Texas (South) has clinched a berth in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game. Its opponent from the North will be either Colorado, or Iowa State.

COLORADO WINS IF it beats Nebraska. The Buffs can still represent the North if they lose to Nebraska and Iowa State loses to Kansas.

IOWA STATE WINS IF it beats Kansas and Colorado loses.

Rushing to the Top

For the first time in Big 12 history, a quarterback can finish the season as the Conference's leading rusher. Currently, Missouri's Brad Smith sits atop the league rushing chart (1,151 yds), followed by Oklahoma State freshman running back Mike Hamilton (941 yds).

10th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The 10th annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship takes place at Houston's Reliant Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 3, at 12 p.m. (CT) under the television cameras of ABC Sports. General public tickets are available at all Ticketmaster outlets, by phone at (713) 629-3700, online at ticketmaster.com or at the Reliant Stadium South ticket windows. Tickets are priced at \$98 (Club), \$78 (Field Level, Mezzanine), \$68 (Loge, Upper Level) and \$48 (Upper Level Ends, 700 Level).

Big 12 Preseason Media Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in two of the last three seasons (OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Last year the media accurately predicted OU to win the South, but incorrectly picked KSU in the North. BAYLOR (5-6, 2-6)

End of Season

Baylor posted two Big 12 wins in a season for the first time ever. The Bears won five games for the first time since the 1995 team won seven.

Baylor finished the season with 10 rushing touchdowns, the most by a Baylor team since the Bears had 16 in 2002.

Free safety Maurice Lane finished his career with 365 tackles, third all-time at BU.

Shawn Bell established a Baylor record for completions in a season. He finished with 190, breaking the longest-standing single-season record at Baylor (Don Trull, 174, 1963). Bell has 3,804 career yards passing, eighth all-time at BU.



COLORADO (7-3, 5-2)

This Week: Nebraska
End of Regular Season

Colorado wins the North Division title with a victory over Nebraska. CU can still advance to the Dr. Pepper Big 12 Championship game for the fourth time in the last five seasons with an Iowa State loss at Kansas.

The Colorado defense has not allowed a 100-yard rusher this season. CU is second nationally in rush defense at 77.0 yards per game.

Joel Klatt went 139 pass attempts without an interception before being picked off in the third-quarter against Iowa State.

Mason Crosby connected on his 11th field goal from beyond 50 yards in his career with a 57-yarder at Iowa State. Earlier this season, he booted a 58-yarder at Miami.



IOWA STATE (7-3, 4-3)

This Week: at Kansas
End of Regular Season

Iowa State advances to the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship game with a win at Kansas, and a loss by Colorado

The Cyclones have won four straight conference games for the second consecutive year, a first in school history .

Iowa State's defense has intercepted passes in eight of the 10 games played this season.

The Cyclones have scored 112 points off of 29 turnovers while allowing only 43 points off of 16 turnovers this season.

Bret Meyer now has 4,291 career yards passing, which is fourth-best in ISU annals.



KANSAS (5-5, 2-5)

This Week: Iowa State
End of Regular Season

Kansas is second in the Big 12 and fifth nationally in rush defense, allowing 91.3 yards per game. The Jayhawks have held the opposition to less than 100 yards on the ground in seven of 10 contests.

Running back Jon Cornish opened the second half of the Texas game with a 59-yard touchdown to mark his third-straight game with a rushing TD and ninth rushing touchdown of the season.

Since switching to playing offense exclusively in the Colorado game, Charles Gordon has 19 catches for 161 yards. Against Texas, Gordon led all KU receivers with six catches for 47 yards.

The Kansas defense held Texas quarterback Vince Young to a career-low negative four (-4) rushing yards, marking the first time in Young's career he had negative yards on the ground.



KANSAS STATE (5-6, 2-6)

End of Season

Kansas State has won 13 straight games over Missouri and sent head coach Bill Snyder, who announced his retirement last week, out on a winning note. Snyder ends his KSU career with a 136-68-1 record over 17 seasons.

Kansas State has scored in 115 straight games, dating back to the 1996 Colorado game. The scoring streak is currently the 13th-longest in the nation.

Thomas Clayton rushed for 102 yards in the season-finale vs. Missouri, breaking the 100-yard mark for the third time in 2005.

Jordy Nelson's eight touchdown receptions this season are the seventh-most in single-season history and his 38 receptions are the second-most by a K-State sophomore wide receiver.



MISSOURI (6-5, 4-5)

End of Regular Season

Tight end Chase Coffman's 33-yard touchdown catch against Kansas State was his first since the second game of the season. Coffman matched his career high with six catches for a career-high 88 yards.

Tight end Martin Rucker also had a career day against K-State with nine catches for 112 yards and a touchdown.

Brad Smith added to his Big 12 total offense career record with 319 yards, 248 passing and 71 rushing. He now has 12,656 total yards in his career.

Smith is the only player in the Big 12 to average over 100 yards a game on the ground with a 104.6 yard average.

Missouri is bowl-eligible for the second time in the last three years.



NEBRASKA (6-4, 3-4)

This Week: at Colorado
End of Regular Season

Nebraska is bowl-eligible after its victory over K-State and snapped a three-game losing streak to the Wildcats. The Cornhuskers will be making their 36th bowl appearance in the last 37 seasons.

Quarterback Zac Taylor passed for 220 yards against Kansas State before being forced to the sideline with an injury early in the fourth quarter. Taylor's 2,094 passing yards on the season is a Nebraska single-season passing record.

