QUICKLY: Big 12 Conference award winners: Levi Knutson (co-sixth man; Alec Burks (unanimous first team); Cory Higgins (third team) • Higgins is now in fourth place on the CU all-time scoring list with 1,894 points • Burks surpassed the 600-point scoring plateau in a single-season ranking and ranks sixth all-time in school history (635 pts.). Burks is also the seventh CU player to score over 600 points, and first player since 1990-91 when two players scored 600 or more (Shaun Vandiver 699, Stevie Wise 655).

BUFF BITS: Colorado is 20-12 on the season, tying the fifth most wins in its history; the record is 22 (22-10 in 1996-97, Chauncey Billups' sophomore season) • CU has won five their last seven games • CU is playing their 33 game Thursday, tying a school record for most games played • Won a school record 15 wins at home • Won three Big 12 road games, a school first since the 1996-97 season • Colorado finished 6-2 at home in Big 12 conference games for 2010-11 • CU swept K-State this season, a school-first since 2003-04.

• Won eight games in the Big 12 Conference, the most wins in five years • CU is 3-3 against nation's ranked teams this season with wins over No. 5/5 Texas, No. 9/8 Missouri, at No. 21/20 Kansas State. Lost to No. 6/6 Kansas, 82-78 and to No. 22/22 Texas A&M in overtime 73-70 (margin of defeat 3.5 points); lost at No. 1/1 KU 89-63.

• CU went 3-3 against the Big 12 Conference top four seeds (swept Kansas State, defeated Texas) • Eight Big 12 Conference losses an average of 9.6 points • Five of eight Big 12 losses were in single-digits (4.6 points) • CU played four true road games in non-conference play more than any other Big 12 Conference school.

ALEC BURKS UP CLOSE: Became the 27th player in school history to score 1,000 points in 55 games • Currently has 1,147 points for 22nd overall (62 games, 18.5 ppg.) • Has led the Buffs in scoring 11 of 14 games [seven straight from (Jan. 18-Feb. 9), was a CU-best for consecutive scoring games in the 15 years of Big 12 play] • Currently averaging 19.8 ppg. the most in a season since Donnie Boyce averaged 22.4 during 1993-94 (18 years ago) • 18 games over 20 points this season • 10 games over 20 points in Big 12 play • 20+ point games in 11 of his last 18 games • On the boards, Burks has led CU eight of last 15 games.

IMPRESSIVE LIST: Andre Roberson is making a run at CU history by becoming the first freshman to lead the team in rebounding, steals and blocked shots in the same season. Roberson would become only the fourth freshman ever in Big 12 play to lead his team in rebounding, blocks steals. Here are the others who have performed that feat: **Michael Beasley, Kansas State:** 2007-08: 408 rebounds, 54 blocks, 42 steals. **Antoine Wright, Texas A&M:** 2002-03: 186 rebounds, 20 blocks, 35 steals. **Kevin Durant, Texas:** 2006-07: 390 rebounds, 67 blocks, 66 steals.

- **#1 Nate Tomlinson:** Scored 10 pts. vs. ISU, a season-best • t11th in career assists at CU (282) • 24 starts at the point: 69 assists/33 Turnovers (2.10 Asst./TO ratio) • Five games with two or more treys.

- **#2 Shannon Sharpe:** One of five on team with eight blocks (fourth on team) • 39 assists, 23 TOs (1.69 Ratio).

- **#5 Marcus Relphorde:** Best two-game total: 40 points (21 at ISU, 19 vs. Nebraska) • last 5 games: 13.8 ppg., 5.6 rpg. • Scored 10+ points in 9 of 17 of all Big 12 games.

- **#10 Alec Burks:** Finished second in Big 12-only scoring 20.0 ppg., t-third in rebounding (7.6) • 1,147 career points (21st all-time) • 18, 20-point games (26 career) • Led CU in scoring 21 times (33 career) • Top 30 Midseason Wooden Award • 2nd nationally in scoring sophomores • 10 of 17 Big 12 games over 20+; led CU in scoring 12 of 17 Big 12 games.

- **#11 Cory Higgins:** 3rd in Big 12-Only FT& (87.7) • In 20 wins: 60 assists and 35 turnovers (1.71 Ast/To.) • second in team points (15.7), assists (79), FT made (144); third in steals (32) and in treys (29) • Ranks second in Big 12 history (all games) w/ 540 FTM and finished second in Big 12-only games with 281 FTM • 9th in Big 12 scoring (1,894).

- **#21 Andre Roberson:** Buffs leader in rebounds (246), steals (45), blocks (34). No CU freshman has led all three at end of season • 246 rebounds: CU freshman record • t-9th nationally in freshman rebounding • 10 games w/ 10+ rebounds • 13 games w/ 9+ rebounds • 20 games with 7+ boards • Led Buffs on boards 19 times • Finished 2nd frosh in Big 12-only boards (7.3) • Led CU on the boards five of last six (one shared) • Season-best 5 assists vs. Texas; 3 blocks vs. Nebraska.

- **#24 Levi Knutson:** 1st in Big12-All Games in 3-pt.% (.489) and 1st in conference-only (.481 - min. 70 attempts) • Career-Year: 12.1 ppg. (third on team), 138 FG (third), team-best 66 treys • In 20 wins has team-best 45 treys • Third at CU in career 3FG% (114-of-293, .389) • 11th place on CU career 3-pointers list (114).

