who is 1-7. Sophomore forward **Anna Nedovic** leads a balanced CU scoring attack at 10.4 points per contest. Nedovic, who also posts a team-high 7.2 rebounds per game, is one of six Buffs averaging at least six points per game. Senior point guard **Veronica Johns-Richardson** is averaging 10.3 points per contest and paces the Buffaloes in 3-point field goals (22), steals (37) and assists (53). The freshman duo of forward **Jackie McFarland** and center **Kara Richards** have nearly identical outputs, combining for 19.2 points and 11.9 rebounds per game. Richards, who has started all 18 games, is averaging 9.4 points and 5.5 rebounds a contest. McFarland, a two-time Big 12 Rookie of the Week, leads the Buffs in field-goal percentage (.492, 64x130) and is averaging 9.8 points and 6.4 rebounds per game. On the outside, sophomore **Jasmina Ilic** averages 9.5 points per game while junior **Whitney Law** is sixth on the squad in the scoring column at 6.3 points an outing.

BUFFS FALL SHORT IN BID TO UPSET KANSAS STATE...Jasmina Ilic and Veronica Johns-Richardson both scored over 20 points but it was not enough as No. 16 Kansas State defeated Colorado 81-70 on Saturday at the Coors Event Center.

Ilic led Colorado (8-10, 1-6) with a career-high 21 points and Johns-Richardson had 20. The Buffs played in front of a season-high 3,680 fans.

"We prepared well all week and were ready for what they were doing offensively. Our fan support makes a huge difference for us. It means a lot for us and makes a difference in how we play," said Colorado Head Coach Ceal Barry.

Kendra Wecker had 28 points and 10 rebounds and Claire Coggins added a career-high 25 points to lead the Wildcats.

Wecker, the Big 12 Conference's leading scorer, had 21 second-half points and finished 11-of-19 from the field. Coggins had five 3-pointers for Kansas State (16-3, 7-1 Big 12), winners of seven straight. The Wildcats finished 11 of 24 from beyond the arc.

Kansas State never trailed in the second half, but its lead dwindled to 53-51 on a basket by Jackie McFarland midway through the half. Colorado had a chance to tie it, but Sarah Lini missed both free throws and Kansas State went on an 11-0 run. Coggins made two 3-pointers in the spurt to push the lead to 64-51.

"At 53-51, we needed to come out of the timeout, make the free throws and take advantage of the opportunity," Barry said.

McFarland had three points in a 6-0 run that got Colorado within 64-57 with 5:22 left, but Wecker, who averages 21 points per game, made a putback and 3-pointer. Coggins had a three-point play and Wecker added four points in the final 3:27.

Kansas State started slowly, committing five turnovers in the first 7 minutes. The Wildcats fell behind 31-23 on Ilic's 3-pointer, which capped a 7-0 Buffalo run.

Chelsea Domenico and Coggins then added 3-pointers to help Kansas State to a 37-34 halftime lead.

Colorado's McFarland came out on top of the battle between her and her sister, Jessica, with 11 points, seven rebounds and two blocked shots. Jessica McFarland finished the game with four points and seven rebounds.

BUFFS TO FACE A TOUGH IOWA STATE TEAM...Iowa State bounced back from a loss to Kansas State early in the week to beat Oklahoma in Norman, 74-52, on Saturday. The victory was Iowa State's sixth Big 12 win of the season and third on the road. The Cyclones are currently in second place in the Big 12, a half game back of both Kansas State and Texas Tech. Iowa State is lead by senior guard Anne O'Neil who averages 17.2 points, good enough for a third place tie in the Big 12, and 6.8 rebounds per game. O'Neil also leads the team in steals (29) and has three double-doubles this season. Senior forward Katie Robinette is second on the squad in scoring (14.6 ppg) and owns a team-high 27 blocks. Iowa State has a total of four ladies who average more than 10 points per game, O'Neil, Robinette, Mary Fox and Megan Ronhovde. Lyndsey Medders, a sophomore guard, has recorded 101 assists so far this season.

COLORADO-IOWA STATE SERIES...This will be the 53rd meeting overall and second of the season between Colorado and Iowa State with the Buffaloes holding a commanding 35-17 advantage. The 35 wins over the Cyclones are the second most CU has over any one opponent (37 against Nebraska). Colorado has won three of the last five contests. Iowa State's win on Jan. 8 was its first since the quarterfinals of the 2002 Big 12 Tournament when they defeated the Buffs 58-56. Seven of ISU's 17 series wins were between the 1998-2001 seasons. Prior to those seven wins the Buffs had defeated the Cyclones 16 times in a row.

