THE MATCHES: Colorado continues Big 12 Conference action on Wednesday, Nov. 10, at No. 20 Kansas State at 6 p.m. MST in Manhattan, Kan. The Buffaloes will return home to host Oklahoma on Saturday, Nov. 13, at 7 p.m. in the Coors Events Conference Center.

ON THE SEASON: Colorado is 11-11 overall in 2004 and in sixth place in the Big 12 at 6-9. The Buffaloes, who are one-half game ahead of Kansas in the league standings, need to win four of their last five regular season matches to finish .500 in conference play. With the Kansas State match Wednesday, the Buffs will play their third straight against a ranked team the last two of which have been on the road. CU will finish the regular season with four teams currently seventh place or lower in the conference standings. Colorado has lost six of its last seven matches, the first such streak since 1987, the program's second season of varsity status. Four of the six losses in that stretch have come against teams ranked in the AVCA Top 25.

Junior right side hitter **Allie Griffin** and junior outside **Maragda Santillana** are both averaging over four kills per game and are ranked fifth and sixth in the Big 12 respectively. However, the Buffaloes are likely to be without Santillana again this week as she is out indefinitely with a rotator cuff injury to her right shoulder. In her place, sophomore **Amber Nu'u** has started the last three matches totalling 12 kills and 23 digs in the three outings. Freshman **Amber Sutherland** has also seen her playing time increase with the loss of Santillana. Sutherland, who played in just four of the season's first 20 matches, has nine kills over the past two outings including six at Texas A&M.

Sophomore **Ashley Nu'u** runs the Buffs' offense at setter averaging 12.17 assists per game. She is currently sixth on the school's all-time assists (1,282) and needs just 87 assists to become the 15th setter in team history with 1,000 assists in a season. Senior setter **Allison Barnes** has played more of a defensive role in 2004, but is still second on the squad in assists (71) and is averaging 1.77 digs per game during the conference season.

Junior outside **Nicole Carr** continues to lead the Buffaloes in digs (2.59 dpg) with Griffin not too far behind (2.50 dpg). Carr,

CU's active career leader in digs, ranks third on the team in kills (2.41 kpg).

CU's middle blocker combination of sophomores **Lara Bossow** and **Austin Zimmerman** are combining for 3.41 kills and 2.06 blocks per game. Defensively, junior **Kelly Masumiya** and freshman **Therese Viñal** have been solid in the libero position averaging 1.23 and 2.13 digs per game respectively.

LAST TIME OUT: No. 14 Texas A&M swept Colorado 30-24, 30-23, 30-22 on Nov. 7 at G. Rollie White Coliseum.

Texas A&M was led by senior All-American Melissa Munsch who led the

Aggies in kills with 13, in blocks with seven, and aces with four.

Colorado had a hitting percentage of just .178 compared to Texas A&M's .336. Colorado's attack was led by **Allie Griffin** as she finished with a match high 14 kills. Griffin also recorded 10 digs for the double-double.

Nicole Carr also recorded a double-double with 11 kills and 13 digs. It was her fifth double-double of the year. **Lara Bossow** had seven kills while **Amber Sutherland** notched a career-best six kills.

No. 10 Texas hit .325 and had 24 kills from Brandy Magee as the Longhorns swept the season series from Colorado with a 30-

The Longhorns demonstrated early why they entered the match as the top hitting percentage team in the conference (.318). Texas had eight kills on its first nine attacks and put down 12 of its first 15 to build a 20-9 lead. Magee had eight of her 24 kills in game one alone as the Longhorns finished at .516 (20 kills-4 errors-31 attacks). CU hit just .032 in game one with 10 kills on 31 attacks with nine errors.

Colorado did rebound in game two, and did it with defense. Texas' hitting percentage sank to .106 (17k-12-e-47att) thanks in part to Buffaloes blocking. After being shut out of the block column in game one, the Buffs had eight in the second frame. **Ashley Nu'u** and **Lara Bossow** each had five block assists including a pair which erased one Texas match point and set the Buffs up with one of their own. CU took advantage of a Magee hitting error to take game two 31-29.

Texas regrouped for games three and four hitting a combined .384 in the two frames compared to just .108 for the Buffaloes. The Longhorns took advantage of six and seven point spurts during the mid points of both games to pull away.

Allie Griffin had 12 kills and 11 digs but hit a season low -.048 as she had 14 errors on 42 attacks. Nu'u, who had 37 assists, hit .727 recording eight kills on 11 blocks with no errors. Bossow finished with a match-high seven blocks and had five kills. **Amber Nu'u** had six kills and registered 10 digs.

CU IN THE RANKINGS: In the seventh RichKern.com/AVCA Division I Region rankings released on Nov. 8, the Buffaloes ranked sixth in the Central Region for the second-straight week. The RichKern.com rankings mimic the NCAA RPI published at the end of the season. They are not associated with the official NCAA rankings, but are provide a ranking which uses a computerized formula similar to the NCAA.

Colorado did not receive any votes in the latest American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA)/USA Today/CSTV Top 25 poll released on Nov. 8. The Buffaloes were ranked No. 25 for two-straight weeks early in the season (Sept. 20-Oct. 3).

19TH SEASON: The 2004 season is the 19th for the Colorado volleyball program. Since debuting as a varsity program in the fall of 1986, the Buffs have an overall record of 357-218 including one conference title (Big Eight in 1993). CU has advanced to 13 NCAA Tournaments in 18 years, 12 of which have come since 1991. The Buffs are one of only 15 NCAA Division I programs with at least 12 NCAA appearances since 1991.

