QUICKLY...The University of Colorado (5-4, 0-0 Big 12 Conference) returns home to host the University of Northern Colorado (2-8, Independent) on Wednesday, Dec. 29, at 7 p.m. in the Coors Events Conference Center in Boulder.

BUFFS ON THE AIR...All Colorado women's basketball regular and post season games are broadcast live on KKZN AM 760, Boulder's Progressive Talk station. **Tim Smile** will handle play by play duties and is joined by USA Basketball's **Carol Callan** with the color commentary.

900TH GAME...Colorado is in its 31st season of varsity women's basketball and Wednesday will mark the 900th game in program history. CU heads into the contest with an all-time record of 582-317 (.647). The Buffaloes have made 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, all since 1988, including six Sweet 16 appearances and three trips to the Elite Eight (1993, 1995 & 2002).

BUFFS LOOKING UP...Colorado has answered an early December three-game losing streak with a current three-game win streak, including the Buffaloes first two road wins of the 2004-05 season. Sophomore forward **Anna Nedovic** leads a balanced CU scoring attack at 11.4 points per contest. Nedovic, who also posts a team-high 6.8 rebounds per game, is one of six Buffs averaging at least seven points per game. Freshman forward **Jackie McFarland** is at 10.4 points an outing, leads the team in free-throw percentage (21x26, .808) and is third in rebounds (5.1 rpg). Classmate **Kara Richards** rounds out CU's front court averaging 8.3 points, 5.4 rebounds and a team-best 1.3 blocks per game. Junior shooting guard Whitney Law is fourth on the squad in the scoring column (9.0 ppg) and leads the team and Big 12, in 3-point field-goal percentage as she has hit 10 of her first 16 shots (.625). Senior point guard **Veronica Johns-Richardson** is averaging 9.0 points per contest and paces the Buffaloes in steals (21) and assists (27).

WILD WIN IN WASHINGTON...**Jackie McFarland** scored with less than two seconds remaining in overtime as Colorado won its third straight game and defeated Washington 76-74 on Dec. 21.

McFarland took a pass just under the basket from **Veronica Johns-Richardson** and tossed in an easy lay-up for the lead.

The Huskies (4-6) were left short when Dominique Banks' long three-point attempt as time expired hit the rim and fell away. The Buffaloes (5-4) won despite missing eight of their final 10 free throws in regulation and hit just 45 percent for the game (9-of-20). Washington's Jill Bell forced overtime after getting wide open in the paint on an in-bound pass and tying the game at 67.

The Huskies led at the half, 33-26, behind 11 points from Banks, who finished with a game high 19 points. Colorado trailed the entire game, until a 10-2 run midway through the second half. CU held its largest lead at 66-59 with just 2:14 remaining, but managed just one Johns-Richardson free-throw until Bell sent the game to the extra session.

McFarland finished with 16 points, including eight in a row in the second half. Johns-Richardson had a career-high 17 points, **Jasmina Ilic** had a personal-best 13 points and **Whitney Law** posted her first career double-double with 11 points and a game-high 10 rebounds.

The Buffaloes' leading scorer, **Anna Nedovic**, who came into the game averaging just over 12 points a game, was held scoreless in the first half and finished with five points.

Colorado won its first game of the season (1-4) when losing the battle of the boards. Washington outrebounded the Buffaloes 49-46 including 22 offensive rebounds which the Huskies turned into 23 second chance points. Bell added 14 points for Washington, which has now dropped five of its last six games.

BUMPY RIDE FOR THE BEARS...Enduring its first full season of Division I basketball, Northern Colorado sports a 2-8 record. The Bears two wins have come at UTEP (59-52) on Dec. 17 and at home against Utah State (68-62) on Dec. 2. UNC averages just 52.8 points per game as a team and no Bear is averaging double digits. Sophomore forward Heather Barbour tops the Bears at 8.3 points per game while center Danielle Hagen, the only Bear to start all 10 games, is at 6.8 points and a team-best 6.1 rebounds per game.

COLORADO-UNC SERIES...This will be the 13th meeting between Colorado and Northern Colorado and the first since the 1985-86 season. The teams are deadlocked at six wins apiece, although Colorado has won three straight in the series and five of the last six. Colorado defeated the Bears 91-50 in the last meeting between the two teams on Nov. 26, 1985, in Boulder. UNC's last win over CU came in Greeley, 59-53, on Jan. 27, 1978.