LAST TIME AGAINST IOWA STATE...The Colorado women's basketball team hung tough with Iowa State, but it wasn't enough as the Cyclones, led by senior guard Anne O'Neil, defeated the Buffaloes 76-64 Saturday evening at the Coors Events Center in Boulder.

Freshman center Kara Richards had a game-high 24 points for the Buffs (7-6, 0-2 Big 12), but she represented the only Colorado player with double-digits in the scoring column. Her scoring output matched her career-high.

The first half was a tight match until Iowa State (12-1, 2-0 Big 12) started to pull away in the last five minutes to take a 42-33 halftime lead. The Cyclones began the second half with an 8-2 run and opened their lead to 16 points when sophomore guard Megan Ronhovde knocked down a three-pointer from the right side.

The Buffs responded with a run of their own, as Richards converted a three-point play, igniting the home crowd of 2,063 and pulling Colorado within six points with 13:21 remaining in the second half. With 3:59 left in the game, senior guard Veronica Johns-Richardson made a three-pointer to pull the Buffs within four points. But that was the closest they would get, as Iowa State responded with every attempt Colorado made to pull even.

"Every time we got within striking distance Iowa State kept their composure and made big shots," Colorado head coach Ceal Barry said. "They did a good job of not rolling over as we made our run." Johns-Richardson had nine points, five rebounds and four assists. Anna Nedovic had six points and a team-high nine rebounds.

The Buffs played some of their best basketball of the season, even though it came in defeat. Iowa State came into the game on the heels of a 78-59 upset over No. 20 Kansas State on Wednesday. "For 40 minutes we competed against a very good team," Barry said. "We definitely had our chances."

FABULOUS IN FEBRUARY...Colorado is 147-91 (.618) all-time in games played in the month of February. On games played Feb. 2 the Buffs are just 2-1 with the last game being a loss, 71-52, at Missouri in 2003.

VJ FROM DOWNTOWN...Senior Veronica Johns-Richardson has taken sole possession of 10th place on Colorado's career 3-point field-goals made list. She passed Emily Waner by hitting her 52nd career 3 against Kansas State on Jan. 29. She has a team-leading 22 trey's already this season, helped by a school-record tying seven against Northern Colorado on Dec. 29. Johns-Richardson is currently seventh in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage this season at .407.

WORKING OVERTIME...Colorado's 76-70 overtime loss to Oklahoma State was its second extra session this season marking the ninth time the Buffaloes have played multiple games in overtime in any one season. Colorado has had three overtime games in one season on three different occasions, the last coming during the 1995-96 season which was also the last season CU had multiple overtime games. The loss also snapped Colorado's four-game winning streak in overtime games. Seven of CU's last eight overtime games have come on the road including a 76-74 win at Washington this past December. Overall the Buffaloes are 16-16 in overtime games.

A RARE DROUGHT FROM THREE...Colorado was 0-for-8 from the 3-point arc in its win over Missouri marking the first time in 76 games the Buffs have gone without a 3-point field goal. The last time CU was shut out from downtown was during its 94-60 loss to Oklahoma in the 2002 NCAA Elite Eight (Mar. 25, 2002). Colorado was near matching its school record streak of 78 games set from Jan. 22, 2000 to Mar. 23, 2002.

LOSING STREAKS DON'T NECESSARILY MEAN LOSING SEASONS...Colorado started 0-3 in the Big 12 Conference for the first time since the 2001-02 season. That year the Buffs lost their first three league games, but then won the next eight and finished 11-5 in league play en route to the Elite Eight. The Buffaloes also avoided their first four-game losing streak since a five-game winless stretch during the middle of the 1999-2000 Big 12 season. Colorado has started 0-3 on four previous occasions (1987-88, 1991-92, 1999-00, 2001-02), but rebounded to have a winning league record in all but one of those campaigns (1999-00). CU has never started any conference season 0-4.

AGAINST THE NATION'S BEST...Colorado's loss to Kansas State dropped the Buffaloes to 0-3 against ranked teams this season. Colorado has lost nine straight against teams ranked in the two major polls dating back to the 2004-05 campaign. The Buffs' last win over a ranked team came in the 2003-04 league opener at Baylor where CU took care of the No. 24 Bears 69-59 on Jan. 7. CU is 47-89 all-time against ranked opponents and has a 27-25 mark in Boulder. As of the most recent polls, Colorado has four remaining games against ranked teams.

