"BUFFALO BITS"

**QUICKLY...** Colorado (1-0-1) will be playing its third game in as many time zones in 1990, as the Buffs opened with a 31-31 tie with Tennessee at Anaheim before returning to Boulder for a 21-17 conquest of Stanford... The Buffs will return to the road next week at Texas, which will mark back-to-back road tilts in nine-league play for the first time since 1986 (and for only the third time since 1976).

**IN THE POLLS...** Colorado was No. 9 in both the AP and UPI polls, and was No. 11 in CNN/USA Today. The three positions that CU dropped in the AP poll marked the first time CU had ever dropped more than one notch in their poll after a victory. CU has now been ranked in the AP's top 10 for 19 straight weeks, the longest stint in school history, and has been ranked overall in 20 straight polls (the schools record is 32, 1971-73).

**STREAKS-N-STUFF...** Here's a quick look at Colorado's record since 1985 in certain instances; the Buffaloes went to a running attack for that season, and have since compiled a 40-20-1 record. Colorado is:

- 27-2-1 when rushing for 300 or more yards (12-0 when 400-plus);
- 31-2-1 when holding the edge in time-of-possession;
- 22-0-1 when gaining 400 or more yards of total offense (10-0 when 500-plus);
- 33-7-0 when holding opponents to 17 points or less (37-7 in overall McCartney Era);
- 20-2-0 when running more plays than the opponent;
- 22-0-0 when holding the opponent to less than 100 yards rushing;
- 24-5-0 when holding the opponent to less than 300 yards of total offense;
- 16-5-0 when passing for over 100 yards (2-0 when passing for over 200);
- 22-2-0 when making 20 or more first downs;
- 21-1-0 when converting over 50 percent of third down conversions;
- 12-0-0 when punting two or fewer times in a game (15-4 with three or fewer);
- 32-5-0 when average field position is better than the CU 30 (19-3 when better than CU35)

**INDIVIDUAL NOTES...** **Eric Bieniemy** needs just 88 yards to become CU's second all-time leading rusher. He enters the game with 2,461 career yards, looking No. 2 James Mayberry in the face (2,548). Bieniemy is fourth on CU's all-time scoring chart (170 points), with Tom Field (190) and Byron White (191) the next two to overtake. **Darian Hagan** is 22nd on the school's rushing chart (1,359 yards), and he is 105 yards away from the next position. He is 18th on the scoring list (yet to score a point in 1990), and is 36 points out of the top 10. **Tim James** is tied for seventh on the all-time interception list (9), with his next one to move him into a tie for third. The leader has 16 (John Stearns), with Dick Anderson next (14). **Joe Garten** will be starting his 35th career game, closing in on the school record of 39 (held by Mickey Pruitt, 1984-87). James, Alfred Williams and Mark Vander Poel have started 24 straight regular season games (26 straight including bowl games), with Kanavis McGhee's 29 career starts the second most on the team by an active player (Bieniemy's next with 28).

**COACH BILL McCARTNEY...** Bill McCartney is 47-45-2 in his ninth season at Colorado (his only collegiate head coaching job), and he has piloted the Buffs to a 40-20-1 mark since 1985 and to a 33-11-1 record since the start of the 1986 conference season. He is 1-0 against Illinois and 2-4 against members of the Big Ten. As an assistant at Michigan, McCartney obviously visited all stadiums in the conference; as a head coach at Colorado, Illinois will be the fourth school he has returned to (Michigan State, Ohio State and Iowa were the others).

**THIS-N-THAT...** The 179 yards passing Colorado had against Stanford was the fifth most in the "Ground Mac" Era. The most has been 223 yards, which CU had in the '89 Illinois game. An individual has not completed 10 or more passes in a game since Craig Keenan did it in the 1984 finale at Kansas State; the team has done it only once since then, last year at Iowa State (10 of 12).
