• CU leads the all-time series against CSU, 25-0 dating back to 1975. The two schools have not played against one another since 2004. CU is 14-0 at home in the series.

• Winde Janssens, Carla Manzi Tenorio, Kristina Schleich, and Juyette Steur each have two wins during the spring season. Schleich has 10, and Janssens has nine wins for the year.

• CU plays five opponents this season from the Centennial State.

• Sophomores Winde Janssens and Kristina Schleich have already played 10 three set matches in their young career, and both are 5-5. Schleich leads the team with four wins in three sets wins when rallying back from a set down.

• CU has failed to win the doubles point in four team matches played.

• The Buffs are 3-1 at the No. 2 singles position so far this year, and have collected two wins each at No. 4 and No. 5.

CSU Match Notes

• The Rams are 1-1 on the season and come into play on Saturday after a win last weekend against Arkansas State.

• Kaley Schultz and Natalie Heffron are the only players on the Rams roster to remain undefeated this season.

• Colorado State has three new players that have been added to its roster this season, two freshmen (Natalie Heffron and Adriana Wojakowska) and one senior (Emese Kordhordo).

• Saturday's match will mark the second time over a three-dual stretch that the Rams have faced an in-state rival; they traveled to play Denver on Jan. 28.