BUFFS CONTINUE SUCCESS IN PRESEASON...With a five-game winning streak in December, Colorado clinched its fifth straight season with a record of .500 or better during the nonconference regular season schedule. The Buffs have only finished below .500 twice during the nonconference schedule in the Ceal Barry era going 5-6 in 1999-2000 and 4-9 in 1984-85.

COLORADO WELL REPRESENTED WITH BIG 12 ROOKIES OF THE WEEK...Colorado has been a popular choice in the voting for Big 12 Rookie of the Week this season. Of the eight weeks the award has been given, Colorado has been represented three times.

Forward Jackie McFarland has received the honor twice -- on Dec. 6 and Jan. 3. Center Kara Richards earned the award in the first week of the regular season, back on Nov. 22.

Most recently, McFarland was cited for her performance over the holiday break where she averaged 10.7 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.0 assists and connected on 68.4 percent of her field goals (13-of-19). McFarland had 16 points on a career-best 8-of-13 shooting against Washington, which included the game-winning layup with under two seconds left in overtime. McFarland made all three of her shots from the field and had five rebounds against Northern Colorado. She then recorded her second career double-double by scoring 10 points and recording a career-high 11 rebounds against Manhattan while adding four assists, two blocks and two steals.

In her first effort, McFarland led Colorado and established career-highs with 23 points and eight rebounds in

CU's five-point loss at Wyoming on Dec. 1. She hit 8-of-14 from the field (.571) and 7-of-8 from the line (.875) against the Cowgirls. She then registered her first career double-double with 19 points and a new career-best 10 rebounds against Creighton on Dec. 4. She hit 9-of-10 from the free-throw stripe and added two blocks, one steal and one assist. For the week McFarland averaged 21.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 1.0 bpg.

Richards averaged 13.5 points, three rebounds and 1.5 blocks in her first two collegiate games. The Graham, Texas, native scored 13 points and pulled down six rebounds in her first game, a Colorado win over Loyola Marymount. She was the first Buff freshman to start the season opener since Linda Lappe in 1998. Richards hit 7-of-10 from the floor for 14 points in CU's loss to Nevada.

FRESHMAN LEADERS IN THE BIG 12...Colorado's duo of **Kara Richards** and **Jackie McFarland** are featured prominently in the Big 12's freshman statistics. McFarland is second in scoring (9.8 ppg) and Richards is fourth (9.4 ppg) among all league freshman. McFarland is second in rebounding (6.4 rpg) while Richards is just behind in third (5.5 rpg). Richards is also ninth in field-goal percentage at .464 (minimum of 50 attempts) and fifth in blocks (0.94 bpg) and fifth in assists (1.44 apg). McFarland is seventh in field-goal percentage (.492), seventh in assists (1.29 apg) and sixth in blocked shots (0.94). Reserve guard **Yari Escalera** is fourth in assists (1.61 apg), seventh in steals (0.94 spg) and 11th in 3-point field-goal percentage (.261).

SOME STREAKS ENDING...Prior to the loss against Creighton, Colorado had won 10 straight games at home following a road loss. The three-game losing streak is also the program's first since the 2001-02 season (78-67 at No. 3 Oklahoma on Jan. 2, 70-68 vs. No. 21 Texas on Jan. 6, and 75-72 at No. 14 Kansas State on Jan. 9) and the losses to Wyoming and Creighton were CU's first back-to-back setbacks against unranked teams since the 2000-01 season (72-70 vs. CSU on Dec. 6 and 92-66 at Iowa on Dec. 10).

A BARRY GOOD MILESTONE...By coaching the Buffaloes against Loyola Marymount in the season opener, head coach **Ceal Barry** passed legendary track & field coach Frank Potts for the most events coaches in school history at 642. She already holds the CU record for wins in any sport (420) and has coached in more games (659) than any coach in school history.

HOWARD LEAVES THE BUFFALOES...Leslie Howard, a 5-10 sophomore forward from Salem, Mo., has left the CU basketball program for personal reasons. Howard played in the first four games of the season averaging 6.3 points and 3.5 rebounds per game including a career-high 14 points against Pennsylvania on Nov. 26. She played 24 games in a Colorado uniform averaging three points and just over one rebound per contest.

FOR OPENERS...Colorado improved to 26-5 all-time in season openers and has won 17 of its last 18. The Buffs are 19-3 under Ceal Barry in season-opening games and have won the last five. This season marked the first time since the 1999-2000 season the Buffs didn't open the season in Boulder (at Denver) and the first time since 1996-97 (at BYU) the Buffs didn't begin the season in the state of Colorado.

