Ninth Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The ninth annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship takes place at Kansas City's Arrowhead Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 4, at 7 p.m. (CST) under the television cameras of ABC Sports. Tickets are on sale and can be purchased through Ticketmaster (1-800-676-5488), the Kansas City Chiefs' ticket office (816-931-3330), or online at www.Big12sports.com. Tickets are priced at \$80, \$75, \$68, and \$58 based on location. In the eight-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), OU (2000, 2002), Colorado (2001), and KSU (2003).

Bowl Games

Again this season the Big 12 has agreements with eight bowl games, including the BCS, to provide a participant. Last year saw the conference send eight teams into the postseason, marking the third consecutive year the league sent two-thirds of its teams to bowl games.

Division Races

South - Oklahoma has clinched the South title. The Sooners will be making their fourth Big 12 Championship appearance in five seasons.

North - Iowa State and Colorado are in contention for the North title.

Iowa State wins if it beats Missouri; OR lose to Missouri and Nebraska beats Colorado.

Colorado wins if it beats Nebraska, AND Iowa State loses to Missouri.

Nebraska can finish 4-4 in the Big 12 and 6-5 overall with a win over Colorado. However, the Huskers can not win the division, as Iowa State holds the tie-breaker by virtue of its win over Nebraska.

All-Conference

The Big 12 will announce its all-conference teams and individual award winners as selected by the league's head coaches on Wednesday, December 1.

Media Teleconference

BCS coordinator and Big 12 commissioner Kevin Weiberg will participate in the Monday, November 29, Big 12 Football Coaches Media Teleconference. Weiberg will join the call at 12:00 p.m. CT. He will be available to discuss Big 12 football and the BCS Standings.

Bowl Eligibility

Heading into the final week of the regular season, the Big 12 has seven teams bowl eligible. The Big 12 has eight bowl slots in its post season lineup. Nebraska must win its final game to become the conference's eighth bowl team.

Rushing Leaders

Cedric Benson (Texas), Vernand Morency (Oklahoma State), and Adrian Peterson (Oklahoma) are among the top eight NCAA rushers.

BAYLOR (3-8, 1-7)

This Week: End of Season

Daniel Sepulveda became the first Baylor player to have at least 20 punts of 50 yards or longer in consecutive seasons. Sepulveda ranks third in the NCAA with a punting average of 46 yards, with a long of 69.

Maurice Lane closed the season by registering game-high tackle totals in each of the last three games. Lane combined for 43 tackles during the stretch, including 36 solo stops. His tackle totals over the last three games included 14 (11) against Oklahoma, 16 (14) at Oklahoma State, and 13 (11) vs. Texas Tech. Lane leads the Big 12 with 77 solo stops, and ranks third with 104 tackles.

The Texas Tech game marked the only time this season the Baylor offense did not commit a turnover.



COLORADO (6-4, 3-4)

This Week: at Nebraska (Friday)
Next Week: TBD

The Buffaloes can claim the Big 12 North Division with a win over Nebraska and an Iowa State loss. Both CU and ISU would finish at 4-4 in the Big 12, with the Buffs owning the tie-breaker by virtue of their 19-14 win over the Cyclones.

Mason Crosby has connected on five field goals from 50-plus yards, tying him for the most in the NCAA this season.

Colorado has been outgained by its opponent in four of its six victories. Against Kansas State and North Texas, CU outgained its opponent in a winning effort.

The Buffs have scored in 193 consecutive games, the longest streak in the Big 12.



IOWA STATE (6-4, 4-3)

This Week: Missouri
Next Week: TBD

Iowa State heads into its final game of the regular season in the midst of its first ever four-game Big 12 Conference win streak.

ISU clinches the Big 12 North Division with a victory over Missouri. It would mark the school's first title since 1912.

Stevie Hicks ran for a career-high 156 yards against Kansas State.

Iowa State is 4-1 at home this season.

ISU's defense has forced 16 turnovers over the last five games, after forcing six turnovers through the season's first five contests. During its four-game win streak the Cyclones are plus-11 on turnovers (13 takeaways vs. 2 turnovers).



KANSAS (4-7, 2-6)

This Week: End of Season

Charles Gordon leads the NCAA with seven interceptions. His season total is the most by a KU player since 1951.

Five of the Jayhawks' seven losses were by less than seven points, including four of six in Big 12 play.

Kansas recorded a Big 12-leading 19 interceptions. Sophomores Charles Gordon (7) and Rodney Harris (4) combined for 11 pick-offs.

The Kansas defense did not allow a first quarter touchdown all season. The Jayhawks allowed two field goals, a safety, and a defensive touchdown in outscoring their opponents 75-15 in the opening stanza.

Nick Reid is second in the Big 12 with 9.6 tackles per game.



KANSAS STATE (4-7, 2-6)

This Week: End of Season

Darren Sproles ranks as the all-time Big 12 leader with 6,812 all-purpose yards. Sproles leads the Big 12 and ranks third in the NCAA, averaging 187.9 all-purpose yards.

Over its last five games, Kansas State averaged 378.6 yards of offense.

The Wildcats committed at least one turnover in every game.

This season ended the Wildcats' streak of 11 consecutive bowl appearances.