HEAD COACH PI'I AIU: Pi'i Aiu (*pronounced P-E I-U*) is in his eighth season as Colorado's head coach sporting a career record of 145-87. The 1997 Big 12 and District V Coach of the Year, Aiu has led the Buffs to six NCAA Tournaments in seven seasons, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 1997. Under his guidance, the Buffs have sported two All-Americans, eight All-Region, and 18 All-Big 12 performers. Aiu has been involved in the Colorado volleyball program in some capacity since its inception in 1986.

Aiu, who has led the Buffs to a 95-60 record in Big 12 matches, is joined on the bench this season by fifth-year assistant **Jil Thomason** and first-year assistant **Erik Sullivan**.

As a head coach Aiu is 6-9 against Kansas State and 14-1 against Oklahoma.

ABOUT THE WILDCATS: No. 20 Kansas State is 15-8 overall and in fifth place in the Big 12 standings at 9-5. The defending Big 12 champions stand one game behind Missouri for the fourth spot and two behind Texas A&M for third. The Wildcats have dropped both of their matches to the

leagues' top two teams -- No. 3 Nebraska and No. 9 Texas -- and their only other league loss came against Colorado in the season-opener in Boulder on Sept. 15. Vali Hejjas tops Kansas State in kills (295) and averages 2.38 digs per game. Lisa Martin is fourth in the Big 12 in hitting percentage (.362) and seventh in blocks (1.41 bpg). Angie Lastra paces the conference in aces (0.61 apg) and is third in digs (4.20 dpg).

ABOUT THE SOONERS: Oklahoma is 10-13 overall and in 10th place in the Big 12 at 2-12. The Sooners, who won their first eight matches of 2004, own conference wins over Colorado, at home in five games, and at Iowa State, in three games. Joanna Schmitt tops Oklahoma at 4.04 kills per game. Keri Coats leads the Sooners in hitting percentage (.298) and is second in kills at 2.82 per game.

SERIES RECORDS: Colorado has a 22-14 series lead over Kansas State. The Buffs' three-game win on Sept. 15 halted a five-match win streak for the Wildcats. KSU has still won the last four in the series in Manhattan. CU's last win at Kansas State came in a five-game thriller during the 1999 season.

Colorado owns a 31-10 series lead over Oklahoma. The 31 wins are the second most the Buffs have over any one program (CU has 36 wins over Iowa State). Oklahoma stopped CU's 14-match winning streak in the series on Oct. 16 with a five-game win in Norman. Colorado has won 15 straight over Oklahoma in Boulder. OU's last win in Boulder came during the 1988 season.

EXCUSED ABSENCE: First-year assistant coach Erik Sullivan missed all of fall preseason practice with the Buffs, but he had a pretty good excuse. He was a member of the U.S. National Volleyball team that competed in the 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens, Greece. The U.S team compiled an overall record of 4-4, advancing to Bronze Medal match. Sullivan, an eight-year veteran of the U.S. National Team, also participated in the 2000 Olympics in Sydney, Australia.

BUFFS AT HOME: Colorado calls the Coors Events/Conference Center home for the 17th straight season. The Buffs are 179-59 all time at the CECC for a winning percentage of .752. The Buffs are 18-7 at home in their last 25 matches with six of the seven losses coming to teams ranked in the AVCA Top 20 at the time.

BARNES, NU'U BOTH RANK AMONG ASSIST LEADERS: Allison Barnes resides in fifth place on CU's all-time assists list

while Ashley Nu'u is now in sixth. Nu'u became the fifth CU player to reach 1,000 assists on the final play of the Buffs' 3-0 win over Kansas on Oct. 9.

BUFF BITS: CU hit over .400 as a team in its first two matches this year, marking the first time since 1988 that the Buffs hit .400 in back-to-back matches. In fact, CU had not hit .400 or above twice in the same season since 1994...Colorado overcame an 0-2 deficit to defeat San Diego in five games. The last time the Buffs overcame an 0-2 deficit to win was in Boulder on Oct. 31, 2001 against Baylor... Conversely, CU saw a 23 match winning streak when up 2-0 end with a five-game loss at Texas...Game five of that Texas match was 20-18, marking the highest game five score CU has been involved in since defeating Ball State 24-22 on Sept. 4, 1995 in Boulder...Against Denver, CU set a team record for hitting percentage in a four-game match with a .402 performance (71k-18e-132att). The old record was .394 against Wyoming in 1995...Colorado started the season 5-2 marking the 16th consecutive season that

the Buffaloes have come out of the non-conference schedule with a record of .500 or above...CU won its fourth-straight Colorado Invitational title and took second place at the University of Oregon Classic Sept. 3-4. Allie Griffin was named MVP of the Colorado Invitational and was joined by Ashley Nu'u and Maragda Santillana on the All-Tournament team. Nu'u and Griffin were also members of the Oregon Classic All-Tournament team.

CU PICKED SIXTH IN 2004 BIG 12 COACHES PRESEASON POLL: Colorado was picked to finish sixth in the annual Big 12 Conference preseason coaches poll released Aug. 9.

Six-time Big 12 champion Nebraska was the unanimous first place pick, receiving 100 points and all 10 first-place votes. 2003 Big 12 Champion Kansas State was second with 80 points followed by Texas, Texas A&M, Missouri and Colorado.

Last season, CU was picked seventh by the coaches in the preseason poll and eventually finished in a three-way tie for third place with Texas A&M and Kansas in the final league standings.

No Buffs were selected to the Big 12 Conference preseason team.
