Proposal No. M-2010-1

TRYOUTS AND PRACTICE WITHOUT COMPETITION

- Sports other than men's ice hockey and skiing:
 - Prior to initial full-time collegiate enrollment, an individual may tryout with a professional athletics team and participate in practice sessions without competition conducted by a professional team.
 - May not receive more than actual and necessary expenses.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010; applicable to student-athletes who initially enroll full time in a collegiate institution on or after August 1, 2010.

Proposal No. M-2010-3

NONCOACHING STAFF MEMBERS AND NONCOUNTABLE COACHES — AFTER RECEIPT OF FINANCIAL DEPOSIT

- On or after May 1 of a prospective student-athlete's senior year in high school, noncoaching staff members and noncountable coaches are permitted to make telephone calls to or receive telephone calls from the prospective student-athlete, provided the institution has received a financial deposit in response to offer of admission.
- Effective date: April 13, 2010.



Proposal No. 2009-43

ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSIONS — EXCEPTION — AFTER RECEIPT OF FINANCIAL DEPOSIT

- On or after May 1 of prospective student-athlete's senior year, there is no limit on forms of electronically transmitted correspondence, provided the institution has received a financial deposit in response to offer of admission.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.

VIDEO/AUDIO MATERIALS AND COMPUTER GENERATED RECRUITING PRESENTATIONS

- Institution may produce video/audio materials **to show to, play for or provide to prospective student-athlete**, provided they include only general information related to institution or athletics and **not created for recruiting purposes**.
- Computer generated recruiting presentation may include **general informational video/audio material** that relates to an institution or athletics program and not created for recruiting purposes.
- Effective date: January 16, 2010.

VIDEO/AUDIO MATERIALS -- TIMING AND MEDIA AVAILABLE TO ALL STUDENTS

- Timing related to providing video or audio materials to a prospective student-athlete is governed by the general rule for providing recruiting materials.
 - We send it...can't be before September 1.
 - They download it from CUBuffs.com on their own, it's permissible
 - We TELL them to download it, has to be after September 1.
- Audio/video that is available to all students may be provided to prospective student-athletes.



Proposal No. 2009-47-B

WRITTEN OFFER OF AID BEFORE SIGNING DATE

- **Prior to August 1** of a prospective student-athlete's senior year in high school, institution shall not provide a written offer of athletically related financial aid or indicate in writing to the prospective student-athlete that an athletically related grant-in-aid will be offered by institution.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.



Proposal No. 2009-51-B

INSTITUTION'S SPORTS CAMPS AND CLINICS — LOCATION RESTRICTION — BASKETBALL

- Institution's camp or clinic must be conducted on the institution's campus or within a 100-mile radius of the institution's campus.
- Effective date: April 29, 2010; a contract signed before September 17, 2008, for men's basketball camps may be honored; a contract signed before September 16, 2009, for women's basketball camps may be honored.

CAMPS AND CLINICS — EMPLOYMENT DURING QUIET PERIODS — QUIET PERIOD — WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL

- Impermissible for a coach or noncoaching staff member with responsibilities specific to volleyball to be employed (either on a salaried or a volunteer basis) at an institutional camp or clinic or a noninstitutional, privately owned camp or clinic that is conducted off the institution's campus during a quiet period.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.



Proposal No. 2009-56

RECRUITING OR SCOUTING SERVICES — CRITERIA FOR SUBSCRIPTION

- Criteria that must be satisfied for institution to subscribe to recruiting/scouting service involving prospective student-athletes:
 - Identifies rates (available at same rate to all);
 - Disseminates information at least four times per year;
 - Identifies geographical scope (broad-based coverage);
 - Provides analysis beyond demographics;
 - Provides access to samples or previews; and
 - If applicable, video is restricted to regularly scheduled regular season contests.
- Effective date: January 16, 2010.

RECRUITING — USE OF RECRUITING FUNDS — RECRUITING OR SCOUTING SERVICES — CRITERIA FOR SUBSCRIPTION — INDIVIDUAL ANALYSIS REQUIRED

- Individual analysis beyond demographic information or rankings for each prospective student-athlete for whom information is disseminated must be provided by a recruiting or scouting service in order for an institution to subscribe to such a service.
- Effective date: April 13, 2010.