RICHARDS, MCFARLAND EARLY BIG 12 ROOKIES OF THE WEEK...Kara Richards and Jackie McFarland have each earned the Big 12 Conference Rookie of the Week award in the early stages of the season. Richards earned the honor on Nov. 22 during the first week of regular season action while McFarland received the award for her performance in games during the week of Nov. 29-Dec. 5.

McFarland led Colorado and established career-highs with 23 points and eight rebounds in CU's five-point loss at Wyoming on Dec. 1. She hit 8-of-14 from the field (.571) and 7-of-8 from the line (.875) against the Cowgirls. She then registered her first career double-double with 19 points and a new career-best 10 rebounds against Creighton on Dec. 4. She hit 9-of-10 from the free-throw stripe and added two blocks, one steal and one assist. For the week McFarland averaged 21.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 1.0 bpg.

Richards averaged 13.5 points, three rebounds and 1.5 blocks in her first two collegiate games. The Graham, Texas, native scored 13 points and pulled down six rebounds in her first game, a Colorado win over Loyola Marymount. She was the first Buff freshman to start the season opener since Linda Lappe in 1998. Richards hit 7-of-10 from the floor for 14 points in CU's loss to Nevada.

NO RUST FROM FINALS...Colorado's game against Pacific was its first in 10 days following the University's finals week which ended with Friday's graduation. The Buffs have had little trouble dusting off the cobwebs from Finals week in recent years going 12-3 since the 1990-91 season in the first game after the traditional finals week. Colorado has won three straight in such games with its last loss coming at No. 20 Florida on Dec. 21, 2001.

SUCCESS IN THE PRESEASON...Colorado will needs a win in one of the next two games to clinch its fifth straight season of .500 or better during the nonconference regular season schedule. The Buffs have only finished below .500 twice during the nonconference schedule in the Ceal Barry era going 5-6 in 1999-2000 and 4-9 in 1984-85.

SOME STREAKS ENDING...Prior to the loss against Creighton, Colorado had won 10 straight games at home following a road loss. The three-game losing streak is also the program's first since the 2001-02 season (78-67 at No. 3 Oklahoma on Jan. 2, 70-68 vs. No. 21 Texas on Jan 6. and 75-72 at No. 14 Kansas State on Jan. 9) and the losses to Wyoming and Creighton were CU's first back-to-back setbacks against unranked teams since the 2000-01 season (72-70 vs. CSU on Dec. 6 and 92-66 at Iowa on Dec. 10).

A BARRY GOOD MILESTONE...By coaching the Buffaloes against Loyola Marymount in the season opener, head coach **Ceal Barry** passed legendary track & field coach Frank Potts for the most events coaches in school history at 642. She already holds the CU record for wins in any sport (420) and has coached in more games (645) than any coach in school history.

HOWARD LEAVES THE BUFFALOES...Leslie Howard, a 5-10 sophomore forward from Salem, Mo., has left the CU basketball program for personal reasons. Howard played in the first four games of the

season averaging 6.3 points and 3.5 rebounds per game including a career-high 14 points against Pennsylvania on Nov. 26. She played 24 games in a Colorado uniform averaging three points and just over one rebound per contest.

FOR OPENERS...Colorado improved to 26-5 all-time in season openers and has won 17 of its last 18. The Buffs are 19-3 under Ceal Barry in season-opening games and have won the last five. This season marked the first time since the 1999-2000 season the Buffs didn't open the season in Boulder (at Denver) and the first time since 1996-97 (at BYU) the Buffs didn't begin the season in the state of Colorado.

DOMINANT IN DECEMBER...Despite a rough start to the month, Colorado is traditionally a strong team in the month of December. The Buffaloes are 137-55 (.714) all-time in the month. Prior to their loss to Wyoming, the Buffaloes had won 12 straight in December dating back to a 61-50 loss at No. 20 Florida on Dec. 21, 2001.

