Colorado Head Coach Dan Hawkins

Genera

"That was unbelievable and a great thing to be a part of right there. The longer the game went on, the better I felt our chances were, I really think the character of our guys and conditioning and what we're doing is really showing up and that's an awesome thing to see. I thought the defense played really, really well. West Virginia got off a couple of good plays, but Pat White is good. You're not going to shut down Michael Jordan, he's going to get some shots off. I thought by and large we did a great job, we got a critical turnover there, had a few mistakes on offense and I think they prevented us from getting a few points. It was a good game against a good team. Give our guys a lot of credit for hanging in there and showing character."

On Rodney Stewart's Performance

"You have seen the glimpses of him, you knew that was coming. That's the stuff we keep talking about; you never know when those freshman are going to grow up, you know it's going to happen sometime because they have too much talent not to. The exciting thing was that he didn't turn the ball over. He did a great job, he made some great runs and he ran hard. The awesome thing is that we have **Darrell (Scott)**, **Demetrius (Sumler)**, and we have **Kevin Moyd**. Kevin Moyd hasn't had a carry yet and the first time he gets the ball, everyone is going to be asking why he hasn't been playing

On The Decision When To Kick The FG In Overtime

"We talked a little bit about how long we wanted to go before we just kicked it and ended it. We probably could have kicked it from the get-go, but again, you can imagine how nervous a guy is at that point. We really wanted to make it a chip-shot and make sure the ball was in the middle of the field. That's what it's all about, coming up when the team needs you."

On The Team Believing In The Colorado System

"I think that they believe and that's a critical component to anything. I think they totally believe in what we're doing and why we do it, and that is huge. That confidence will grow. With that, they need to have the maturity of looking at some of the missed opportunities and continuing to push on; and I think they are, and they will. You can't just sit back and think that's great, you need to think that it's great and how we can fix these mistakes."

On The Team Playing With Urgency

"It's not so much that your getting that womping. These guys are having to scratch and claw, so I think that sense of urgency is still in the back of their mind. They know it's just not coming easy and that's a good thing, because we're playing too many good football teams. You never know how much ten minutes of film or one more rep, or five more pounds is going to help you in the game."

On Getting Too Confident With The Victory

"We'll put this thing to bed tomorrow morning or tomorrow afternoon and they'll get Saturday off, but come Sunday, it's all about the Seminoles. They've been pretty good about that so far and so has our staff, so I don't have any problems with that. I'm not one of those guys who looks ahead, persay, I've really been preaching this whole consitancy thing the whole time. Understanding how to balance your life out and win, lose, or draw, let's put it to bed and move on. That has to be the mantra as we go through this thing, because it's just too tough physically, emotionally, and everything else. I don't anticipate our guys having any problems, but we need to be able to do that."

On Scoring Early And Winning The Game

"That's the fastest we've scored all year. We just made a couple of plays and got going. I'm fired up that that kid (West Virginia Linebacker J.T. Thomas) is going to be alright. You never want to see that happen to someone. It's great to get a win with Eddie's name on the field, and that was special."

On The Game's Atmosphere

"I took several times during the game to look around and look at the pagentry. I kept thinking how blessed I was to be out there; everyone was in black, everyone was fired up, we're under the lights. I said, 'This is awesome!' It's a great thing to be apart of and to enjoy it. Like I said, I though the longer the game went on, our guys enjoyed it and nobody freaked out. We had a couple of opportunities where we probably should have scored some more points, Misty's son (and his son, quarterback Cody Hawkins) had a hand in not getting those points, but he did get the other points. It just seemed like we had a penalty, or a jacked up play and then we just get behind the eight-ball a little bit. You'd love as time goes on to see us iron that out and be a smooth, operating machine; but I'll take the win, and they're a good football team, so that was a good win."

