Ninth Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The ninth annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship takes place at Kansas City's Arrowhead Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 4, at 7 p.m. (CST) under the television cameras of ABC Sports. Tickets are on sale and can be purchased through Ticketmaster (1-800-676-5488), the Kansas City Chiefs' ticket office (816-931-3330), or online at www.Big12sports.com. Tickets are priced at \$80, \$75, \$68, and \$58 based on location. In the eight-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), OU (2000, 2002), Colorado (2001), and KSU (2003).

Bowl Games

Again this season the Big 12 has agreements with eight bowl games, including the BCS, to provide a participant. Last year saw the conference send eight teams into the postseason, marking the third consecutive year the league sent two-thirds of its teams to bowl games.

Division Races

South - Oklahoma is in the driver's seat in the South. The Sooners by virtue of their win over Texas own the tiebreaker over the Longhorns. Therefore, Oklahoma is the South representative in the Big 12 championship game if it wins one of its two remaining games (Nebraska, Baylor). Any combination of either an OU victory or UT loss in the final two games sends the Sooners to Kansas City. The only way Texas makes the championship game is by winning its two remaining contests, while Oklahoma loses both of its.

North - Five of the six North teams are still in the hunt for the Division title, with only Kansas eliminated. Following are the current standings and remaining games:

There are two possible scenarios for a North champion at 7-4 overall and 5-3 in the conference. If Iowa State wins its remaining games, the Cyclones claim the North crown, even if Nebraska wins its final two contests as ISU won the head-to-head matchup against the Huskers. Nebraska wins the division by winning its last two games, coupled with one Iowa State loss. However, Colorado (5-4/2-4) can also finish 7-4 overall, but 4-4 in the Big 12. Under this scenario, Colorado would win the North if Nebraska, Iowa State and Missouri each lost one of its remaining games as CU would be 2-0 in a NU/ISU "mini conference."

A multitude of possibilities exist if the divisional leaders finish at 6-5/4-4.

BAYLOR (3-6, 1-5)

This Week: at Oklahoma State
Next Week: Oklahoma

After not registering a turnover during a four-game stretch, the Baylor defense has forced four turnovers over the last two games.

The tandem of Maurice Land and Willie Andrews combined for 25 tackles against Texas Tech. Land tallied a game-high 13 stops, including 11 solo tackles, while Andrews registered 12 tackles, 10 of which were solo.

Daniel Sepulveda averaged 43.9 yards a punt vs. Texas Tech, with five of his seven punts forcing the Red Raiders to begin drives inside their 20-yard line.

The Tech game marked the first time this season the Baylor offense did not commit a turnover.



COLORADO (5-4, 2-4)

This Week: Kansas State
Next Week: Open

Dominique Brooks returned a fumble 41 yards for a touchdown against Kansas. Brooks tallied five tackles, including three solo stops.

Stephone Robinson's 48-yard punt return for touchdown with 12 seconds left in the third quarter put CU ahead for good at 24-21 in last week's victory at Kansas. Robinson totaled 98 return yards to earn Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week honors.

Colorado has been outgained by its opponent in four of its five victories. Only in the victory over North Texas did CU outgain its opponent in a winning effort.

The Buffs have scored in 192 consecutive games, the longest streak in the Big 12.



IOWA STATE (5-4, 3-3)

This Week: Open
Next Week: at Kansas State

Iowa State heads into an open date in the midst of a three-game Big 12 Conference win streak, its first since the 2002 campaign.

ISU clinches the Big 12 North Division with victories in its last two games (Kansas State, Missouri).

The Cyclones posted a season-high 466 yards of offense in their win over Nebraska, including a season-best 364 passing yards.

Todd Blythe hauled in a game-high eight passes for 188 yards in the win over Nebraska. Jon Davis added 103 yards on four catches.

ISU's defense has forced 12 turnovers over the last four games, after forcing six turnovers through the season's first five games.



KANSAS (3-6, 1-5)

This Week: Texas
Next Week: at Missouri

Charles Gordon leads the Big 12 with six interceptions. He added to his conference-leading total with a pair of INTs in last week's game against Colorado. His season total is the most by a KU player since 1951.

The Jayhawks forced four turnovers last week against Colorado, and held CU to 263 yards. KU has given up a combined 455 yards over the last two games.

Kansas is third in the Big 12 in rush defense, allowing 112 yards a game.

Nick Reid is second in the Big 12 with 89 tackles. He is also third in the conference in solo tackles (51).



KANSAS STATE (4-5, 2-4)

This Week: at Colorado
Next Week: Iowa State

Darren Sproles leads the NCAA in all-purpose yards with 190.9 per game. Sproles ranks as the all-time Big 12 leader with 6,463 all-purpose yards. He added to his total with 160 yards rushing in last week's win at Missouri. Sproles ranks fourth in the Big 12 in rushing with an average of 121.8 yards.

The 21-point come back by Kansas State in last week's 35-24 win at Missouri ties the largest deficit overcome in school history. It marked the third time in school history K-State came back from 21 points behind to win.