SPORTS CAMPS AND CLINICS — RECRUITING CONVERSATIONS DURING INSTITUTION'S CAMPS AND CLINICS — EXCEPTION — MEN'S BASKETBALL

- Permits men's basketball coaches to engage in recruiting conversations with prospective student-athletes during institution's men's basketball camps or clinics.
- Effective date: April 29, 2010.

Proposal No. 2009-61

U.S. OLYMPIC COMMITTEE/NATIONAL GOVERNING BODY — FORMER STUDENT ATHLETE AT ANOTHER INSTITUTION — INDIVIDUAL SPORTS AND WOMEN'S ROWING

- Permits former student-athlete who has graduated and has no eligibility remaining to participate in organized practice sessions at institution other than the one he or she previously attended.
- U.S. Olympic Committee or national governing body in the sport must recommend the individual's participation.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.



Proposal No. 2009-62

U.S. OLYMPIC COMMITTEE/NATIONAL GOVERNING BODY — FORMER STUDENT-ATHLETE — DURATION OF WAIVER — INDIVIDUAL SPORTS AND WOMEN'S ROWING

- Former student-athlete's participation in organized practice sessions is **limited to number of years that allows individual to practice with institution's team in preparation for two consecutive Olympic Games** following exhaustion of eligibility or completion of degree, whichever is earlier.

- U.S. Olympic Committee or national governing body in the sport must recommend the individual's participation.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.

Proposal No. 2009-66

4-4 TRANSFERS — COMPETITION OR RECEIPT OF ATHLETICALLY RELATED FINANCIAL AID IN YEAR OF TRANSFER — TENNIS

- If 4-4 midyear transfer qualifies for exception to one-year residence requirement, student-athlete is not eligible for competition until following academic year if student-athlete competed during same academic year or received athletically related financial aid during same academic year from previous four-year institution.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.

MIDYEAR REPLACEMENT — GRADUATION DURING PREVIOUS YEAR — WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL

- Financial aid of counter who graduates at midyear or who graduates during the previous academic year (including summer) may be provided to another student-athlete without making the second student-athlete a counter for the remainder of that academic year.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.

OCCASIONAL MEALS — LOCATION OF MEAL PROVIDED BY REPRESENTATIVE OF ATHLETICS INTERESTS

- Permits representative of institution's athletics interests to provide an occasional meal to student-athlete or entire team in a sport **on campus** or in a **facility that is regularly used for home competition.**
- Effective date: April 29, 2010.

MANDATORY MEDICAL EXAMINATION — SICKLE CELL SOLUBILITY TEST — OPTION TO DECLINE AND SIGN WRITTEN RELEASE

- Required medical examination or evaluation for student-athletes beginning initial season of eligibility and students who are trying out for a team must undergo prior to any athletic shall include a sickle cell solubility test.
- Exceptions:
 - Documented results of a prior test are provided to institution.
 - Individual declines the test and signs a written release.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL — PRESEASON PRACTICE — ON-COURT PRACTICE — 30 DAYS OF COUNTABLE ACTIVITIES WITHIN 40 DAYS PRIOR TO FIRST CONTEST

- Institution shall not commence on-court preseason basketball practice sessions prior to 5 p.m. on the date that is 40 days prior to date of institution's first regular-season contest.
- Institution shall not engage in more than 30 days of countable athletically related activities prior to first regular-season contest.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.



Proposal No. 2009-79-B

NONCHAMPIONSHIP SEGMENT — TRAVEL
RESTRICTIONS — CROSS COUNTRY, FIELD
HOCKEY, SOCCER, SOFTBALL AND VOLLEYBALL
— EXCEPTION — 400-MILE RADIUS

- Team travel to competition in the **nonchampionship** segment shall be restricted **to ground transportation**, unless there are no other Division I institutions **located within 400 miles of the institution**.
- Effective date: August 1, 2010.
