THE MATCH: Colorado will travel to play the Baylor Bears on Wednesday, Nov. 17, for a 6 p.m. MST match in Waco, Texas. The Buffaloes will then enjoy the second of two Big 12 Conference byes this weekend before finishing the regular season schedule next week.

ON THE SEASON: Colorado is 12-12 overall in 2004 and in sixth place in the Big 12 at 7-10, one-half game up on Kansas. The Buffaloes need to win their last three regular season matches to finish .500 in conference play. CU, coming off a string of three-straight losses against ranked teams, got back into the win column with a three-game home win over Oklahoma on Nov. 13. The Buffs will finish the regular season with three teams currently seventh place or lower in the conference standings. Colorado has lost seven of its nine matches, the first such streak since 1987, the program's second season of varsity status. Five of the seven losses in that stretch have come against teams ranked in the AVCA Top 25.

Junior right side hitter **Allie Griffin** leads the Buffaloes with 4.21 kills per game which ranks fifth in the Big 12. She is also second on the squad in digs (2.45 dp) and blocks (0.94 bpg). Colorado has been without a major part of its offensive punch as junior outside hitter **Maragda Santillana** has missed the last five matches, and is out indefinitely, with a rotator cuff injury to her right shoulder. Santillana was averaging 4.17 kills per game which still ranks sixth in the Big 12. In her place sophomore **Amber Nu'u** has filled in nicely averaging nearly three kills per game over her last five starts. Freshman **Amber Sutherland** has also seen her playing time increase with the loss of Santillana. Sutherland, who played in just four of the season's first 20 matches, has 10 kills over her past three outings including six at Texas A&M.

Sophomore **Ashley Nu'u** runs the Buffs' offense at setter averaging 12.13 assists per game. She is currently sixth on the school's all-time assists (1,364) and needs just five assists to become the 15th setter in team history with 1,000 assists in a season. Senior setter **Allison Barnes** has played more of a defensive role in 2004, but is still second on the squad in assists (73) and is averaging 1.81 digs per game during the conference season.

Defensively, junior outside **Nicole Carr** continues to lead the Buffaloes in digs (2.65 dp). CU's active career leader in digs with 854, Carr also ranks third on the team in kills (2.43 kpg).

CU's middle blocker combination of sophomores **Lara Bossow** and **Austin Zimmerman** are combining for 3.43 kills and 2.04 blocks per game. Junior **Kelly Masumiya** and freshman **Therese Viñal** have been solid in the libero position averaging 1.18 and 2.07 digs per game respectively.

LAST TIME OUT: Twin sisters **Amber** and **Ashley Nu'u** each set career-highs and kills and hit a combined .615 to lead

Colorado to a 30-24, 30-13, 30-24 Big 12 Conference sweep of Oklahoma Saturday evening in front of a season-high 1,140 fans at the Coors Events Conference Center.

Colorado's win avenges a heart-breaking, five-game loss at Oklahoma back on Oct. 16.

Amber Nu'u finished with a match-high 17 kills, eclipsing her previous personal best of 16 kills set in the Buffs' last match, at Kansas State on Nov. 10. Nu'u, who has started the last five matches at outside hitter, also set a career-high with a .556 hitting percentage, recording her kills on just 27 attacks with only two errors.

Ashley, the younger Nu'u (by three minutes), had a career-high nine kills on just 12 attacks with no errors for a .750 percentage – the highest single-match total by a Buff this season (minimum of 10 attacks). The sophomore setter also had 42 assists, leaving her just five assists shy of the 1,000 mark for the season.

Colorado hit well as a whole team against the Sooners. The Buffs had 56 kills on 109 attacks with just 18 errors to hit .349, their highest since hitting .410 against Cal State-Northridge in the second match of the season. It was also the last time CU had hit at least .300 since the San Diego match (.306) on Sept. 10. Sophomore Austin Zimmerman joined the Nu'u twins in hitting above .500 with eight kills on 13 attacks with one error (.538).

Oklahoma was led by Joanna Schmitt's 13 kills. Julie Chester and Rachel Jackson each had seven digs.

Amber Nu'u had a career-high 16 kills but Kansas State offset her performance by hitting .326 as a team in a 30-21, 30-11, 27-30, 30-19 Big 12 win over the Buffaloes on Wednesday evening at Ahearn Field House.

Nu'u, making her fourth consecutive start in place of injured **Maragda Santillana**, hit .265 with a season-high 34 attacks and pitched in defensively with eight digs. Junior **Nicole Carr** registered her second-straight double-double with 10 kills and a team-high 14 digs.

Kansas State's Vali Hejjas had a match-high 17 kills and hit .412, notching just three errors on 34 attacks. Rita Lilom hit .545 (6k-0e-11att) and recorded seven blocks. The Wildcats, who also out-blocked the Buffaloes 16-3, had 58 kills with only 14 errors on 135 attacks.

Kansas State had just two attack errors in the first two games, hitting a whopping .467 (30k-2e-60att) on its way to a 2-0 lead. Colorado made a formidable comeback in the third frame, holding KSU to a .171 mark (15k-8e-41att), but the Buffaloes hit under .100 in two of the four games finishing at .142 (53k-3e1-155att).

Allie Griffin had 12 kills and three blocks for Colorado while Zimmerman had six kills and 10 digs.

CU IN THE RANKINGS: In the eighth RichKern.com/AVCA Division I Region rankings released on Nov. 16, the Buffaloes ranked seventh in the Central Region, down one spot from a week ago. The RichKern.com rankings mimic the NCAA RPI published at the end of the season. They are not associated with the official NCAA rankings, but are provide a ranking which uses a computerized formula similar to the NCAA.