Brandon Archer registered his second career interception in the win at Missouri. Archer has returned both his picks for touchdowns.

The Missouri game marked the second time this season the Wildcats forced a season-high four turnovers.



MISSOURI (4-5, 2-4)

This Week: Open
Next Week: Kansas

Mizzou has yielded a total of 284 yards through the air over the last three games. Missouri leads the Big 12 and is third in the NCAA in pass defense, at 133 yards per game.

Damien Nash returned to the Missouri line up to rush for 118 yards in last week's game against Kansas State. Nash ranks sixth in the Big 12 with a 91-yard average.

Bard Smith ranks second all-time in the Big 12 with 9,111 career yards of total offense.

Missouri leads the Big 12 in total defense and is 11th nationally, allowing 288 yards a game.

The Tigers' 477 yards of offense against Kansas State was their highest total since the season opener (506 vs. Arkansas State).



NEBRASKA (5-4, 3-3)

This Week: at Oklahoma
Next Week: Open

Barrett Ruud leads the Big 12 with 105 total tackles and 55 solo stops. He is averaging 11.7 tackles per game.

Cory Ross has rushed for 320 yards and three touchdowns over the last two games. Ross ran for a game-high 126 yards against Iowa State last week after running for a career-high 194 yards the week prior vs. Missouri.

Nebraska ranks second in the Big 12 and ninth in the NCAA in rush defense, allowing 94.2 yards per game.

The Cornhuskers are 4-1 at home this season.



OKLAHOMA (9-0, 6-0)

This Week: Nebraska
Next Week: at Baylor

Adrian Peterson set an NCAA freshman record in last week's win at Texas A&M with his ninth straight 100-yard rushing game (101), breaking the record of New Mexico State's Ron James set in 1968. Peterson ranks fifth in the NCAA and third in the Big 12, averaging 152.6 rushing yards.

Oklahoma leads the Big 12 and ranks seventh nationally in rushing defense at 90.4 yards per game.

Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week Jason White tied the OU record he already shared with Josh Heupel with five touchdown passes in the Sooners win at Texas A&M. White has thrown 16 TD passes over the last four games, and leads the Big 12 with 25 on the season.



OKLAHOMA STATE (6-3, 3-3)

This Week: Baylor
Next Week: Open

Vernand Morency is third in the Big 12 and sixth in the NCAA in rushing with a 149.6-yard average. He has rushed for 100 yards or more in 11 of his last 13 games.

Donovan Woods threw for a career-high 224 yards against Texas. In addition to throwing for a TD, Woods also scored on a 1-yard run, marking the eighth time he has scored a rushing touchdown in the last nine games.

OSU is second in the Big 12 in rushing offense and eighth in the NCAA, averaging 246 yards.

Oklahoma State leads the Big 12 in red zone offense, scoring 92.3 percent of the time it penetrates the opposing 20-yard line.



TEXAS (8-1, 5-1)

This Week: at Kansas
Next Week: Open

Cedric Benson rushed for a game-high 141 yards and five touchdowns in Texas' come-from-behind win against Oklahoma State. Benson leads the Big 12 and is fourth in the nation with a 159.8-yard average.

Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week Derrick Johnson tallied a game-best 18 tackles, including 14 solo, in the win over Oklahoma State.

Texas has rushed for over 300 yards six times this season. The Longhorns lead the Big 12 and are second nationally in rushing offense at 306.7 yards a game.

UT overcame a 28-point deficit in its 56-35 win over Oklahoma State, its biggest comeback in school history.

Texas leads the Big 12 in scoring defense, allowing 15.8 ppg.



TEXAS A&M (6-3, 4-2)

This Week: Texas Tech
Next Week: Open

Texas A&M scored two special teams' touchdowns against Oklahoma with a fake punt and fake field goal attempt.

After committing one turnover through their first seven games, the Aggies have committed six turnovers in the last two.

Jaxson Appel tied for game-high honors with 12 tackles and three tackles for loss last week against Oklahoma.

The Aggies have posted over 400 yards of offense in eight of nine games. A&M ranks fourth in the Big 12, averaging 456.6 yards, and has a conference-leading 6.5 yards per play.

A&M is second in the Big 12 in passing offense at 265.8 yards per game.



TEXAS TECH (6-3, 4-2)

This Week: at Texas A&M
Next Week: Open

Texas Tech leads the nation in pass offense (411.2 ypg), is third in total offense (496.8 ypg), and seventh in scoring offense (37.0 ppg). The Red Raiders lead the Big 12 in all three categories.

The trio of Nehemiah Glover, Trey Haverty and Jarrett Hicks holds the Big 12's top three spots in receptions per game and receiving yards per game.

Sonny Cumbie leads the nation in total offense (390.4 ypg) and passing yards (405.2 ypg).

Tech has surpassed 500 yards of offense on five occasions this season. Twice (Texas, Oklahoma) the Red Raiders failed to post at least 400 yards.