SECOND AT COORS...Colorado placed second at the 18th annual Coors Classic, Nov. 26-27, at the Coors Events Center. The Buffaloes took care of business with a 69-49 win over Pennsylvania in the first round, but fell to then No 2 ranked, and now top-ranked, LSU 75-44. Freshman **Kara Richards** was awarded All-Tournament team honors after achieving career-highs with 11 rebounds and six assists against Penn and 10 rebounds, three steals and two blocks against the Tigers. Leslie Howard scored a career-high 14 points against Penn while **Anna Nedovic** and **Whitney Law** each had 10. LSU held Colorado to a school record low 24 percent shooting in the championship game.

Preseason Player of the Year candidate Seimone Augustus took home tournament MVP honors.

PRESEASON TOURNAMENTS...Colorado is 86-31 all-time in preseason tournaments, including a solid 30-6 mark in the Coors Classic. The Buffaloes have won 23 of their last 29 preseason tournament games and went 5-1 last season winning the WBCA Classic and Coors Classic Tournament championships.

LIGHTS, CAMERA, BUFFS...The Colorado Athletic Department and Fox Sports Rocky Mountain have agreed to televise seven Buffs' women's basketball games this season. Add that to the three national Fox Sports Network games scheduled through a combination of Big 12 and Pac 10 Conference pacts, CU women's basketball is scheduled for a school-record 10 regular season television games this winter.

TOUGH SCHEDULE...Colorado's schedule is once again a tough one, with the Buffs facing nine teams that played in the 2004 NCAA tournament. The Big 12 offers one of the toughest schedules in the nation, as seven members played in the NCAA's a season ago, with Texas and Baylor making the Sweet 16. Colorado's Coors Classic alone featured three teams who played in the NCAA Tournament last season, Penn, LSU and Maryland.

HEAD COACH CEAL BARRY...Ceal Barry is in her 22nd season at Colorado, and 26th overall has a collegiate head coach. Barry's overall coaching record is 509-274 with the win total ranking 20th among active NCAA Division I coaches. At Colorado Barry has led the Buffaloes to a 426-232 record, including 13 20-win seasons and 12 trips to the NCAA Tournament.

As a head coach Barry is 28-19 against Kansas State.

BUFFS PICKED SEVENTH, SIXTH IN BIG 12 POLLS...Colorado was picked to finish seventh in the annual Big 12 Coaches Preseason poll while the media said the Buffaloes would finish sixth in their preseason poll. Texas was the overwhelming favorite in both polls. The Longhorns received 11 of 12 first place votes in the coaches poll (coaches aren't allowed to vote for their own teams) and 12 of 14 first place votes in the media poll. Colorado was picked fifth in both the 2003-04 and 2002-03 preseason polls only to achieve a higher standing by the end of the season. CU enjoyed a third-place finish last season and a fourth-place showing in 2002-03. The Buffs have not finished lower than fourth in the Big 12 standings since the 1999-2000 season.

NATIONAL POLLS...Colorado was not ranked in either of the major polls this week. Six of CU's 2004-05 opponents are in the current top 20. LSU is ranked second by the AP and first in the coaches poll while Baylor is ranked seventh in the AP poll and eighth by the coaches. In the coaches poll Texas Tech is 14th, Texas is 15th, Kansas State is 16th and Iowa State is 17th. In the AP poll, Texas Tech is 13th, Texas is 15th, Kansas State is 16th and Iowa State is 18th.

HOME SWEET HOME...The Buffs are 321-96 (.770) at home all-time, with an even more impressive record at the Coors Events/Conference Center, turning in a record of 288-75 (.793). Under head coach Ceal Barry the Buffs are 236-74 (.761) at the CECC. CU has turned in six undefeated seasons at home in 28 seasons, including three consecutive years from 1980-83. Most recently the Buffs were perfect at home in 1993-94 when they went 13-0 at the CECC, 27-5 overall. Colorado owns the seventh-longest home winning streak in NCAA history, going for 53-straight during the early 80s.

THE BUFFALO STAMPEDE...Coach Ceal Barry's television show airs on Fox Sports Rocky Mountain on Friday evenings at 7:30 p.m. Hosted by Sandy Williams, the show incorporates all of CU's athletic department and is filmed on location in and around Boulder and is produced by BuffVision, the partnership that brings us the fantastic video boards at Folsom Field.

UP NEXT...Colorado will continue Big 12 action on Saturday, Feb. 5, against Texas A&M at 11 a.m. MST in College Station, Texas.