On Colorado's Defensive Effort

"The defensive staff and these guys have been working for basically two weeks. When you play a team like West Virginia, you have to be so disciplined; it's keeping the shoulders square, staying in your gap, moving when your gap moves, and doing that. We didn't get overly complicated too much, we changed up a few things in there, but these guys did a nice job of haning in there, filling there gaps; and every once in a while we would throw a curve ball so that it wasn't exactly the same every time. I thought Ron (Collins, Defensive Coordinator), our defensive staff, and our guys did a good job just over the course of the two weeks with the mentality that there's no room for error. Pat White and Noel Divine are so good, that if you make one mistake, it's over; it's not a seven yard gain, it's to the house."

On Where The Program Currently Is

"Nobody wants to be close, but we're a lot closer than people think and realize. You win a couple of games, you get a little bit of confidence, you catch fire and it's on. I do think all of these guys are sold on how we lift, how we discipline, how we practice, and what we ask of them; and I think we're consistant with that. They're starting to see that. We talk about those breakthrough moments, which we had against Oklahoma last year, and the guys think that they're kind of getting it. The more you do that and the more they believe in it, the more you don't think about it; it just becomes what you do. We're definitely going in the right direction and I think we're getting really, really, really close. No one wants to be close, but if this group keeps hanging together and doing things right, we'll have some things to say by the end of the season.

On Players Buying Into His Philosophy

"That's what you live for; when that lightbulb comes on and they start connecting the dots on how you win football games, graduate, have this magical existance, and how it all comes together. Guys will understand that if you do things right and do them consistantly, good things are going to happen on the football field or in the classroom. That's the cool thing, when a guy takes something away from this thing bigger than just winning a football game."

West Virginia Head Coach Bill Stewart

General

"I'm so proud of the way they came out and competed. There's a lot of heart ache in that locker room. But they'll grow and get better. I'm proud of the seniors, they've been such great leaders."

"For the people of West Virginia, we came out here to get us a win and we fell short. And I hate that very very much."

"I hate it for our team that we couldn't get the win today. We were in the hunt."

On Play Of Defense

"We gave up 14 points early, then for 55 minutes we played like warriors, true warriors. I'm proud of the way they hung in there and played."

"Oh boy, you kidding me? They bent a little bit, but (Colorado) on third down they were six of 15. We counted on the defense for 55 minutes."

On Missed Kick In Overtime

"I feel sorry for Patrick McAfee. I don't know what happened with the hold or the snap, but it just hit the upright. He's made us a bunch, but that's a tought miss for him. I hate it for him, I really do."

"I'm proud of the special teams except for one play. That's going to haunt that poor kid forever. And I hate that for Patrick (McAfee)."

On Trick Play

"We had a wide open guy there, the kid just underthrew the ball. We could have scored there and maybe done some good things. But maybe doesn't get it done."

On End Of Regulation

"We weren't going to kick the ball at the end of the game. I don't second guess. I absolutely wouldn't change a thing. We weren't going to put our defense on the 50 yard line with the game on the line."

On Play of Pat White

"He's a lifeblood. He's the best we have."

On Returning Back to Colorado (former Air Force assistant coach.)

"I spent four wonderful years at the Air Force acadamy. I used to come up here and visit the Colorado Buffs. We had a great relationship."

On Being 1-2

"We still have our in-state rival (Marshall) coming in this Saturday. We have every game left in the Big East. We still have some marquee games coming in at home."

"We have a chance to have a tremendous year if we grow. Our juniors and seniors will hold everyone together. Those guys in that locker room have hurt hearts. They don't feel good, I don't feel good."

Colorado Players

PK Aric Goodman

ON GAME-WINNING FIELD GOAL- "When they missed the field goal it made it easier mentally on me, I have a chance to win the game, but I cannot lose the game. Mentally knowing that I have a chance to go out there and have fun was important. I just went out there and went through my check list and hit it and fortunately it went through."

ON OPPORTUNITY TO WIN THE GAME-"It's a great opportunity to go out there and make a kick. Throughout the fourth quarter I knew it might come down to a kick and I had a pretty good practice all week. I knew if it came down to me it was going to go through."

ON KICKING TRADITION AT CU-"I am confident from 60 yards and in, but it's definitely not the time to relate me to Mason Crosby. Those are huge shoes to fill and he is a fantastic kicker for the Green Bay Packers. I am just trying to creep up into his shadow right now."