Twice this season K-State forced a season-high four turnovers (Nebraska, Missouri).

K-State lost a Big 12-leading 15 fumbles, with 12 of them coming in conference play.



MISSOURI (4-6, 2-5)

This Week: at Iowa State
Next Week: End of Season

Mizzou leads the Big 12 and is third in the NCAA in pass defense, at 143.6 yards per game.

Missouri is the least penalized team in the Big 12. The Tigers have been flagged 42 times for 324 yards, an average of 32.4 per game.

MU has posted 1,061 yards of offense over the last three games.

Brad Smith ranks second all-time in the Big 12 with 9,332 career yards of total offense.

Missouri leads the Big 12 in total defense and is 13th nationally, allowing 296.6 yards a game.

The Tigers' five-game losing streak is their longest since a six-game skid in 1995.



NEBRASKA (5-5, 3-4)

This Week: Colorado (Nov. 26)
Next Week: TBD

Barrett Ruud leads the Big 12 with 116 total tackles and is second with 62 solo stops. He is averaging 11.6 tackles per game.

Cory Ross has rushed for 450 yards and three touchdowns over the last three games. Ross has posted 130- (Oklahoma), 126- (Iowa State), and 194-yard efforts (Missouri).

Nebraska leads the Big 12 and ranks eighth in the NCAA in rush defense, allowing 94.6 yards per game.

The Cornhuskers need a victory in their final game to increase their NCAA-record of 35 consecutive bowl appearances.



OKLAHOMA (11-0, 8-0)

This Week: Open
Next Week: Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship

Adrian Peterson ranks second in the Big 12 with a 151-yard rushing average. Peterson eclipsed the 200-yard rushing mark for the third time this season with a 240-yard effort at Baylor.

The OU defense is holding opponents to 94.6 yards rushing per game.

The Sooners have claimed their fourth Big 12 South Division title. All of OU's South titles have come in the last five seasons.

Jason White leads the Big 12 and is seventh nationally with a pass efficiency rating of 162.3. White set an OU record with 18 consecutive completions in the win over Nebraska. He has thrown 21 TD passes over the last six games, and leads the Big 12 with 30 on the season.



OKLAHOMA STATE (7-3, 4-3)

This Week: at Texas Tech
Next Game: Postseason Bowl

Seymore Shaw made his first start of the 2004 season in place of Vernard Morency, the NCAA's fifth-leading rusher, in the win over Baylor. Shaw ran for a career-high 172 yards and one touchdown.

Prentiss Elliott garnered Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week accolades for his performance against Baylor. Elliot returned a punt 74 yards for a touchdown, and totaled 131 yards on four returns.

OSU is second in the Big 12 in rushing offense and eighth in the NCAA, averaging 251.9 yards.

Oklahoma State leads the Big 12 in red zone offense, scoring 93.0 percent of the time it penetrates the opposing 20-yard line. The Cowboys have scored on 40-of-43 red zone trips, including 34 TDs.



TEXAS (9-1, 6-1)

This Week: Texas A&M (Nov. 26)
Next Game: Postseason Bowl

For the second time in as many seasons, Derrick Johnson is a finalist for the Butkus Award, given annually to the nation's top linebacker. Johnson is second in the Big 12 in tackles for loss (14.0), has caused an NCAA-leading six fumbles, and ranks fourth in the conference in tackles (86). He is a three-time Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week honoree this season.

The Longhorns lead the Big 12 and are second nationally in rushing offense at 305.2 yards a game.

UT has posted come-from-behind victories in its last two outings, scoring 14 points in the last five minutes for a 27-23 win at Kansas, and overcoming a 28-point deficit in its 56-35 win against Oklahoma State, its biggest comeback in school history.



TEXAS A&M (7-3, 5-2)

This Week: at Texas (Friday)
Next Game: Postseason Bowl

Texas A&M has played in a Big 12 single-season record three overtime games this year. Three of the Aggies' last four contests have required extra frames. All-time A&M is second in the Big 12 with eight overtime games since the 1996 season (4-4).

A&M is second in the Big 12 in passing offense at 264.6 yards per game.

Reggie McNeal accounted for 309 of the Aggies' 436 yards of offense in the overtime win against Texas Tech. McNeal ran for 55 yards, while throwing for 254 more.

The Aggies have posted over 400 yards of offense in nine of ten games. A&M ranks fourth in the Big 12, averaging 454.5 yards, and has a conference-leading 6.6 yards per play.



TEXAS TECH (6-4, 4-3)

This Week: Oklahoma State
Next Game: Postseason Bowl

Texas Tech leads the nation in pass offense (399.5 ypg), while leading the Big 12 and ranking sixth nationally in total offense (488.2 ypg).

The trio of Nehemiah Glover, Trey Haverty and Jarrett Hicks holds the Big 12's top three spots in receptions per game and receiving yards per game.

Taurean Henderson is on the verge of becoming the first player in Big 12 history to post 2,000 career rushing yards and 1,500 career passing yards. Henderson has surpassed the 2,000-yard rushing mark (2,249) and is 40 yards shy of 1,500 receiving yards (1,460).

Sonny Cumbie leads the nation in total offense (380.8 ypg) and passing yards (394.1 ypg).