- **#33 Austin Dufault:** 655 career points (71st at CU) • Fourth on the boards (4.2) • Career-best four blocks vs. A&M • 12 pts, seven rebounds in home win over Mizzou; scored 10 pts., 6 rebs. at Mizzou.

CU RECORDS: The Buffaloes won a school-record 15 victories at home, in addition set four attendance marks: most sellouts a season (5); all games (117,306); conference total (78,472); and conference average (9,809).

CU AS THE NO. 5 SEED: The Buffs are 8-14 record into the conference championships and as the number five seed are 2-1. The last time that happened was 2006 (American Airlines Center, Dallas) when CU defeated No. 12 Baylor, 65-61, then lost to No. 4 Texas A&M, 86-53. CU went to the NIT that season with a 20-10 record (9-7 in Big 12) and fell to Old Dominion five days later in Boulder, 79-71. That year was the last post-season CU experienced, won 20 games and won that many in a conference season.

RARE FEAT: Four CU players have made over 100 field goals this season, the most by a CU team since 2004-05. The feat ties six other teams in school history. Entering tonight's game, Austin Dufault has 94 FGs made. No CU team has ever had five players in one season with over 100 made field goals.

BIG 12 TRENDS: CU has won five of its last seven games • Four of those wins were by single-digits • Buffs are 6-5 in single-digit Big 12 games (including win over Iowa State

in KC) • CU has surpassed their Big 12 Conference win total in the last four years (eight) and have won 20 games, the most since winning 20 in 2005-06 (N.I.T.).

SIXTH MAN: Senior guard Levi Knutson is averaging 16.0 ppg. on 51.7 field goal shooting in his last five games, he also leads CU with 14 treys. Knutson recorded his 10 game in double-digits in Big 12 play with a career conference high 21 points in the upset win over Texas; he also came off the bench with 18 points at Texas Tech; 16 points with four treys at Iowa State (more Levi pages 5, 22, 23).

- 13 games coming off the bench, Knutson is averaging 13.0 points per game (50.9 FG%) with 2.5 treys a game. He also averaging 48.5 from the 3-point arc.

- Knutson has made a three-pointer in 20-straight games; 30 of 32 games this season with at least one three-pointer • Knutson has led CU in scoring four times this season (five career).

THIRD ALL-TIME: Head coach Tad Boyle is second all-time among first-year CU head coaches at the helm.

GAME NOTES vs. Iowa State - March 9

- Colorado advances to the quarterfinal round for the first time since 2007-08. That season the Buffaloes were the first No. 12 seed to upset No. 5 (Baylor, 91-84 2 ots) • CU improves to 8-14 in Big 12 Championship games • 2-1 as the No. 5 seed • 2-0 vs. Iowa State in post-season Big 12 play • CU improves to 2-1 in neutral court games this season.

- CU has won 20 games in a season, a first to win that many games in a season since 2005-06 (20-10, NIT).

- The 20 wins in season is the fifth time in school history.

- Head Coach Tad Boyle now ranks second in school history to win that many games as a first year coach (22, Ricardo Patton, 1996-97).

- Third game this season a pair of CU players grabbed 10 or more rebounds in the same game (Iowa State, Texas).

- CU is 15-0 with a higher shooting percentage; 15-2 when outrebounding the opponent (at OU, at Mizzou only losses); 12-2 when their bench outscores the opponent (at OU, at BU).

- Levi Knutson made two treys (66 season) ranking 10th in CU season three-pointers.

- Knutson has made a three-pointer in 30 of 32 games; sixth games with at least two in a game.

- Cory Higgins played his 1,000 minute of the

FOUR CU RECORDS: This season Cory Higgins has etched his name atop four school records: games played (126), games starts (125), career FTs made (540) and career minutes (4,290).

FREE SHOTS = FREE POINTS: Alec Burks and Cory Higgins are a combined 349-for-415 (84.1 percent) from the free throw line this season. The rest of the team is 228-for-324 (70.3). As a team, the Buffs are fifth nationally (78.1).

CU MILESTONE CLUB: Cory Higgins is the 18th player in school history to score over 1,000 points (1,894) with 500 rebounds in a career (536). However, he's only the second player in school history to score over 1,800 points, grab 500 rebounds, handout out 300 assists (305), and having over 150 steals (187). Donnie Boyce (1991-95) is the only other player.

ON THE ROAD: The last time CU won three Big 12 road games was 1996-97 (made NCAA Tournament) • The Buffs have won three true road games this season, the most since winning three in 2007-08 (all those wins in state of Colorado) • Wins at Texas Tech and No. 21/20 K-State equal two Big 12 roads in the same season since 2005-06 season (at Missouri, at Oklahoma State).

SCORING: Alec Burks and Cory Higgins have led CU one-and-two in scoring 37 of their 62 games together, 18 times this season • Leading CU in scoring: Burks 21 times (one shared); Higgins five times (one shared); Levi Knutson four times; Austin Dufault, Marcus Relphorde once each • Burks netted scoring double figures 30 of 32 games; Higgins 29 of 32 games; Knutson 23 of 32; Relphorde 21 of 31 • Dufault and Marcus Relphorde are the only players to start every game (32).

The 2001-02 and the 1990-91 teams did it seven times.

MORE TRENDS: CU committed just five turnovers in the home win over Nebraska, their lowest all season and lowest as a team since having four in a 64-63 loss at Iowa State in 2009-10. This season, the Buffs have committed single-digit turnovers 11 times • CU has forced more turnovers than it has committed in 22 of 32 contests this year.