Colorado did not receive any votes in the latest American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA)/USA Today/CSTV Top

25 poll released on Nov. 15. The Buffaloes were ranked No. 25 for two-straight weeks early in the season (Sept. 20-Oct. 3).

19TH SEASON: The 2004 season is the 19th for the Colorado volleyball program. Since debuting as a varsity program in the fall of 1986, the Buffs have an overall record of 358-219 including one conference title (Big Eight in 1993). CU has advanced to 13 NCAA Tournaments in 18 years, 12 of which have come since 1991. The Buffs are one of only 15 NCAA Division I programs with at least 12 NCAA appearances since 1991.

HEAD COACH PI'I AIU: Pi'i Aiu (*pronounced P-E I-U*) is in his eighth season as Colorado's head coach sporting a career record of 146-88. The 1997 Big 12 and District V Coach of the Year, Aiu has led the Buffs to six NCAA Tournaments in seven seasons, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 1997. Under his guidance, the Buffs have sported two All-Americans, eight All-Region, and 18 All-Big 12 performers. Aiu has been involved in the Colorado volleyball program

in some capacity since its inception in 1986.

Aiu, who has led the Buffs to a 96-61 record in Big 12 matches, is joined on the bench this season by fifth-year assistant **Jil Thomason** and first-year assistant **Erik Sullivan**.

As a head coach Aiu is 13-2 against Baylor.

ABOUT THE BEARS: Baylor is 12-16 overall and in ninth place in the Big 12 at 4-13, one game behind Texas Tech in the league standings. The Bears have just two wins in their last nine matches and the only Big 12 victory in that span came at home against last place Iowa State in four games on Nov. 6. The Bears have a balanced offensive attack with four players averaging between 2.47 and 3.10 kills per game. Sophomore middle Desiree Guilliard-Young, averaging 2.89 kills per game, tops the Bears and ranks eighth in the Big 12 in hitting percentage (.324) and also ranks eighth among league players in blocking with 1.33 per game. Adeline Meira is fourth in the Big 12 in blocking (1.60 bpg) and as a team the Bears rank third in the conference (3.08).

SERIES RECORDS: Colorado leads its series with Baylor by a commanding 16-2 margin. The Buffaloes have won the last eight in the series including a three-game win in Boulder on Sept. 25. The Bears' last win over Colorado came on Oct. 2000 in Boulder.

EXCUSED ABSENCE: First-year assistant coach Erik Sullivan missed all of fall preseason practice with the Buffs, but he had a pretty good excuse. He was a member of the U.S. National Volleyball team that competed in the 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens, Greece. The U.S team compiled an overall record of 4-4, advancing to Bronze Medal match. Sullivan, an eight-year veteran of the U.S. National Team, also participated in the 2000 Olympics in Sydney, Australia.

BUFFS AT HOME: Colorado calls the Coors Events/Conference Center home for the 17th straight season. The Buffs are 180-59 all time at the CECC for a winning percentage of .753. The Buffs are 19-7 at home in their last 26 matches with six of the seven losses coming to teams ranked in the AVCA Top 20 at the time.

BARNES, NU'U BOTH RANK AMONG ASSIST LEADERS: Allison Barnes resides in fifth place on CU's all-time assists list while Ashley Nu'u is now in sixth. Nu'u became the fifth CU player to reach 1,000 assists on the final play of the Buffs' 3-0 win over Kansas on Oct. 9.

BUFF BITS: CU hit over .400 as a team in its first two matches this year, marking the first time since 1988 that the Buffs hit .400 in back-to-back matches. In fact, CU had not hit .400 or above twice in the same season since 1994...Colorado overcame an 0-2 deficit to defeat San Diego in five games. The last time the Buffs overcame an 0-2 deficit to win was in Boulder on Oct. 31, 2001 against Baylor... Conversely, CU saw a 23 match winning streak when up 2-0 end with a five-game loss at Texas...Game five of that Texas match was 20-18, marking the highest game five score CU has been involved in since defeating Ball State 24-22 on Sept. 4, 1995 in Boulder...Against Denver, CU set a team record for hitting percentage in a four-game match with a .402 performance (71k-18e-132att). The old record was .394 against Wyoming in 1995...Colorado started the season 5-2 marking the 16th consecutive season that the Buffaloes have come out of the non-conference schedule with a record of .500 or above...CU won its fourth-straight Colorado Invitational title and took second place at the University of Oregon Classic

Sept. 3-4. **Allie Griffin** was named MVP of the Colorado Invitational and was joined by **Ashley Nu'u** and **Maragda Santillana** on the All-Tournament team. Nu'u and Griffin were also members of the Oregon Classic All-Tournament team.

CU PICKED SIXTH IN 2004 BIG 12 COACHES PRESEASON POLL: Colorado was picked to finish sixth in the annual Big 12 Conference preseason coaches poll released Aug. 9.

Six-time Big 12 champion Nebraska was the unanimous first place pick, receiving 100 points and all 10 first-place votes. 2003 Big 12 Champion Kansas State was second with 80 points followed by Texas, Texas A&M, Missouri and Colorado.

Last season, CU was picked seventh by the coaches in the preseason poll and eventually finished in a three-way tie for third place with Texas A&M and Kansas in the final league standings.

No Buffs were selected to the Big 12 Conference preseason team.