Bo Ruud tallied a career-high 15 tackles in the win over Kansas State. He was also in on five tackles for loss, tying the Cornhusker single-game record for a linebacker. Ruud is currently second on the team with 74 tackles, including 11 for loss.



OKLAHOMA (6-4, 5-2)

This Week: Oklahoma State
End of Regular Season

Dusty Dvoracek sacked Cody Hodges for his 42nd career tackle for loss and moved into sole possession of sixth-place on OU's all-time list in that category.

Malcolm Kelly moved into fifth place on OU's all-time receptions by a freshman list. Kelly has 23 catches this season.

Adrian Peterson rushed for two touchdowns against Texas Tech, marking the eighth time in 22 career games that Peterson has had multiple-touchdown games.

With 108 yards, Peterson also recorded his fourth 100-plus-yard rushing game of the season and 15th of his career.



OKLAHOMA STATE (4-6, 1-6)

This Week: at Oklahoma
End of Season

D'Juan Woods pushed his streak of consecutive games with a catch to 20. Woods ranks third in the Big 12 with 840 receiving yards. His 2,065 career receiving yards is third on the all-time OSU list.

With one game left to play, Mike Hamilton needs 39 yards to record the 16th 1,000-yard rushing season in school history.

Hamilton has 1,106 all-purpose yards this season and is the first OSU freshman to rack up 1,000 all-purpose yards since quarterback Aso Pogi in 2000.

Quarterback Al Pena had a career day at Baylor, completing 25 passes for 351 yards and four touchdowns -- all career-highs.



TEXAS (10-0, 7-0)

This Week: at Texas A&M
Next Week: Big 12 Championship

The Longhorns have clinched the Big 12 South Division title and will play in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship game on December 3 in Houston's Reliant Stadium.

Texas has racked up 1,868 yards of offense over the last three games, while outscoring the opposition 175-42.

With his 32-yard completion to David Thomas in the first quarter against Kansas, Vince Young became UT's all-time leader in total offense with 8,078 yards, passing Major Applewhite who had 8,059 (1998-01). He now stands at 8,269 total yards.

UT leads the Big 12 in scoring offense (50.1 ppg), rushing offense (284.3 ypg), total offense (527.9 ypg), scoring defense (14.3 ppg), pass defense (164.4 ypg) and total defense (277.8 ypg).

The KU win was Mack Brown's 80th victory as Texas' coach.



TEXAS A&M (5-5, 3-4)

This Week: Texas
End of Regular Season

Placekicker Todd Pegram became the second 300-point scorer in Texas A&M history with a 12-point effort (three FGs, three PATs) against Oklahoma. For his career, Pegram has booted 55 field goals and 139 extra points for a total of 304 points, which is second to Kyle Bryant's 325 points from 1994-97 on the A&M all-time list.

The Texas A&M defense has caused 14 turnovers over the last five games.

Reggie McNeal became Texas A&M's all-time leading career passer with his 158-yard effort against OU. McNeal has passed for 6,992 career yards, which broke the old record of 6,846 yards set by Corey Pullig (1992-95).

Redshirt freshman quarterback Stephen McGee came off the bench for the injured Reggie McNeal and led the Aggies on three scoring drives in the comeback attempt at Oklahoma.



TEXAS TECH (9-2, 6-2)

End of Regular Season

Texas Tech's nine-win regular season is its first since 1976 when Tech won 10 regular-season games. The Red Raiders' six conference wins are their most since competing in the Big 12.

Taurean Henderson picked up his fourth 100-plus yard (109 yards) rushing game of the season and the 10th of his career.

The Red Raiders went 7-0 at Jones SBC Stadium this season and will go into 2006 riding a nine-game home win streak. The nine-game streak is the longest since Tech registering 11-straight between Sept. 15, 1973, and Nov. 23, 1974.

Texas Tech has outscored opponents 224-99 in the first half this season, including a 100-30 in the first quarter.

Instant Replay

The Big 12 has two main principles with regard to review:

- A standard of **indisputable video evidence** for any on-field call to be changed;
- A review must have a **direct, competitive effect** on the game, such as a change of possession, scoring play, etc.

Plays that **MAY** be reviewed with the use video replay:

1. Plays governed by sideline, goal line and end line:

- a) Scoring plays, including a runner breaking the plane of the goal line.
- b) Pass complete/incomplete/intercepted at sideline, goal line and end line.
- c) Runner/receiver in or out of bounds.
- d) Recovery of loose ball in bounds.

2. Passing Plays:

- a) Pass ruled complete/incomplete/intercepted in the field of play and end zones.
- b) Touching of a forward pass by an ineligible receiver.
- c) Touching of a forward pass by a defensive player.
- d) Quarterback (passer) forward pass or fumble (if ruled incomplete, the play is finalized).
- e) Illegal forward pass or illegal handing beyond the line of scrimmage.
- f) Illegal forward pass or illegal handing after change of possession.
- g) Forward or backward pass thrown from behind the line of scrimmage.

3. Other detectable infractions:

- a) Runner ruled not down.
- b) Forward progress errors with respect to first down.
- c) Touching of a kick.
- d) Number of players on field.
- e) Clock adjustments.
- f) Fourth-down/try fumble plays.

Plays that **MAY NOT** be reviewed with the use of video replay:

1. Holding.
2. Offside/encroachment.
3. Pass interference.
4. Personal fouls (e.g., late hits).
5. Illegal blocks.
6. Illegal formations.
7. Face mask.
8. Taunting/excessive celebration.
9. False starts.
10. Roughing the passer/kicker.
11. Fighting participants.