SECOND AT COORS...Colorado placed second at the 18th annual Coors Classic, Nov. 26-27, at the Coors Events Center. The Buffaloes took care of business with a 69-49 win over Pennsylvania in the first round, but fell to then No 2 ranked, and now top-ranked, LSU 75-44. Freshman **Kara Richards** was awarded All-Tournament team honors after achieving career-highs with 11 rebounds and six assists against Penn and 10 rebounds, three steals and two blocks against the Tigers. Leslie Howard scored a career-high 14 points against Penn while **Anna Nedovic** and **Whitney Law** each had 10. LSU held Colorado to a school record low 24 percent shooting in the championship game. Preseason Player of the Year candidate Seimone Augustus took home tournament MVP honors.

PRESEASON TOURNAMENTS...Colorado is 86-31 all-time in preseason tournaments, including a solid 30-6 mark in the Coors Classic. The Buffaloes have won 23 of their last 29 preseason tournament games and went 5-1 last season winning the WBCA Classic and Coors Classic Tournament championships.

LIGHTS, CAMERA, BUFFS...The Colorado Athletic Department and Fox Sports Rocky Mountain have agreed to televise seven Buffs' women's basketball games this season. Add that to the three national Fox Sports Network games scheduled through a combination of Big 12 and Pac 10 Conference pacts, CU women's basketball is scheduled for a school-record 10 regular season television games this winter.

TOUGH SCHEDULE...Colorado's schedule is once again a tough one, with the Buffs facing nine teams that played in the 2004 NCAA tournament. The Big 12 offers one of the toughest schedules in the nation, as seven members played in the NCAA's a season ago, with Texas and Baylor making the Sweet 16. Colorado's Coors Classic alone featured three teams who played in the NCAA Tournament last season, Penn, LSU and Maryland.

HEAD COACH CEAL BARRY...Ceal Barry is in her 22nd season at Colorado, and 26th overall has a collegiate head coach. Barry's overall coaching record is 506-269 with the win total ranking 20th among active NCAA Division I coaches. At Colorado Barry has led the Buffaloes to a 423-227 record, including 13 20-win seasons and 12 trips to the NCAA Tournament.

As a head coach Barry has a 1-0 record against Northern Colorado.

BUFFS PICKED SEVENTH, SIXTH IN BIG 12 POLLS...Colorado was picked to finish seventh in the annual Big 12 Coaches Preseason poll while the media said the Buffaloes would finish sixth in their preseason poll. Texas was the overwhelming favorite in both polls. The Longhorns received 11 of 12 first place votes in the coaches poll (coaches aren't allowed to vote for their own teams) and 12 of 14 first place votes in the media poll. Colorado was picked fifth in both the 2003-04 and 2002-03 preseason polls only to achieve a higher standing by the end of the season. CU enjoyed a third-place finish last season and a fourth-place showing in 2002-03. The Buffs have not finished lower than fourth in the Big 12 standings since the 1999-2000 season.

NATIONAL POLLS...Colorado was not ranked in either of the major polls this week. Five of CU's 2004-05 opponents are in the current top 25 including four in the top 15. LSU is ranked first in both polls after its 8-0 start. Texas is fourth in both polls, but owns a win over preseason No. 1 Tennessee. In the coaches poll Baylor is ninth, Texas Tech is 12th and Kansas State is 22nd. In the AP poll, Baylor is sixth, Texas Tech is 12th and Kansas State is 25th.

HOME SWEET HOME...The Buffs are 319-92 (.776) at home all-time, with an even more impressive record at the Coors Events/Conference Center, turning in a record of 286-71 (.801). Under head coach Ceal Barry the Buffs are 234-70 (.772) at the CECC. CU has turned in six undefeated seasons at home in 28 seasons, including three consecutive years from 1980-83. Most recently the Buffs were perfect at home in 1993-94 when they went 13-0 at the CECC, 27-5 overall. Colorado owns the seventh-longest home winning streak in NCAA history, going for 53-straight during the early 80s.

THE BUFFALO STAMPEDE...Coach Ceal Barry's television show airs on Fox Sports Rocky Mountain on Friday evenings at 7:30 p.m. Hosted by Sandy Williams, the show incorporates all of CU's athletic department and is filmed on location in and around Boulder and is produced by BuffVision, the partnership that brings us the fantastic video boards at Folsom Field.

UP NEXT...Colorado will remain at home for its final non conference game on Sunday, Jan. 2, against Manhattan at 12 p.m.
