MATCH NOTES

• Saturday's back-to-back matches in the same day is the first time CU will be performing the pair of matches in the same day since the 1996-97 season. While in Hawaii, the Buffs played the host Rainbow Warriors (W, 9-0) and Pacific (W, 4-2).

• CU is 13-1 all-time against Air Force. The Academy edged CU last year at home, 4-3 winning the doubles point, then taking three of the six singles matches. The Buffaloes are 7-0 at home in the series.

• CU holds a 27-0 advantage against Colorado State with 15 of the victories coming at home. In their only two meetings in 2012 and 2013 (since the series started again since 2004), CU took a pair of 6-1 decisions.

• After the AFA-CSU match, CU will travel to the Sunflower State to take on Kansas (Feb. 7 and Kansas State (Feb. 8). It's also a homecoming for CU junior Ashley Tiefel, who is from Leawood, Kan. (Blue Valley HS).

• Since 2007, CU has won five of six against KU, although the Jayhawks lead the all-time series, 25-17. Against K-State, the Buffs have won six of the last seven in the series, however, the Wildcats lead 24-11.

• Entering play this weekend, Alex Aiello and Nuria Ormeño Ruiz lead the team in wins with 12 and 11, respectively. Julyette Steur and Ashley Tiefel each have seven. In doubles, the duo of Ormeño Ruiz and Winde Janssens have eight victories, followed by Steur and Tiefel with six. Alex Aiello and Carla Manzi Tenorio have five wins.

• The Pac-12 Conference is regarded as the best conference for women's tennis nationally features eight of the 10 schools nationally ranked among the Top-75 schools. Defending champion Stanford is ranked at the top, followed by UCLA (No. 5), USC (No. 6), and California (No. 8) rounding out conference teams among the top 10. All four schools will visit Boulder in March.