ON SCHOLARSHIP OFFER-"Finally after a year and a half I am now on scholarship."

TB Rodney Stewart

ON HIS PERFORMANCE-"I just figured out the defensive game plan and I was figuring out where the holes were and luckily I was getting yards."

ON DIFFERENT OFFENSIVE FORMATIONS-"I think I like the "I" a little bit more because you have vision to both sides of the field instead of being in the spread when you have vision to one side of the field. It was great that we switched our game plan this week."

ON EXPERIENCE GAINED-"It shows that we have faith in our program and our team. We came out and worked hard and we knew it was going to pay off."

QB Cody Hawkins

ON RUNNING GAME-"I have a lot of faith in our offensive line. I think they took it as a challenge last week and a lot of that was miscommunication. This week they did an awesome job of talking to each other and they were very physical and that was the number one key to the game. They did a good job of hustling up to the ball and knocking the snot out of the guy across from them, down after down."

ON OFFENSIVE LINE-"We have so many great guys up front and Coach Grimes does an awesome job. They take a lot of pride in moving the ball up and down the field. I tip my hat to them because if it wasn't for our offensive and defensive line we wouldn't have won this game tonight."

ON WEST VIRGINIA'S DEFENSE-"They were fast and I think they adjusted to our tempo pretty quickly. They also dropped a lot of guys into coverage and that's why we ran the ball so well, because they knew we had that threat outside. Obviously as the game went on we relied on the run because our offensive line was doing a great job and we also got some great blocks from our wide receivers."

He's been talking about kicking a game winning field goal against West Virginia since last year. People might say we made that up, but he's been saying that forever. LB Jeff Smart

ON DEFENSIVE PLAY-"We always feel like if we can get the lead we have a great shot of winning. If we keep them out of the end zone, then we win the game. It's good to get up early like we did and we got a big turnover and we were able to capitalize on that. They have a bunch of great athletes on their team and it's just a matter of not giving up and fighting."

ON THIRD DOWN STOP IN OVERTIME-"It's especially big in overtime. It's do or die. We had third and a yard and they lined up in a 100 percent run formation. We got a great call from the coaches and we just played ball from there."

ON COLORADO'S OFFENSE- "They started the first quarter throwing a lot. After their first two scores, they started to nickel and dime us. They stopped throwing."

ON TRAILING EARLY- "We just got to the sideline and coach said there is a long game left. He said to take it play by play so we did."

ON COACH BILL STEWART- "Coach Stewart is a great coach. He and his staff are doing a good job. We are behind him one-hundred percent."

ON WEST VIRGINIA FANS- "Walking on campus last week, people were telling me to hold my head up. I feel like our fans will stick with us."

ON THE LOSS- "We're devastated, but at the same time, there's a long season ahead of us. Our defense got a little bit of confidence. We came out and played well against a great team.

ON THE 1-2 START- "It's tough, especially for those of us who have been in the program for a few years. We aren't used to losing. The rest of the season will define our

character and allow us to build on it and find out what type of team we have."

ON COLORADO'S OFFENSE- "We knew what type of game it was going to be. We buckled down as a defense after the two early scores. We had a week and a half to prepare. This week, we did a lot less thinking and just a lot more performing. We did some good things against the run game, but still gave up way too many yards.

GENERAL- "It's tough for me to walk off the field looking at the scoreboard, seeing us down 17-14. A lot of bad comes out of this because we lost, but a lot of good too because as a defense we played well."

ON THIRD DOWN EFFICIENCY- "We need to get into the media room to see what we have to do to get better, to improve."

ON THE 1-2 START- "It's tough, but we need to hold our heads high and move on."

ON WEST VIRGINIA'S OFFENSE- "It's a team sport, but when I have the ball in my hands I need to do the best I can. We feel like we are just one broken tackle away from breaking a big play."

GENERAL- "We just need to do the best we can, just have to fix the little things, and bounce back from our losses."

