rebounding games rank fourth and her 91 double-digit scoring games rank sixth on CU's career charts.

- Had at least one assist over her final 74 games and in 123 of 125 career outings.

- Has 45 career games with three or more steals.

- 2012 All-Pac-12 Conference selection by both the coaches and the media. Selected to the Pac-12 All-Defensive team by the coaches.

- Averaged 15.8 points and 11.8 rebounds in the 2012 Postseason WNIT. Had double-doubles in her last three and four of her last six games.

- Holds two of the program's three triple-doubles, recording her second with 12 points, 12 rebounds and a career-high tying 10 assists in the WNIT quarterfinal over Oklahoma State.

- The 24th player in team history to reach 1,000 points, 10th to reach that milestone before her senior year and tied for ninth fastest overall at 81 games (Tera Bjorklund, 2000-04).

- As a junior in the Pac-12 ranked fourth in assists, fifth in steals, sixth in scoring and defensive rebounds, eighth in overall rebounding, 10th in assist-to-turnover ratio, 12th in field-goal percentage and 13th free-throw percentage.

- On CU's single-season ledger ranked fourth in minutes played (1,161), fifth in field-goal attempts (474), seventh in steals (82), eighth in field-goals made (211), ninth in points (541) and rebounds (280) and 11th in assists (133).

- Her 30 double-figure scoring games are sixth on CU's single-season list while her 10 double-doubles are seventh.

- On the junior season charts she finished second in assists, third in scoring and fourth in steals and rebounds.

- Only the second guard in CU history with double-doubles in three-straight games

- The first player in team history to record 1,600 points, 900 rebounds and 400 assists.

- Had 10 double-doubles, six coming in the final 13 games, including three-straight (USC-Oregon State-Oregon). Eight of her 10 double-doubles came during conference play.

- Named espnW and U.S. Basketball Writers Association Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Week (Dec. 10-16).

- Named to the Omni Classic All-Tournament team averaging 13 points, 7.5 rebounds, 3 assists and 3 steals. First player to be named Omni Classic All-Tournament all four years of her career.

- On the Pac-12 leaderboard ranked fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio, fifth in steals and assists, sixth in double-doubles, overall rebounding and defensive rebounds, ninth in scoring and 13th free-throw percentage.

- Recorded her second straight season with at least 125 assists and 75 steals (eighth instance overall), joining Bridget Turner as the only CU players to do it twice.

- Scored the decisive points in back-to-back wins, a jumper against Arizona with 17.7 seconds left and two free throws against USC with 1.2 seconds remaining.

- Pac-12 Conference Player of the Week on Dec. 4, averaging 28 points and 11 rebounds on 64.5 percent from the field.

- Her 9-of-10 performance from the field against Denver was the best by a CU player on a minimum 10 attempts since Jackie McFarland was 9-of-10 against CSU Bakersfield on Dec. 28, 2007. MVP of the Omni Hotels Classic.

- Led Colorado in assists (4.3 apg) and steals (2.5 spg) while ranking second in scoring (13.5 ppg) and rebounding (7.9) as a sophomore.

- Second in the Big 12 in defensive rebounds (6.0 drpg) while ranking third in steals, fifth in overall rebounding, seventh in assists, 10th in field-goal percentage (.471), 15th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.1), and 16th in scoring.

- Her 76 steals in 2010-11 were seventh on CU's single-season list while her 128 assists were 14th.

- Recorded the second triple-double in school history with 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 assists against Loyola Chicago. Her triple-double was the 18th in Big 12 history and she was the 11th different player to score one.

- Averaged 9.3 points, 5.2 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 2.0 steals as a freshman. Led the team in assists, ranked second in rebounding and steals and third in scoring. Ranked 10th in overall assists on the league charts and ranked 13th in assist-to-turnover ratio (0.8). Among freshmen in the Big 12, she ranked fourth in assists and fifth in scoring.

- Big 12 Freshman of the Week honors on Jan. 11 after averaging 15.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, 6.5 assists and 5.0 steals in wins over Yale (1/4) and Missouri (1/9).

- She came off the bench in her collegiate debut, but started in the final 28 games she played in, missing only one contest (Gambling State, 12/30) with a sprained ankle.

- First career double-double against No. 6 (AP)/4 (WBCA) Nebraska (1/30) with 14 points and a career-best 11 rebounds.

- *Denver Post* Class 4A All-State first team member for Sierra High School

- Averaged 22.1 points, 12.9 rebounds, 4.9 steals, 4.6 assists and 3.0 blocks as a senior leading Sierra a 22-3 record and their third straight Colorado Springs Metro League title.

- Two-time *Colorado Springs Post Gazette* Big Schools Player of the Year.

- Honorable Mention all-state as a junior.

- Given name is Janeesa (pronounced Ja-NEE-sa)

- A sociology major, expected to graduate this summer. She earned the Most Improved Student-Athlete Award at the 2012 Academic Banquet, one of three recipients across all 16 of Colorado's varsity sport programs.