COLORADO BUFFALO FOOTBALL / POSTGAME NOTES

Colorado Buffaloes vs. West Virginia Mountaineers, Folsom Field, Boulder, Colo. (September 18, 2008)

QUICKLY Dan Hawkins' teams are now 8-1 following a bye week ... Colorado is 3-0 for the first time since 2004, and just the second time since a 5-0 start in '98 ... This was Colorado's 42nd win over a ranked team dating back to 1989, the eighth most in the nation during this time frame ... CU was last ranked Nov. 6, 2005 (21st by the coaches, 22 in AP & Harris) ... First significant winds (18-32 mph) in a game in Boulder since 2006, when winds gusted from 12-24 miles per hour on Sept. 21 vs. Arizona State (and those were the first since November 1995 against Missouri) ... Colorado now has six turnovers this season (3 INT, 3 FUM), all oddly occurring in the second quarter... CB Cha'pelle Brown was credited with his first career sack (for 0 yards); now, the NCAA doesn't acknowledge sacks for zero; however, Colorado has kept sacks since 1968 and awarded them for zero as the NFL does, and since the NCAA never bothered to ask any SID's or defensive coaches their opinions when it started tracking defensive numbers in 2003, CU did not change ... CU was up 14-7 at halftime; the Buffs had allowed just six points in the second half all season ... QB Cody Hawkins now has a 20-to-1 ratio of touchdowns to interceptions in the red zone.

FIRST ACTION TE Riar Geer saw his first action of the season after missing the first two games recovering from arthroscopic surgery; **CB Jimmy Smith** did the same after being out with back spasms; Fairview High alum and R-Fr. **TB Arthur Jaffee** saw his first action on the kickoff return unit in the third quarter.

FIRST START: Anthony Perkins made his first career start at strong safety, subbing for D.J. Dykes.

TB RODNEY STEWART (28-166, O TD) Colorado's diminutive freshman (5-6, 170) rushed for the third most yards in a game by a freshman with 166 (tied for the 60th most overall for a single game). He had 98 yards in the first half and also earned eight first downs. Tonight's chart:

"TOUCHBACK" DAVIS PK Jameson Davis, whose first

kickoff went for a touchback (and about 87 yards), equaled CU's 2007 total of touchbacks on kickoffs with his sixth of year. CU had that many on 63 kickoffs last year, and took just 14 in 2008 to reach that many. He latter added a seventh (on 16 kicks).

POWEK STRIKE Colorado's two touchdowns in the first **4:50** of the game were the fastest pair by the Buffs since Nov. 23, 2001 when the Buffs went up 14-0 on Nebraska just 3:13 into the game (CU of course went on to a 62-36 win scored two in the first 4:56 at Baylor on Oct. 19, 2002). CU had not scored in the first quarter (six possessions) prior to tonight. CU is 8-9 in games under Dan Hawkins when scoring first.

PK ARIC GOODMAN He hit the game winner from 25 yards out, which after a long drought in CU history has become almost commonplace. Kevin Eberhart hit two game winners last year, including over No. 3 Oklahoma, CU's last win over a ranked team (after hitting a game-tying one and then the winner against CSU). And Mason Crosby had a winner with four seconds left to beat CSU in 2005.

238 & COUNTING And the train keeps going: Colorado scored in its **238th** consecutive game tonight, adding to the fourth longest active streak in the nation and the ninth longest of all-time. CU has now extended the streak on its first possession **98** times and in the first quarter **164** times (**216** times by halftime). CU was last shutout nearly 20 years ago, 7-0 at Nebraska on Nov. 12, 1988.

HEISMAN WORTHY Colorado had not allowed an opposing back to gain 100 yards at Folsom Field since Kansas State's Alan Webb (QB) snuck over the plateau with 103 yards on 24 carries back on Nov. 13, 2004. WVU's QB Pat White (19-148, 2 TD) became just the seventh opponent to run for 100 or more in the last 40 games against the Buffs and the first in Boulder in nearly four years. Noel Devine added 133 on 26 carries, thus WVU became the first team with two 100-yard rushers in a game against CU since Eli Roberson (21-178) and Darren Sproles (16-121) did it for Kansas State in Boulder on Oct. 5, 2002.

OPPONENT PASSING LOW Even though WVU completed 10-of-15 passes, the 43 yards was a decade opponent low. You have to go back to Nov. 13, 1999 at Baylor, when CU limited the Bears to 40 passing yards on 4-of-21 throws. It's the lowest total by a ranked opponent in 20 years... No. 7 Nebraska completed 2-of-9 passes for 18 yards in a 7-0 win on Nov. 12, 1988.

INJURY REPORT SS D.J. Dykes did not start tonight due to illness. Otherwise just normal bumps and bruises. S Bret Smith (winter knee surgery) is due back in practice next week.

Game Captains

WVU game captains against the Buffaloes were senior quarterback Pat White, senior offensive lineman Ryan Stanchek, senior linebacker Mortty Ivy and senior linebacker Reed Williams.

Coach Bill Stewart will select game captains each week. Team captains will be elected at the end of the regular season.

For Starters

Freshman tight end Tyler Urban was the lone first-time starter for the Mountaineers against Colorado. Will Johnson made his first career start as a slot receiver. Reed Williams made his first start of the season in his first game action of the year.

A total of 35 Mountaineers now have at least one game of starting experience. Tops on that list are senior offensive lineman Ryan Stanchek (37), senior quarterback Pat White (33), junior offensive lineman Greg Isdaner (28) and senior offensive lineman Jake Figner (28). All of Stanchek and Isdaner's starts are consecutive, and White has started 17 straight.

Moving On Up

With his 12-yard carry in the first quarter, quarterback Patrick White passed Joshua Cribbs (Kent State, 2001-04) for third place on the all-time NCAA career quarterback rushing list. Cribbs had 3,670 career rushing yards.

White now boasts 3,814 for his career.

Season-long Play

Pat White's 44-yard rush on WVU's second drive of the game marked the longest play of the season for the Mountaineers. It marked White's 13th longest rush of his career.

White's Rushing Touchdowns

Patrick White's six-yard rushing touchdown in the first quarter and his 39-yard scoring run in the third quarter marked his first and second of the season and 40th and 41st of his career. He moved past Amos Zereoue (1996-98) into fourth place on WVU's career rushing touchdown list. Steve Slaton (2005-07) is WVU's career rushing touchdown leader with 50.

The scores marked White's 80th and 81st career TDs responsible for. He is just the third player in BIG EAST history to amass 80 or more career TDs responsible for. Syracuse's Donovan McNabb (1995-98) is the BIG EAST career leader in the category with 96.

White now has 12 career multiple rushing touchdown games in his career. White's first rushing touchdown also marked WVU's first of the 2008 season. WVU now has 122 rushing touchdowns in its last 35 games, dating back to 2005.

Williams' Pick

Reed Williams' second-quarter interception marked the second of his career.

Holmes' Sack and Forced Fumble

John Holmes' sack of Cody Hawkins in the second quarter and subsequent forced fumble marked the seventh and fourth of his career, respectively. Scooter Berry recovered the fumble, the fourth of his career.

100-Yard Rushing Performances

Pat White's 148-yards rushing against Colorado marked his 16th career 100-yard rushing effort and first of the season.

Noel Devine reached 100 yards rushing for the fourth time in his career and first time this season with his 133 yards, the second-most of his career. His previous-high was 136 at Maryland last year.

Double-Trouble

White and Devine both topped 100 yards rushing against the Buffaloes. It marked the 45th time in school history that there were two l00-yard rushers in the same game. It marks the 12th time that White has been one of those two in a single contest.

It marks the first game that the Mountaineers had two 100-yard rushers since White (150) and Devine (108) both reached that plateau in the same game against Oklahoma in the 2008 Fiesta Bowl.

Career Night for Devine

Noel Devine's 26 carries against Colorado marked a career-high. His previous best was 13 in last season's Fiesta Bowl.

Overtime

West Virginia headed to overtime for the first time since 2006, a 41-39 three overtime victory in the season's final regular season game against Rutgers at Mountaineer Field at Milan Puskar Stadium. The Colorado game marked the second-ever away overtime contest (2000 at Rutgers, 31-24/W).

WVU falls to 4-2 all-time and 1-1 on the road in overtime games.
